RESERVES



To be eligible to compete in the Grand Final of the Championship horses shall start in every Qualifying Division unless exemption is made by the Grand Council of the Inter Dominion Trotting Council.

INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS SYSTEM

Points shall be awarded to each horses actually starting and finishing a race of a Qualifying Division on the basis that the winner of a race of a Qualifying Division will receive in points the equivalent of the number of horses previously selected by the Host Club as the maximum number of horses to compete in each race of the Qualifying Divisions. The second horses in each race of the Qualifying Divisions will receive the next lower number in points and the third horses will receive the next lower number with each horse finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding horse until the last horse finishing in a maximum field will receive one (1) point.

The winner of each race of a Qualifying Division will receive one (1) bonus point to be added to the points already earned for that race.

There are no points allocated for fastest time.

A horse that is scratched from a race of the Qualifying Divisions or a horse that does not complete the race will not be allocated any points for the race of that Qualifying Division.

In the event of a scratching or a horse not completing the course, points will be allocated as before with the winner and other horses finishing the race entitled to receive their maximum number of points as if a full field had competed and finished the course in that particular race.

In the event of a dead-heat all points of the horses dead-heating shall be added together and equally divided.

The ten horses which gain the greatest aggregate of points shall be eligible to start in the Grand Final.

In the event of two or more horses each scoring equally the minimum number of points entitling them to be eligible for the Grand Final and thereby producing a field exceeding the number designated by the Albion Park Trotting Club or producing a field exceeding the safety number for Albion Park Paceway then the Grand Council shall decide in its discretion which of the horses with equal points shall start in the Grand Final.

Should circumstances warrant such a course of action the Grand Council of the Inter-Dominion Trotting Council shall have the power to increase the number of starters above the designated number and to select the additional starters.

STEWARDS' REPORT Saturday, 13th May, 1972

Changes of Gear:

Permission was granted to connections to make the following gear changes:—

Race 2 — REVELLING SANDY — hopples to be altered

from 56 to 55.

Race 3 — ALL REAL — to race in hopple shorteners. Race 6 — PEPPIN BLOOD — to race in a hood. COCKY SCOTT — to remove shadow roll.

Scratchings:

JENNIFER GLENFERN, CLAN CHIEF, TIDY OFFICER, GAY POWER and ZAROLI were all scratched for veterinary reasons and were declared ineligible to start for 10 days; a veterinary certificate of fitness is to be submitted before each horse again

starts at a registered meeting.

Race 1: The hopples of MONASTIQUE (F. J. Southgate) broke as the horses approached the turn into the straight during the final lap, causing that mare to break and, in so doing, NERELLA STAR (A. H. Coleman) and PLAIN GAMBLE (A. R. Belford) were severely interfered with and lost considerable ground. The hopples of MONASTIQUE were found to be of good quality. Trainer Southgate was advised to cure MONASTIQUE of lugging in during races; however, he advised the Stewards that the mare would be retired immediately.

Race 2: TRAVIS RUTH (C. H. Mewes) was slow away, and will continue to be excluded from the barrier draw in standing starts. FLYING WARRILL (J. R. Brown), which again broke without interference, was declared ineligible to start at Albion Park until a satisfactory barrier trial is performed. Having its first start in the right-handed direction, PLEASEWIN (C. King) lugged in

badly, and a warning was issued.

Race 3: REGENCY BUCK (K. Hill) galloped at the start, and will continue to be drawn on the outside in standing start races. GAY GLEN (W. Wood) lugged off in the straight on each occasion when leading the field, and a warning was issued to the connections.

Race 4: IVOR (G. McMahon) broke soon after the start and, when dropping back through the field, inconvenienced horses which were following. A warning was issued to the connections.

RAIDER'S CITY (C. Edwards) broke on the turn out of the back straight during the second lap when the field was racing tightly. No blame could be attached to any particular driver.

Driver P. Bryant (NELLIE GLENFERN) was severely reprimanded for failing to stop driving the horse when it veered out

under pressure in the run to the winning post.

Race 5: WAR VETERAN (C. Neville), which galloped at the start, will continue to be excluded from the draw in standing start races. ADIOS AMIGO (R. Jackson) broke for no apparent reason as the horses turned into the straight on the second lap, and a warning was issued to the connections. GARRISON (R. Croghan) was inconvenienced and lost ground as a result of this incident.

