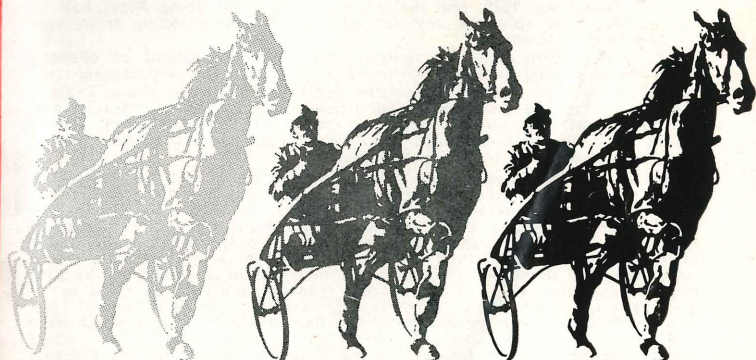

NEW ZEALAND TROTTING CONFERENCE

In pursuance and exercise of the power contained in section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, the New Zealand Trotting Conference resolves to and does hereby make, the following rules controlling the admission of persons to all race courses used by racing clubs which are now or may at any time hereafter be registered with the said New Zealand Trotting Conference.

RULES

(Under the Racing Act 1971)

1. These rules shall come into force on the day after the day on which they are published in the "New Zealand Gazette".
2. In these rules the words "racecourse", "racing club", and "race meeting" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by section 2 of the Racing Act 1971, and the word "bookmaker" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto by the Gaming Act 1908, or any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution of such Act.
3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from all racecourses used by racing clubs which are or may at any time hereafter be registered with the New Zealand Trotting Conference while such racecourses, or any thereof, are being used by any club for a race meeting, namely:
 - (a) All persons under disqualification imposed under the New Zealand Rules of Racing or the New Zealand Rules of Trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside New Zealand, which have reciprocal agreements in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or the New Zealand Trotting Conference;
 - (b) Bookmakers;
 - (c) Persons convicted of theft, burglary, receiving stolen goods, robbery, unlawful taking or conversion of a motor car or other vehicle, false pretences, forgery, utterings, possession of counterfeit coin, or assault;
 - (d) Persons convicted of any offence under the Gaming Act 1908, or of any of the following offences under the Crimes Act 1961: murder, attempted murder, manslaughter (not based on negligence), sections 188-204 (which relate to assaults and injuries to the person), sections 294-297 (which relate to arson or attempt thereof), crimes involving dishonesty or conspiracy to commit a crime, indecent acts, sexual offences, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
 - (e) Persons convicted of an offence against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Narcotics Act 1965, or against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
 - (f) Persons convicted in countries outside New Zealand of offences corresponding to those mentioned in paragraph (d) or paragraph (e).

Provided always that a committee established by the New Zealand Racing and Trotting Conferences upon being satisfied as to character and otherwise that any person who, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of these rules should have relief from the effect thereof may grant exemption to any such person.

4. The rules previously made by the New Zealand Trotting Conference under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the "New Zealand Gazette", of 22 November 1973, on p. 2438, and which were deemed to have been revoked at midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976, have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time before midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976. In every other respect such revoked rules thereafter have no effect. The rules previously made by the New Zealand Trotting Conference under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the "New Zealand Gazette", and shall thereafter have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time between midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976 and midnight on the day on which these rules are published in the said "Gazette". In every other respect such revoked rules shall thereafter have no effect.

PHOTO FINISH

When "Photo" appears on the results board, there will be a short delay in posting the placed horses to allow the Judge to inspect a photograph of the finish.

Later, photographs will be exhibited at the west end of the doubles Totalisator and the west side of the Members' Stand.

BUGLE CALL

A bugle call will be sounded over the public address system when the field leaves the Birdcage.

LAP BELL

As a warning to drivers the lap bell (situated at the top of the straight) will be sounded when the field has one more round of the track to go.

SIREN

Patrons are advised that a siren will be sounded if an inquiry is to be held, the result of which might affect the placings of the horses.

