TROTTING CONTROL BOARD

Doubles and Quinella

- 1 A Doubles totalisator will operate on "this and the next" for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th Races. A Quinella totalisator will operate on all races.
- 1. In selecting a Double the investor must ask for the racebook number of the horse required in the 1st leg First and then the racebook number of the horse required in the 2nd leg.
- An investor may invest in a Double as many times as desired.

For example, if he wishes to Couple Nos. 3 and 7 more than once he should say "Nos. 3 and 7, two tickets", or whatever number of times he requires the double.

FIELD BETTING -

Certain windows will be available for Doubles and Quinella "Field" betting. In Doubles "Field" betting an investor selects one horse in any one leg of a Double with ALL the runners in the other leg. For example, a horse, say No. 7, in thefirst leg, could be coupled with all, the horses ("the Field") in the 2nd leg, in which case the investor would ask for "No. 7 and the Field", or the investor may desire to have all runners ("the Field") in the 1st leg coupled with a horse, say No. 5, in the 2nd leg, in which case he would ask for "the Field and No. 5". The same principle applies to Quinella "Field" betting. Of course the investor's outlay is greater, being governed by the number of horses in "the Field". A Doubles or Quinella ticket in "Field" betting can be issued just as quickly as a Single ticket for a combination of only two horses.

- 5. In Totalisator Doubles:--
 - (a) You are entitled to a REFUND of your stake -
 - (1) If your horse in the 1st leg is withdrawn, regardless of whether your horse in the 2nd leg wins or does not start:
 - (2) If your horse in the 2nd leg is withdrawn PRIOR to the running of the 1st leg, regardless of whether your horse in the 1st leg wins or loses.
 - (b) NO REFUND is made if your horse in the 1st leg loses and your horse in the 2nd leg is scratched after the running of the 1st leg.

(c) If your horse in the 1st leg wins and your horse in the leg is withdrawn AFTER the running of the 1st leg your bet deemed to be transferred to such other horse as the Trotting Control Board shall determine and announce prior to the running of the 2nd leg. In making its determination, the Board is required, as far as practicable to substitute for the withdrawn horse the starter which carries the greatest amount of money in combination with the winner of the 1st leg.

The foregoing shall also apply if your horse in the 2nd leg is withdrawn from a re-run of a race in which it had taken part.

OUINELLA (RACE PAIRS) BETTING -

This a form of Doubles betting on any one race. A Quinella will operate on every race.

The investor may select any two horses in the race, for example Nos. 3 and 11, and if those horses fill the first two placings IRRESPECTIVE OF WHETHER THEY ARE PLACED FIRST AND SECOND OR SECOND AND FIRST, the investors on Nos. 3 and 11 are entitled to collect the dividend declared on the Quinella. As in doubles betting the investor may take the whole field if he wishes (see paragraph 5).

On the last race all Doubles Windows will be open for Quinella betting

WARNING RE DOUBLES and QUINELLA

It is possible that there may not be any investors on a winning combination to which event the Doubles and Quinella pools would be divided among the tuvestors as follows:—

STEWARDS' REPORT

SATURDAY, 21st FEBRUARY, 1970

"Bylaw" was examined by the Veterinary Surgeon at 6 p.m. and declared fit to start.

- LAUNCESTON STAKES: "Ed Brigade" (G. D. Wilson) broke without interference soon after the barrier was released and veered towards the rails, forcing "Clan Raider" (L. Rule) on to "Jaygo" (D. Dove), which contacted the rail. "Horology" (K. Wellington), which was trailing, contacted the rear of "Clan Raider" (L. Rule), and was pulled up. D. Dove "Jaygo" and L. Rule "Clan Raider" were unseated. In avoiding the mix-up, "Rich King" (G. Rothacker) checked "Go Glen" (M. Shaw). In future, "Ed Brigade" (G. D. Wilson) will be excluded from the draw in mobile barrier races.
- HOBART HANDICAP: In future. "Baderloo" (K. Elliott), which began badly, checking "Wimble" (G. Lang) will oe excluded from the draw in standing start races.
- 1970 INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP (Ninth Qualifying Division): "Co Pilot" (G. Holmes) broke without interference at the first turn, checking "Bar Adios" (R. Ford).
 "Stella Frost" (D. Townley) jumped sideways at the start, checking "Golden Allev" (K. Newman).

"Bylaw" (K. Webster) galloped from the start.

1970 INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP (Tenth Qualifying Division): "The Rogue" (F. Kersley) fell in its preliminary. After examination by the Veterinary Surgeon it was withdrawn at 9.03 p.m. It was required that all bets on "The Rogue" be refunded, and bets made prior to 9.03 p.m. to be paid less six cents (6c) for the win and seven cents (7c) for the place on the face value of the ticket; all bets made after 9.03 p.m. to be paid in full.

"Bold Alabar" (N. G. Gath), when leading at the turn into the straight with a lap to go, faltered. "Garrison Call" (N. Welsh), "Richmond Lass" (J. Hargreaves), "Hi Efficiency" (C. Phillis), "Meadow Bank" (D. Townley) and "Leading Light" (D. Jones), which were trailing on the rail, suffered checks as a shunting action went through the field. It was found on completion of the race that "Bold Alabar" had bröken down, and the driver, N. G. Gath, stated that in his opinion, it occurred at this spot. Following the race, "Bold Alabar" was examined by the Veterinary Surgeon, who found him to be very lame in the off foreleg.

1970 INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP (Eleventh Qualifying Division):
"Imatoff" (K. Innes), "Moonstone Bay" (R. Cox), "Lucky Creed" (V. Frost) and "Torrent" (J. Smolenski) began badly. As "Torrent" (J. Smolenski) and "Lucky Creed" (V. Frost) had previously begun badly in divisions, they will continue to be excluded from the draw, Warnings were issued to "Imatoff" (K. Innes) and "Moonstone Bay" (R. Cox).

It was found to be caused by "Royal Society" (P. J. Hall) crossing to the rails too sharply, causing B. Cushing to check "Dainty's Daughter" severely. The driver's licence of P. J. Hall was suspended for four weeks, to be served concurrently with that for the incident involving "Dollar Gift" (G. Rothacker). (Rule 261.)


