STEWARDS' REPORTS

GLOBE DERBY PARK — SATURDAY, 14th FEBRUARY, 1976

Race 1 Benson & Hedges Inter-Dominion Trotters Champ. (Cons)

ARMBRO TIME (C. Hurley) paced shortly after the start and lost position when checked back to a trot.

BRIGHT CIRCLE (B. Gath) was slow to begin and then broke shortly after the start, this horse broke twice in running, on the last occasion it hung badly and hit the running rail when the field was sprinting away and it could not keep up and the horse was eventually pulled up.

PETER PILADE (P. Connole) and SIR VOLO (R. Jacques) broke under pressure with approximately 400 metres to run.

TRAIL OF GOLD (B. Nolan) broke under pressure on the last turn.

FRAMALDA was a late scratching at 11.30 a.m. due to an injured near fore pastern, the late scratching occurred because K. Newman fulfilled commitments at HAROLD PARK on the previous evening and could not return to South Australia prior to 11.30 a.m.

Race 2 Singapore Airlines Three-years-old Stakes

SINGLE AGAIN (C. Martin) struck its knee in running and broke gait.

BILL'S BEAUTY (T. Kelly) did not adequately fill its position at the start and has been declared out of future mobile barrier draws.

R. Sweet (VIENNA STAR) was directed to use the foot rest at all times in future and not the cross bar.

Race 3 Ansett Airlines Graduation Stakes

KAHLUA ADIOS (A. Bray) and KAMEKO (W. Butterworth) missed the start.

DEEP END (S. Barbaro) hung both outward and inward continually in running, at one stage allowing GILLIGAN (R. Glasgow) a run inside, it was barred from racing until after midnight on February 28th, 1976 to enable a cure to be effected.

Race 4 Benson & Hedges Inter-Dominion Pacers Champ. (8th Qual. Div.).

On the first turn AL'S HOLIDAY (K. Newman) hung down against the efforts of its driver and locked wheels with IRISH RETURN (M. Paddon), this put a buckle into the wheel of AL'S HOLIDAY and later the rim snapped spearing through the stay causing a seizure and AL'S HOLIDAY was pulled up.

K. Pocock (ROYAL GAZE) and K. Robinson (TRUANT ARMAGH) were both fined \$10 for allowing their horses to drift off in the run home.

After an enquiry into an alleged incident in the back straight on the last occasion A. C. Lewis (CARCLEW) was found not guilty on a careless driving charge.

Race 5 Benson & Hedges Inter-Dominion Trotters Champ. (Grand Final).

STORMY MEADOW (M. Paddon) ROCKIN DALE (C. Redwood) and TOUCH MERCHANT (G. Wilson) all broke in running.

K. Rawiller (EL CORDOBIES) was fined \$10 for allowing his horse to drift off in the run home.

C. De Fillipi (CEE AR) was suspended from driving at licensed trotting meetings until after midnight on February 21st, 1976, for coming out too late on EL CORDOBIES (K. Rawiller) with just over two laps to travel causing EL CORDOBIES to lose position and race three deep.

HOMAGE (H. Young) missed the start.

DERBY ROYALE (J. Treloar) stopped quickly with about 400 metres to travel and finished a disappointing last, it was noted that this horse was used up considerably to get to the front from TOPEKA and that EL CORDOBIES applied strong pressure with 600 metres to run. Driver J. Treloar felt that this may have been responsible for the weakening.

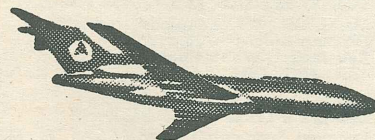

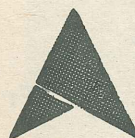

THE INTERDOMINION PACING CHAMPIONSHIP

In 1925 James Breenan originated an event, the Australasian Championship, which was run in Perth in 1925 and 1926. The event was then disbanded owing to the depression years.

Mr. James P. Stratton revived the idea in Perth in 1936 with a few changes in format. The series became known as the Interdominion Pacing Championship.

The first Championship was run in Perth and won by Logan Derby, driven by J. Agnew. The Grand Final Prizemoney was \$3,000. This year the Grand Final is worth \$60,500.

The Interdominion Championship Final is recognized as the Melbourne Cup of Trotting, but unlike that race, because of the qualifying divisions it is impossible to look through the winners and find anything but a Champion as the winner.