ADMISSION: \$2

Children under 15 years of age, accompanied by a guardian, will be admitted to the course free of charge.

TOTALISATOR INFORMATION

Win and Place Dividends will be paid as follows:
WIN—on the first horse only.

PLACE

FOUR or fewer totalisator numbers: No Place dividend.
FIVE, SIX or SEVEN totalisator numbers: Two dividends.
EIGHT or more totalisator numbers: Three dividends.

QUINELLA TOTALISATOR

In Quinella Betting, you select two horses to run first and second, in EITHER ORDER, in the same race.

The amount available for dividend shall be distributed as follows:

- Amongst the holders of tickets on the combination of horses placed first and second equally and if no ticket is held on this combination;
- Amongst holders of tickets on the combinations of horses placed first and third equally and if no ticket is held on either of the preceding combinations;
- Amongst the holders of tickets on the combination of horses placed second and third equally.
- In the event of bracketed horses filling any of the first three placings the lower placed horse of the bracket shall be superseded by the next following placed horse.

Late Scratching—Should a late scratching occur after the Quinella Totalisator has opened and the horse scratched is not bracketed with another horse which is a starter the bet is off and the investor may change his ticket or claim a refund if the stewards so permit.

Full Quinella Regulations are displayed on the main doubles Totalisator.

EXCHANGE CONCESSION DOUBLE (Races 6 and 8)

Double Tickets may be purchased at the Main Double Totalisator, and from the booth on the ground floor of the Public Stand.

Tickets for the Double will be sold for the horse chosen to win the first leg of the Double up to the time of the closing of the Totalisator for that Race.

Holders of winning tickets on the First Leg must exchange their tickets for the horse or horses they wish to support for the second leg of the Double.

HOLDERS OF \$10, \$2 and \$1 WINNING TICKETS ON THE FIRST LEG OF THE DOUBLE MAY EXCHANGE THEM FOR \$1, or 50c TICKETS ON THE SECOND LEG.

Investors failing to exchange their winning tickets on the First Leg of the Double before the Double Totalisator closes for the Second Leg of the Double shall have no further interest or claim in or upon any amount invested and shall not be entitled to any refund.

If there be a dead-heat the right of holders of tickets on the Starters so dead-heating shall be determined in accordance with the regulations.

Full double regulations are displayed on the main doubles totalisator.

ON COURSE TWO EXCHANGE TREBLE (Races 1, 3 and 4)

Treble Tickets on the First Leg only may be purchased at the Main Treble Totalisator and from the booth on the ground floor of the Public Stand.

Tickets for the Treble will be sold for the horse chosen to win the first leg of the Treble.

HOLDERS OF \$10, \$2 AND \$1 WINNING TICKETS ON THE FIRST LEG OF THE TREBLE MAY EXCHANGE THEM FOR \$1 TICKETS ON THE SECOND LEG.

Holders of winning tickets on the First Leg must exchange their tickets for the horse or horses they wish to support for the second leg of the Treble.

Holders of winning tickets on the Second Leg must exchange their tickets for the horse or horses they wish to support for the third leg of the Treble.

Investors failing to exchange their winning tickets on the First or Second Legs of the Treble before the Treble Totalisator closes for the Second or Third Legs respectively shall have no further interest or claim in or upon any amount invested and shall not be entitled to any refund.

If there be a dead-heat the right of holders of tickets on the Starters so dead-heating shall be determined in accordance with the regulations.

Full Treble regulations are available for inspection in the Secretary's office.

WARNING: Patrons are cautioned to hold Trebles tickets until payout of dividends is officially announced.

PAYOUT

QUINELLA AND WIN/PLACE DIVIDENDS WILL BE PAID AT ALL \$2
AND \$1 PAYOUT WINDOWS

Treble Dividends will be paid at specially marked windows at the rear of the main Doubles Totalisator.

Concession Doubles dividends will be paid through the Doubles selling windows.

