

## NEW LOCAL RULE

---

Every Licence or Permit to a Trainer, owner, or other person to train, ride, exercise, or bring a horse or horses on a course shall be issued, and every nomination or entry of a horse to race on a course shall be made on the express stipulation and condition that the use of the course for any purpose whatsoever shall be entirely at the risk of the Owner or Trainer of the horse or other person using the course. And that the Club does not guarantee that the course is safe for any such purpose, and that the Club will not be liable for any accident that may happen, whether arising from any defect in the course, or from, by, or through the negligence of the Club, its officials or servants, or from any cause whatsoever. And that this stipulation and condition shall apply to every horse which may be brought, trained, exercised, or raced, or which may be nominated or entered for any race to be run on the course; and for the purpose of this Rule course shall mean the Trotting Track at Elphin, and in addition any land owned, occupied, or used by this Club, whether such land is of a like nature to a racecourse or training track or is of a different nature and used for a different purpose.

## NOTICE

All horses must be on the Track 20 minutes before the advertised time of starting each Race. This rule will be strictly enforced.

Races will be started strictly to time.

## INTER-DOMINION TROTTING CHAMPIONSHIPS

### A BRIEF HISTORY

It was at a meeting in Sydney on June 18, 1935 at which the various trotting controlling bodies in Australasia were represented that the Inter-Dominion Trotting Championships were inaugurated. It is hoped that each State in the Commonwealth and New Zealand can take its turn in staging the outstanding classics of the light harness sport.

The Inter-Dominion Trotting Championships Committee which will stage the 1939 series at Launceston is made up of representatives of the Northern Tasmanian Trotting Club and Danbury Park Trotting Club. Stakes to the value of £3,500 have been provided for the 4 days, which is outstanding in Australia for a city of the size of Launceston. This generous allotment of prize money was made possible by the whole-hearted support of the business and sporting people of the State.

# THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

## HEATS OVER THREE DISTANCES

SATURDAY, DECEMBER 31—Heats over 1½ miles.

TUESDAY, JANUARY 3—Heats over 1½ miles.

THURSDAY, JANUARY 5—Heats over 2 miles.

SATURDAY, JANUARY 7—Final (£1,000) over 1½ miles.

The conditions of the Final of the Inter-Dominion Championships shall be: Points shall be allotted for heat winners, 4 points; second, 3 points; third, 2 points; fourth, 1 point. In the event of dead-heats, the points shall be equally divided, except in the case of fourth place, where the point for that place shall be equally divided. The 10 horses which aggregate most points (provided they compete in heats over each distance) shall be eligible for, and shall compete in the Final.

Where horses score the same number of points, the Committee shall decide on the number of starters in the Final.

## COLOURS

Owners' attention is drawn to the following rule, which will be strictly enforced:—"Any persons whose rider appears in colours other than those specified at time of entry may be fined a sum not exceeding One Pound (£1)"

## NOTICES TO OWNERS

No horse shall weigh out a second time without the permission of the Stewards.

Horses winning or improving their marks at the meeting may be re-classed at the discretion of the Handicapper and such re-classification shall be final. Horses re-classified into any other race shall be regarded as eligible for such race and be liable for any payments attached thereto.

Handicaps for the minor events (all races except Championships) will be declared as follows: First day, SATURDAY, DECEMBER 17, 1938; second day, MONDAY, JANUARY 2, 1939; third day, WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 4, 1939; fourth day, FRIDAY, JANUARY 6, 1939. Handicaps will be published on those days.

### NOTICE TO MOTORISTS

#### Traffic Arrangements for Inter-Dominion Race Meetings at Elphin.

All private vehicles will reach Course via Elphin Road to Cypress St. and enter grounds from that street, and proceed to eastern side, where they will be parked under police supervision.

When leaving the grounds these vehicles, if it is desired to come back to the City or proceed north, will leave by same route as they entered till Elphin Road is reached, then proceed via Dowling St., Racecourse Crescent, Cimitiere St. to City. Vehicles desiring to proceed eastwards or to Newstead will leave grounds by Hart St. entrance to Elphin Road and turn east towards David Street.

Cars with "Official Disc" attached to wind-screen will be permitted to enter grounds via Olive St. and park in the reserve provided. (All other Members' cars will enter via Cypress St. with other traffic.) Official cars may leave ground either by Hart St. or Cypress St. as desired.

Motor lorries conveying horses to Course will enter by Hart Street entrance only and shall not be left in such a manner as to cause obstruction round horse boxes.
