# STEWARDS' REPORT

WEDNESDAY, 8th MARCH, 1978

Prior to the commencement of racing this evening, the Stewards interviewed Mr. P. Coulson, trainer-driver of "Pure Steel", and Mr. R. Roberts, owner of "Pure Steel". Mr. Coulson was questioned by Stewards regarding the change of race tactics employed with "Pure Steel" in his qualifying division of the Championships on Saturday night as compared with his previous races in Melbourne. Coulson explained that he had driven "Pure Steel" in his last four starts prior to the Hunter Cup, of which he had won two races and been second once, and on each occasion he had employed tactics similar to those which he employed on Saturday evening. Coulson further explained that he did not have a particular race plan, and he had not made an early move with the horse as had been made with him in the Hunter Cup, because of the fast early pace set in this division in which he was out of the barrier draw. Secondly, he had not been positioned to make a run up to the leaders, such as "Pure Steel" had made in the "Hunter Cup" when the pace was somewhat slower in the early part of the race. The Stewards informed Coulson that, whilst accepting his explanation, they expected him to inform them when drastic changes were intended as compared with the

way the horse had been previously driven.

The Stewards also questioned Mr. Roberts, owner of "Pure Steel", in relation to statements published in the Press and attributed to him. Whilst Mr. Roberts did not deny some of the statements attributed to him, he complained to the Stewards that his remarks had been published out of context, and he had been most disturbed by them. Mr. Roberts further informed the Stewards that he had supported "Pure Steel" heavily to win on Saturday night last. This was established

to the satisfaction of the Stewards

**ELWICK HANDICAP:** "Kentucky Charger" (T. Demmler) broke shortly after the start, and "Rowan Crest" (K. Newbound) began badly.

Warnings were issued.

Turning out of the home straight on the first occasion, "Kentucky Charger" (T. Demmler) broke and shifted ground, causing "Barbarian Boy" (N. Diebert) to be checked outwards on to "Southern Sands" (R. Long), causing this horse to be checked also. The Stewards informed Demmler that they will recommend to the Board that the nomination of "Kentucky Charger" be refused for four

weeks on all courses for unsatisfactory race behaviour. (Rule 10(L).)
Turning out of the back straight on the first occasion, "Butleigh" (T. Mahar)
commenced to hang and tighten "Yarra Valley" (R. Demmler). As Mahar
attempted to straighten "Butleigh", this horse broke. A warning was issued.
Approaching the winning post, "Southern Sands" (R. Long), which was leading
clearly, propped at the photo finish lights, and as a result was overtaken close to the line by "Magnus Byrd" (D. Guy). R. Long, trainer-driver of "Southern Sands", informed the Stewards that "Southern Sands" had not behaved in this fashion before, and sought permission to use a shadow roll in future. The

Stewards granted Long's request.

INTER-DOMINION TROTTING CHAMPIONSHIP (First Qualifying Race of the Second Qualifying Divisions): "Weeona Dancer" (R. Cunninghame) broke shortly after entering the home straight on the last occasion, and again broke approaching the finishing post.
"Billboard" (G. Lang) broke in the home straight on the last occasion.

"Waipounamu" (P. Jones) broke approaching the home turn on the last occasion. Warnings were issued.

Routine swab samples were taken from "Storm Rider" (N. Shinn) and "Touch

Merchant" (G. Wilson), first and second placegetters in the event.

INTER-DOMINION PACING CHAMPIONSHIP (First Qualifying Race of the Second Series Qualifying Divisions): The Board's Veterinary Surgeon, Dr. B. Gilbo, examined "Don't Retreat" prior to payment time, and declared the horse fit to start. Dr. Gilbo again examined "Don't Retreat" at the completion of this horse's preliminary.

"Dimante Hanover" (Tr. Hutchings) will be re-included in the barrier draw.
P. Jones "Regal Light" lost his whip at the straight entrance on the last occasion. When queried as to the reason for dropping his whip, P. Jones explained that he was having difficulty using cane whips to which he was unaccustomed, and that they did not have the balance of the whips which he was accustomed to using in New Zealand.

"Nixon Adios" (F. Kersley) broke under pressure in the home straight.
It was noted that "Apre Ski" (B. Gath) was held up for a run in the concluding stages

It was noted that "Don't Retreat" (L. Moulds) shifted ground under pressure in the home straight.

# TRIFECTA BETTING

In the other form if a person selects three horses on which he wishes to invest and decides to couple the six possible finishing combinations of these horses it is not necessary to take six individual tickets. He can take the six combinations on one ticket which is known as a BOX TRIFECTA at a cost of \$6.00 per ticket.