CLOSING OF TOTALISATOR—Three minutes after the sounding of the intermittent signal over the public address system the Totalisator will close.

PAYMENT OF LATE DIVIDENDS—The late dividend windows for \$50, \$10, \$2 and \$1 tickets on all races will close at the start of the last race.

Patrons are requested to collect dividends after each race. Those unable to collect on the course may do so at the Office of the N.Z. Metropolitan Trotting Club (Inc.), Addington Raceway, end of Twigger Street, Addington, from Thursday, 15th March. Hours: 10 a.m.-4 p.m.

Registration of letters containing Totalisator tickets is advised, if contents are valued at \$10 or less. Insurance is recommended if value exceeds \$10. Claimant's name should be written on the back of all tickets.

WARNING—Investors should see that the proper change, ticket, or dividend is received before leaving the window.

In no circumstances will claims for dividends on lost or destroyed totalisator tickets be entertained.

The selling windows for all Pools will close simultaneously each race.

T.A.B. INVESTMENTS

Patrons are advised that the T.A.B. selling figures will be transmitted to the On-Course Totalisator as follows:—

50 minutes prior to race start time approximately 60% of T.A.B. betting will be transmitted.

The final total will be transmitted 6 minutes prior to race start time.

UNRULY HORSES

If the word unruly appears in place of the Barrier Draw, it means that that particular horse has been declared unruly by the Stipendiary Stewards and such horse shall start from a second line on the extreme outside from behind and clear of the front line horses.

If there are other horses on the second line the horse or horses so declared unruly shall start on the extreme outside of the second line and clear of the front and second line horses.

CONDITIONS GOVERNING INTER DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIPS

MAXIMUM HANDICAP MARKS:

For both Pacing and Trotting events the maximum handicap marks will be as under:

- 2600 metres — 10 metres behind
- 3200 metres — 20 metres behind

RE-HANDICAPS:

After handicaps have been declared for the Championship Events any horse so handicapped subsequently winning a race at any other meeting in Australia or New Zealand to the value of \$50,000 or more to the winner may be re-handicapped for the Championship events with the approval of the Executive of the New Zealand Trotting Conference. In no case other than the above stated will a horse's mark be altered after the declaration of handicaps, errors and omissions excepted.

QUALIFYING RACES (Or heats of same):

(a) The aim of the Championship Programme Committee is that there will be not more than three heats in any Qualifying race and not be more than twelve horses in any one heat. The Committee reserve the right to vary these figures.

(b) In the event of the number of acceptors exceeding the number of horses permitted to start in the Qualifying races for the Championship the Championship Programme Committee shall select up to ten horses which shall be given the right of re-entry until 3 p.m. Monday, 5th March, 1979. No right of re-entry shall be given after this date.

Heats of Qualifying Races will be run as separate races and the Totalisator will be open on each heat separately.

POINTS SYSTEM:

Qualifying points for the Championship Grand Final shall be awarded to each horse actually starting and finishing a race of the Qualifying Divisions on the basis that the winner of a race of a Qualifying Division will receive in points the equivalent of the number of horses previously selected by the New Zealand Metropolitan Trotting Club (Inc.) as the maximum number of horses to compete in any race of the Qualifying Divisions. The second horses in each race of the Qualifying Divisions will receive the next lower number in points and the third horses will receive the next lower number with each horse actually finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding horse until the last horse finishing in a maximum field will receive one (1) point.

The winner of each race of a Qualifying Division will receive one (1) bonus point to be added to the points already earned by the winner of that race.

There will be no points awarded for fastest time. A horse that is scratched from a race of the Qualifying Division or a horse that does not complete a race will not be awarded any points for that race.

In the event of a scratching or a horse not completing the course points will be awarded as before with the winner and other horses finishing the race entitled to receive their maximum number of points as if a full field had competed and finished the course in that particular race.

In the event of a dead heat all points of the horses dead heating shall be added together and equally divided among the horses dead heating.

