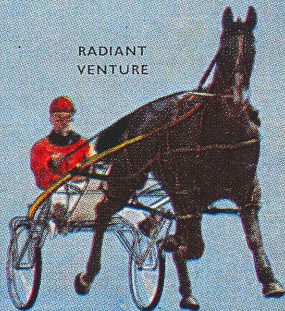

STEWARDS' REPORT

WAYVILLE — SATURDAY, 16th FEBRUARY, 1963

Christchurch Handicap:

R. Vile (MEDONIS) was questioned regarding this mare's performance. He stated that she could not come on when asked in the last lap. He was told not to race her again for two or three weeks to give her an opportunity to freshen up.

CULLODEN BOY broke for no apparent reason at the top turn. May was told that a repetition of this bad fault would result in the refusal of the horse's nomination for a period.

Inter-Dominion Championship (1st Div.):

FUTURE RAIDER pulled very hard in running and struck OPAL CHIEF's wheel, pulling the tyre from the rim. FUTURE RAIDER also missed the start and will be excluded from the draw in the Consolation Races.

S.A. Pacing Derby:

D. Townley (TACTILE) was severely reprimanded for driving too close to MINUTEMAN, causing considerable inconvenience to E. Hurley, the driver of MINUTEMAN.

STATE LAW broke in the back straight, causing YOU CROVOTTIE to be checked.

Inter-Dominion Championship (3rd Div.):

A. Turner (MARY KATHLEEN) had his reinsmen's licence suspended for one month for careless driving in driving into the back of CONEEDA, causing the accident involving CONEEDA, MARY KATHLEEN, STEPPING CHIEF and CARDIGAN BAY.

Inter-Dominion Championship (4th Div.):

The accident in this division was caused when MAYFIELD SCOTT broke and collided with MARY MAVIS, which in turn was contacted from the rear by BARMAN CHIEF, unseating both W. Picken and R. Arthur, and causing interference to VEEBEEAH and JIDALUK.

D. Townley (WAITAKI HANOVER) could offer no explanation for this horse's poor performance in breaking in running, and said that all through the race WAITAKI HANOVER appeared to be shying away from the inside of the track.

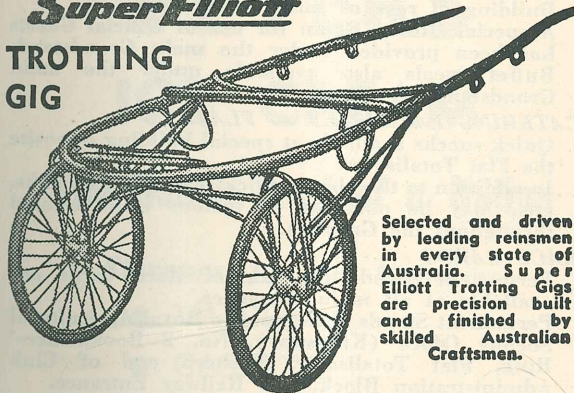

Extracts from Regulations under Lottery and Gaming Acts

CONTROL OF QUEUES.

7. (1) Persons approaching any window of a Totalizator shall form up in a queue in single file extending away from such window.

(2) When any such queue has been formed, no person shall approach the window to which such queue leads except as a member of such queue.

8. No person shall —

- (a) push into any such queue, or join the same except at the rear end thereof;
- (b) take precedence of any person who from his position has a prior right in any queue,
- (c) stand or walk between any queues so formed, or within four yards of either side of the outside queues;
- (d) pass money or a ticket to any person in any queue.

9. Every person shall at all times observe and comply with any reasonable direction by any member of the Police Force as to: —

- (a) the manner of approaching to or departing from any totalizator;
- (b) the conduct of such person in the vicinity of any totalizator.

PENALTIES

10. Any person who contravenes any provision of regulation 7, 8, or 9 hereof, whether by omission or commission, shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £10 for every breach of such provision.

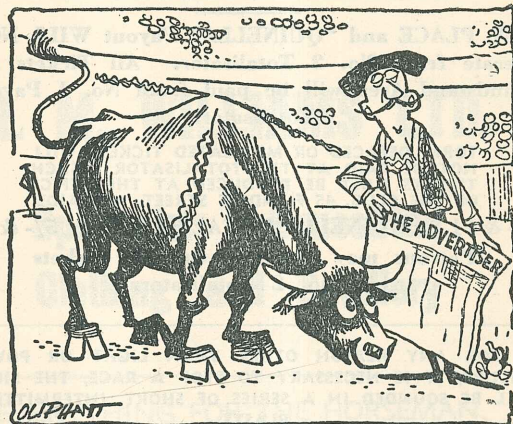

- (1) No person shall at any time on the Showgrounds, without the written consent of the Council, consume any liquor whatsoever except in such booths, luncheon or refreshment rooms, stalls or other places as set apart by the Council for the consumption of liquor.
- (2) Whereas any consent is given in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of this by-law, the Council may impose any terms or conditions it thinks fit and if any person consume liquor otherwise than in accordance with such terms and conditions or any of them, he shall be guilty of an offence.
- (3) In this by-law "liquor" shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in Section 4 of the Licensing Act, 1922-1945