Race 6: THE JOKER (J. O'Sullivan), which refused to line up at the barrier, was ordered to the outside by the starter, and will continue to be excluded from the barrier draw in standing start races. KAYELEM (L. Knight), RE PETITE (R. Croghan) and ROYAL POPPIN (L. J. Hopper), which galloped at the start, will continue to be drawn on the outside in standing start races.

DARLIN DONNA (R. Pollack) appeared to contact the wheel of JENNY GLENFERN (N. Ryan) as the horses turned into the straight during the final lap. An enquiry was held after the final race, and, after hearing evidence of Driver R. Pollack (DARLIN DONNA) and Driver N. Ryan (JENNY GLENFERN) and from the Stewards' observation, the Stewards decided that each horse had contributed to the incident by DARLIN DONNA lugging out slightly under pressure and JENNY GLENFERN lugging in under pressure.

Race 7: QUEEN CREED (J. O'Sullivan) was accidentally contacted from behind by CLIONA BELLE (G. McMahon) when the field tightened abruptly in the back straight during the first lap. The tyre of the gig of QUEEN CREED was punctured during this

incident. The occurrence was accidental.

MR. SPROGGINS (K. Belford) broke on the turn out of the back straight during the final lap when racing between JOHNNY DHU (A. Paxman) and QUEEN CREED (J. O'Sullivan). An enquiry was held, and after hearing evidence of J. O'Sullivan, driver of QUEEN CREED, which was racing on the inside; K. Belford, driver of MR. SPROGGINS (centre) and A. Paxman, driver of JOHNNY DHU (outside), and from the Stewards' observation, Driver Paxman was given the benefit of a very grave doubt, and no further action was taken.

Hopples of horses which broke were checked and found to be of correct length. Films were viewed at enquiries. Winners

of all races were sent to be swabbed.

NOTICE TO TOTALISATOR INVESTORS

WIN AND PLACE TOTALISATOR: In all cases, investors must ask for the number of the horse they select thus, "No. 1 — Win"; Place only, —"No. 1 — Place". If a win and a place ticket are required, ask for "No. 1 — Each Way".

The Place Totalisator will not operate when there are four (4) or less starters and where there are only five (5) to seven (7) starters, only two dividends will be paid. If there are eight (8) or more in a race, dividends will be paid on the horses placed first, second, third.

DOUBLES PRE-SELECTION TOTALISATOR: Doubles totalisator will operate on two consecutive races, viz., the first and second race, the second and third race and so on. The Double investors must ask for the number of the horse they select as the first leg and the number of the horse in the second leg, thus, "No. 1 and No. 4". It is important to mention first the number of the horse in the first race, and second, the number of the horse in the second leg.

When it is desired to purchase a ticket on one horse in one race of the double and on all horses in the other race of the double, the word "Field" is used to include all the horses, and on the ticket appears as the letter "F". To obtain a ticket to include one horse in the first race and all horses in the second race of the double, ask for "No. 1 in the first race, the field in the second race"; or if it is desired to couple all the horses in the first race of the double with one horse in the second race, ask for "The field in the first race, No. 1 in the second race". Double investors are reminded to hold their tickets until the dividend is declared.

QUINELLA TOTALISATOR: This Totalisator is for investors to invest in any selected race for the purpose of nominating the two horses which shall be placed first and second in one and the same race irrespective to which horse is placed first or which horse is placed second in the race on which the Quinella operates. The Quinella Tote operates only when there are four (4) or more starters.

Investors must ask for the numbers of the two horses they select to fill first and second places, asking for the lowest number first. In the case of no investor selecting the first two horses, a dividend may be earned by investors who select the first and third placed horses or second and third placed horses.

Investors should see that they are issued with the correct ticket or dividend before leaving the Totalisator as subsequent claims will not be recognised.

Win, Place, Quinella and Doubles dividends may be collected at any subsequent metropolitan meeting held not later than one (1) month from the date of meeting at which the ticket was purchased, or all classes of totalisator dividends may be collected at the Office of the Commissioner of Stamp Duties, State Government Buildings, Adelaide St., Brisbane, within 3 months after the meeting.

No person under the age of 21 shall be allowed to bet on the Totalisator nor any person on his or her behalf.

Warning bells will be rung at the Totalisator ten minutes and also two minutes before starting time of each race.
