The second Horse in each of the Qualifying Divisions will receive the next lower number in points and the third Horse will receive the next lower number with each Horse actually finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding Horse until the Last Horse finishing in a maximum field will receive one (1) point.

The winner of each Qualifying Division will receive one bonus point to be added to the points already earned by the winner of that Division.
