- Open to approved horses registered with the Controlling Bodies of New Zealand and each State of the Commonwealth of Australia.
- The Championships will be restricted to pacers and conducted on the points system. Points will be awarded as follows in each division: First horse 4 points; second horse 2 points; third horse 1 point and the horse recording the fastest time in each division will receive 3 points. The maximum handicaps will be 36 yards up to 12 furlongs and 48 yards over longer distances.