The judge shall place all horses in a race according to the order in which their noses reached the winning post.

In each Qualifying Division the same number of maximum points shall be allocated irrespective of the actual number of starters and irrespective of the variation of the number of divisions on each day or night of racing.

The twelve (12) horses which gain the greatest aggregate of points shall be eligible to start in the Grand Final, but should circumstances warrant such a course of action the Grand Council of the Inter-Dominion Council shall have the power to increase the numbers of starters above the designated number and to select the additional starters.

In the event of two or more horses each scoring equally the minimum number of points entitling them to be eligible for the Grand Final and thereby producing a field exceeding the number designated by the New Zealand Metropolitan Trotting Club (Inc.) or producing a field exceeding the safety number permitted for Addington Raceway, then the Grand Council shall decide in its discretion which of the horses with equal points shall start in the Grand Final.

Points shall be allotted to all contestants in the Grand Final in the same manner as for a Qualifying Division. The points gained by each horse competing in the Grand Final shall be added to those already obtained by such horses in the Qualifying Divisions and to the horse which obtains the greatest total of points in the Qualifying Divisions and the Grand Final a stake of \$5000 shall be paid. In the event of two or more horses having an equal number of points after the Qualifying Divisions and the Grand Final, the stake of \$5000 shall be divided equally between them.

The Championship Programme Committee shall be the sole judge of which horses are entitled to start in the Consolation Race.

HORSES ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THE GRAND FINAL:

To be eligible to compete in the Grand Final horses shall start in each Qualifying Race unless exemption is made by the Grand Council who shall decide upon each case according to its merits.

SPECIAL GENERAL CONDITIONS GOVERNING INTER DOMINION PACING AND TROTTING CHAMPIONSHIPS

- (1) All races will be run, and all proceedings in connection therewith, conducted under the New Zealand Rules of Trotting and subject to these conditions and to the Regulations laid down by the Inter Dominion Trotting Council.
- (2) Subject to the previous consent of the President of the New Zealand Trotting Conference the Committee of the New Zealand Metropolitan Trotting Club (Inc.) will have the right to:
 - (a) Alter the order in which races on any programme are advertised to be run.
 - (b) Alter the limit, the stake, or any of the conditions of any of the races.
 - (c) Cancel the Championships events in which case all money received will be refunded.
 - (d) Increase or decrease the number of Heats in the Qualifying Races and the number of Consolation Races and amend the number of other events on the programme to retain a maximum of nine races.
- (3) The Committee of the New Zealand Metropolitan Trotting Club (Inc.) reserves the right to reject the nomination of any horse in which case the decision of the Committee will be final and binding on all parties.
- (4) The Committee of the New Zealand Metropolitan Trotting Club (Inc.) reserves the right to select the horses to start in the Inter Dominion Championships.
- (5) **Handicapping Penalties:**

Winners of Inter Dominion Championship Qualifying Division races, Consolation Race and the Grand Final shall be penalised in accordance with the Handicapping Regulations of the Country in which the horse races.
- (6) Wherever a scratching occurs after the barrier draw of a Division, Consolation or Final, no horse shall change his barrier position or line because of such scratching, provided that where a scratching does occur on the front line horses shall have their positions adjusted so as to close up all gaps left by the scratchings.

STIPENDIARY STEWARD'S REPORT

NEW ZEALAND METROPOLITAN TROTTING CLUB (INC.)

FIRST NIGHT — SATURDAY, 10th MARCH, 1979

Weather: Fair.

Track: Firm.

Race 1—Inter Dominion Pacing Championship. First Qualifying Race. (First Heat):

GOLD RAND, ROYAL WALDORF, TOM PEPPER and ICE WISE all made bad beginnings. After 300 metres BELMER'S IMAGE touched a wheel, and broke momentarily causing JAUNTY HANOVER to check and break. A. K. Holmes and W. R. Butt were questioned regarding the incident and no further action was taken, as A. K. Holmes had attempted to restrain his horse.

