#### RESERVES



To be eligible to compete in the Grand Final of the Championship horses shall start in every Qualifying Division unless exemption is made by the Grand Council of the Inter Dominion Trotting Council.

## INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS SYSTEM

Points shall be awarded to each horses actually starting and finishing a race of a Qualifying Division on the basis that the winner of a race of a Qualifying Division will receive in points the equivalent of the number of horses previously selected by the Host Club as the maximum number of horses to compete in each race of the Qualifying Divisions. The second horses in each race of the Qualifying Divisions will receive the next lower number in points and the third horses will receive the next lower number with each horse finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding horse until the last horse finishing in a maximum field will receive one (1) point.

The winner of each race of a Qualifying Division will receive one (1) bonus point to be added to the points already earned for that race.

There are no points allocated for fastest time.

A horse that is scratched from a race of the Qualifying Divisions or a horse that does not complete the race will not be allocated any points for the race of that Qualifying Division.

In the event of a scratching or a horse not completing the course, points will be allocated as before with the winner and other horses finishing the race entitled to receive their maximum number of points as if a full field had competed and finished the course in that particular race.

In the event of a dead-heat all points of the horses dead-heating shall be added together and equally divided.

The ten horses which gain the greatest aggregate of points shall be eligible to start in the Grand Final.

In the event of two or more horses each scoring equally the minimum number of points entitling them to be eligible for the Grand Final and thereby producing a field exceeding the number designated by the Albion Park Trotting Club or producing a field exceeding the safety number for Albion Park Paceway then the Grand Council shall decide in its discretion which of the horses with equal points shall start in the Grand Final.

Should circumstances warrant such a course of action the Grand Council of the Inter-Dominion Trotting Council shall have the power to increase the number of starters above the designated number and to select the additional starters.

Race 1: ROYAL GARRISON (P. J. Hall) galloped at the start and will continue to be drawn on the outside in standing start

PRINCESS LIGHT (J. L. Young) broke for no apparent reason on the turn out of the back straight during the first lap, and again broke and fell in the same position during the second lap. BAY BRIGADE (R. L. Williams) also broke on the first turn out of the back straight and appeared to be unbalanced by racing in the right-handed direction and failed to complete the course.

HARD TO GET (J. Ilsley) broke and lost ground on the turn out of the back straight soon after the start when racing on the inside of MONARA (D. Dove). An enquiry was opened

and adjourned until after the last race.

Race 2: SPRING MOON (N. Price) galloped at the start causing WILLIAM GUY to check and lose ground. SPRING MOON again broke in running, and a final warning was issued to connections.

STANLEY HANOVER (J. O'Sullivan) crossfired during the running causing him to lug and race ungenerously. The con-

nections were advised to cure him of this habit.

Race 3: TRADER HORN (J. McMullen) galloped at the start and will continue to be drawn on the outside in standing start races.

DEEP COURT (C. Webster) broke as the horses turned into the front straight during the first lap, causing WELCOME ADVICE (A. G. Harpley), which was following, to check and lose considerable ground. A warning was issued to connections of DEEP COURT regarding the horse breaking in races.

ARTANIS (J. Binskin) appeared to force WELCOME ADVICE (A. G. Harpley) to race wider on the track than was necessary on the turn out of the straight during the final lap. Race 4: An enquiry was opened into the running and handling of ROYAL RIVER driven by K. Charlwood, and after hearing evidence from Trainer W. Townsend and Driver Charlwood, the enquiry was adjourned until after the last race.

Race 5: RED VICAR (E. R. Kersley) was slow away, and appeared to race unkindly in the right-handed direction.

Race 6: MERRY FROST (J. Croghan) broke on the turn out of the straight soon after the start when the field was racing tightly, causing BILL BOW (P. J. Hall) which was trailing, to check and lose considerable ground. An enquiry, was held, and after hearing evidence of Drivers J. Croghan (MERRY FROST) and G. McMahon (CLIONA BELLE), Driver G. McMahon was found guilty of contravening Rule 261(a) and his driver's licence was suspended for 4 weeks.

Race 7: ENFIELD PARK (W. Wood) broke on the turn out of the straight during the first lap, causing HENRY SCOTT (K. J. Belford) which was trailing to lose considerable ground.

SMILING SONG (A. Camilleri) whose performance was unsatisfactory was declared ineligible to start at Albion Park

until a satisfactory trial is performed.

