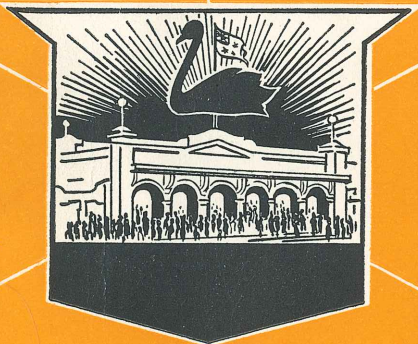

# "QUINELLA" 5/- TOTALISATOR

## Operates on All Races

The "Quinella" Totalisator is conducted on all races of the programme. You must choose two horses to fill the first and second places irrespective of the order in which they finish. Tickets are sold at 5/- each. There is no limit to the number of tickets which may be purchased, and please ask for horse numbers in race book order.

In the event of a "carry-over" on any "Quinella", it shall be transferred into the Pool of the first Quinella (1st Race) of the next meeting at Gloucester Park. In the event of there being 2 or more "carry-overs" at the one meeting, the first "carry-over" shall be transferred into the Pool of the first race Quinella of the next meeting and the other or others shall be transferred to a race or races to be decided by the committee of the Association.

### "FIELD" TICKETS

Investors may purchase "Field" Tickets; taking one horse (or No.) with the remainder of the Field (or Nos.) for which one ticket will be issued.

### REFUNDS ON NON-STARTERS

Investments on the "Quinella" Totalisator on any combination which includes a non-starter shall be refunded in full upon production and delivery of the ticket.

## NOTICE TO PATRONS

### CONDITIONS OF RACING

All races to be run under the Rules of Racing made under the Constitution and Rules of the Western Australian Trotting Association.

In all races when two or more horses are on identical marks, the horse whose name appears first will occupy No. 1 pole position, the other positions following in rotation.

### REFUSAL OF NOMINATION

The Committee may, in its absolute discretion, at any time after receipt of a nomination, cancel the same without giving any reason therefor.

### RE-HANDICAPPING OF HORSES

If, after the handicaps are declared for a race, a horse wins or is placed in another race, the handicap of that horse may be re-adjusted by the Handicapper.

### STARTING

Horses are under the starter's orders after the whistle has been blown to take their position at the barriers.

### PROTESTS

A driver of a competing horse may protest against the winner, or any placed horse on the ground of interference, crossing, jostling, or any improper act or conduct of the driver of such horse. The protest must be made to a Steward or Clerk of the Scales BEFORE THE DRIVER LEAVES THE SCALES after weighing in.

### BOOKMAKERS

The public is notified that Bookmakers fielding in the Enclosure must set the Investor up to £100 on the prices shown on the board, and in the Leger, up to £25. In the event of a dead heat, payment will be made on a basis of half of value of the ticket.

A Horn will be blown in the Enclosure Bookmakers' Ring as the horses are called to the barrier. (Approx. 3 minutes to the start of each race.)

On all Betting tickets issued by Bookmakers, the name of the Horse and the amount of the Bet must be clearly written. Should a dispute arise and it is found that this has not been done, a decision may be given against the Bookmaker.

Investors must check their ticket for the correct Name of Horse and Amount, as no claim will be recognised after the acceptance of the Ticket.

### LOST BETTING TICKETS