Race 2—Inter Dominion Trotting Championship. First Qualifying Race. (First Heat):

SCOTCH TAR and GYPSENELLI both broke at the start and after approximately 350 metres ILSA VOSS broke causing a check to FABIAN who also went off stride. Others to break on the journey were RELINQUISH and MISS CASTLETON which broke in the run home.

Race 3—Hutt Park Handicap:

ALENA ran out at the start causing a check to SEAFIELD ROSE, the latter receiving a further check when ALEC PETERSON ran out when in a break. GLOBAL GIRL was observed to be running on but was unable to improve due to the packed nature of the field over the concluding stages.

Race 4—C. S. Donald Memorial Stakes (Mobile Start):

P. Young was questioned regarding the performance of GANELON. This horse stopped with approximately 600 metres to run. P. Young stated that the horse hung badly throughout the contest and though he had worked well on Wednesday was unable to account for the horse's poor performance. CROSSFIRE stopped badly after sprinting hard twice during the running. This horse was observed to be hanging badly throughout the contest and in reply to questioning from the Judicial Committee, trainer/driver T. F. Thompson stated that the horse had raced at the trials on Wednesday and had started to hang at that meeting and as he had raced so badly he would be withdrawing it from Wednesday night and would see how the horse did in the next few days as to whether or not it would start again at the meeting.

Race 5—Inter Dominion Trotting Championship. First Qualifying Race. (Second Heat):

FIRST PRIZE and MARSHA DONNA both broke at the start losing all chance. An enquiry was opened and adjourned until the second night into the tightening of ABOUT NOW and NO RESPONSE with approximately 1400 metres to run. SHARMBRO broke free of interference in the run home.

Race 6—Inter Dominion Pacing Championship. First Qualifying Race. (Second Heat):

The connections of LORD MODULE were issued with a warning to improve this horse's barrier manners. This horse broke at the start losing all chance. MAIN STAR swung outwards, this causing a severe check to SCOTTISH HEATH. GEMINI BOY broke free of interference. With approximately 400 metres to run VAN JAMES and TORLE both broke, this causing a check to MR SPYRO. An enquiry was opened and adjourned until the 2nd night due to the unavailability of drivers.

Race 7—Graduation Stakes:

Horses to break at the start were BRASE, WISH ME LUCK, CROCKETT WOOD and TROPEZ, as did EL GUAGO for a few strides. T. F. Thompson, trainer of WAI EYRE, stated that this horse, which raced disappointingly, would be turned out. GAME ADIOS was found to be lame in the near fore leg in the preliminary and was scratched on veterinary advice.

Race 8—Inter Dominion Pacing Championship. First Qualifying Race. (Third Heat):

SUN SEEKER and BAD LUCK were horses to make mistakes at the start, BAD LUCK breaking again during the running.

Race 9—Moonee Valley Stakes (Mobile Start):

All clear.

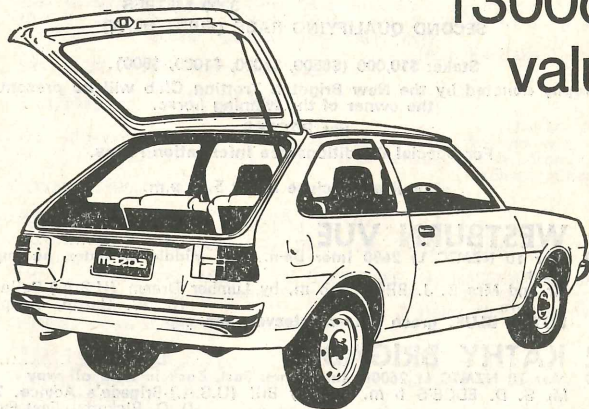

Multiply his starts by nine.

Multiply his wins by nine.

Multiply his seconds by five.

Multiply his thirds by three.

Combine the totals for wins, seconds and thirds and divide it by the number of starts.

The formula makes two seconds worth slightly more than one win, a second and a third worth just less than a win and three thirds an equal amount as one win.