Race 8: RAIVANCE (J. McMullen) galloped at the start and will be excluded from the barrier draw in standing starts. RAIVANCE (J. McMullen) also broke again in running, and a warning was issued to the connections.

RESULTS OF ENQUIRIES -

Race 1: After hearing evidence of Driver J. Ilsley (HARD TO GET) and Driver D. Dove (MONARA) and from the Steward's observation, Driver D. Dove was found guilty of contravening Rule 261(a) and his driver's licence was suspended for 4 weeks. Race 6: After hearing evidence of Drivers J. Croghan (MERRY FROST) and G. McMahon (CLIONA BELLE), Driver G. McMahon was found guilty of contravening Rule 261(a), and his driver's licence was suspended for four (4) weeks.

Race 3: Incident concerning ARTANIS and WELCOME ADVICE: As there were extenuating circumstances, no further action was taken other than to advise Driver J. Binskin to use

greater care in future races.

Race 7: Incident concerning ENFIELD PARK and HENRY SCOTT: The Stewards were of the opinion that the incident was caused by ENFIELD PARK (W. Woods) shifting in slightly and HENRY SCOTT (K. Belford) boring out slightly, and making contact. Both driver W. D. Wood and K. J. Belford were severely reprimanded.

Race 4: After hearing further evidence from both Trainer Townsend and Driver K. Charlwood, Trainer W. Townsend's explanation was accepted and no further action was taken against the trainer. Driver K. Charlwood was charged with not allowing the horse ROYAL RIVER to race on its merits in the fourth race, and the enquiry was adjourned until 6.30 p.m. on Wednesday, 24/5/72.

Hopples of horses which broke were checked and found to be of correct length. Films were viewed at enquiries. Winners

were sent to be swabbed.

#### NOTICE TO TOTALISATOR INVESTORS

WIN AND PLACE TOTALISATOR: In all cases, investors must ask for the number of the horse they select thus, "No. 1 — Win"; Place only, —"No. 1 — Place". If a win and a place ticket are required, ask for "No. 1 — Each Way".

The Place Totalisator will not operate when there are four (4) or less starters and where there are only five (5) to seven (7) starters, only two dividends will be paid. If there are eight (8) or more in a race, dividends will be paid on the horses placed first, second, third.

**DOUBLES PRE-SELECTION TOTALISATOR:** Doubles totalisator will operate on two consecutive races, viz., the first and second race, the second and third race and so on. The Double investors must ask for the number of the horse they select as the first leg and the number of the horse in the second leg, thus, "No. 1 and No. 4". It is important to mention first the number of the horse in the first race, and second, the number of the horse in the second leg.

When it is desired to purchase a ticket on one horse in one race of the double and on all horses in the other race of the double, the word "Field" is used to include all the horses, and on the ticket appears as the letter "F". To obtain a ticket to include one horse in the first race and all horses in the second race of the double, ask for "No. 1 in the first race, the field in the second race"; or if it is desired to couple all the horses in the first race of the double with one horse in the second race, ask for "The field in the first race, No. 1 in the second race". Double investors are reminded to hold their tickets until the dividend is declared.

**QUINELLA TOTALISATOR:** This Totalisator is for investors to invest in any selected race for the purpose of nominating the two horses which shall be placed first and second in one and the same race irrespective to which horse is placed first or which horse is placed second in the race on which the Quinella operates. The Quinella Tote operates only when there are four (4) or more starters.

Investors must ask for the numbers of the two horses they select to fill first and second places, asking for the lowest number first. In the case of no investor selecting the first two horses, a dividend may be earned by investors who select the first and third placed horses or second and third placed horses.

Investors should see that they are issued with the correct ticket or dividend before leaving the Totalisator as subsequent claims will not be recognised.

Win, Place, Quinella and Doubles dividends may be collected at any subsequent metropolitan meeting held not later than one (1) month from the date of meeting at which the ticket was purchased, or all classes of totalisator dividends may be collected at the Office of the Commissioner of Stamp Duties, State Government Buildings, Adelaide St., Brisbane, within 3 months after the meeting.

No person under the age of 21 shall be allowed to bet on the Totalisator nor any person on his or her behalf.

Warning bells will be rung at the Totalisator ten minutes and also two minutes before starting time of each race.