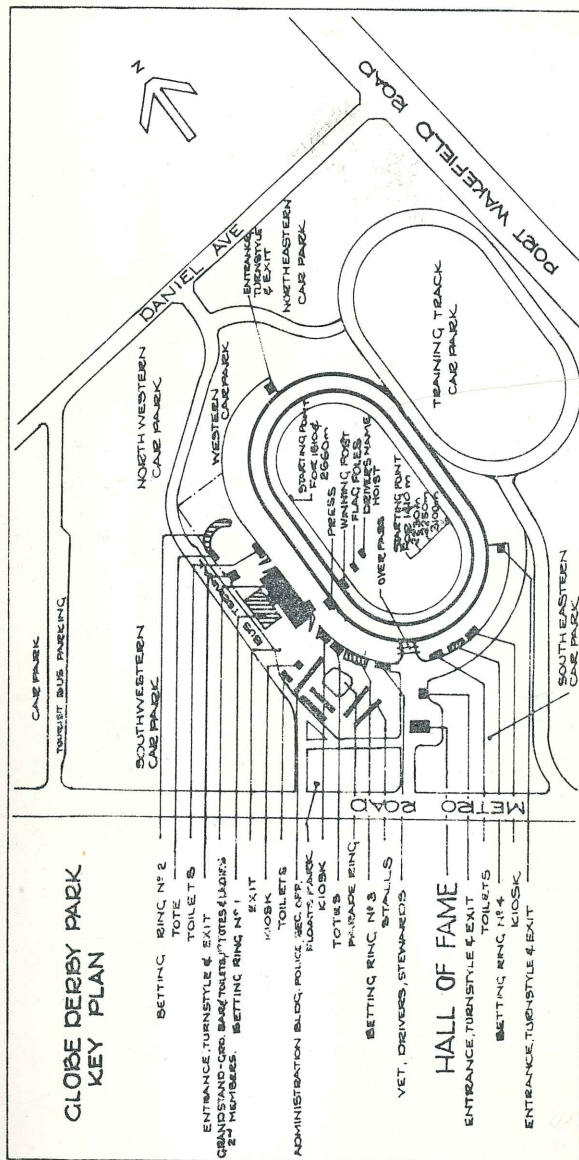

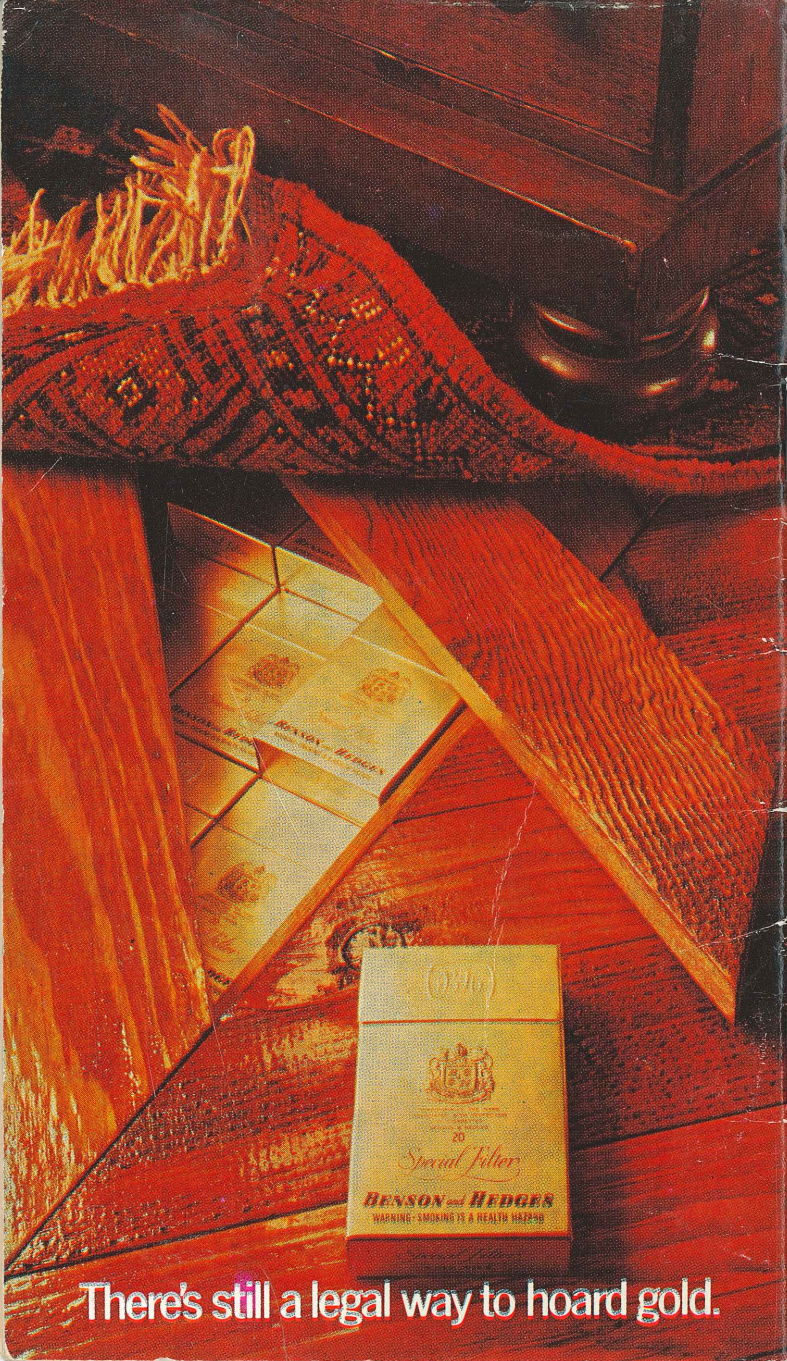
