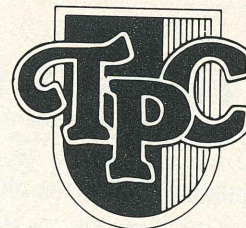

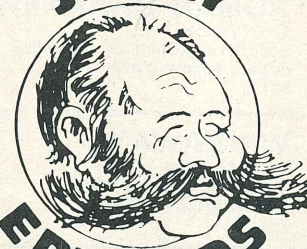

## INFORMATION RELATING TO BETTING WITH BOOKMAKERS

Bookmakers will display odds on offer for each horse at least 15 minutes before the starting time for each race.

**Win Only** When a bookmaker displays this sign it means that the odds displayed are for a win only.

**Win and Place** (each way) When this sign is displayed it means that you may bet for a win only or win and place about each horse in that race.

In a win and place bet the odds for a place where there are eight or more horses in the race when the wager is made shall be one fourth of the odds for a win, and where there are not less than five nor more than seven horses in the race when the wager is laid, shall be one third of the odds for a win. Where there are eight or more horses in the race a place bet is payable for first second and third and where there are not less than five or more than seven horses a place bet is payable on first and second only.

**Bookmakers Liability** Under the Racing and Gaming Regulations the minimum and maximum bets that a bookmaker must accept are as follows:—

- (1) **Minimum Bet** A bookmaker shall, if required to do so by a bettor, lay odds to the sum of 40 cents or, in the case of a win and place bet to the sum of 40 cents each way.
- (2) **Maximum Bet** A bookmaker shall lay the odds on offer to not less than \$20 if demanded by the taker, but so that the bookmaker is not obliged to lose more than \$200 on any wager demanded by the bettor.

**Placing Your Bet** When placing your bet clearly state the name of the horse and the amount that you intend to wager and listen carefully to the bet being called by the clerk to ensure that it is recorded as you intend. The bookmaker will then issue you with your ticket which will indicate the details of your bet. Ensure that you receive your correct change and ticket.

**Collecting Your Bet** Winning bets may be collected immediately after the correct weight or all clear signal has been given. Present your ticket to the bookmaker with whom you placed your bet.

**Lost Ticket** Should you lose your betting ticket immediately seek the advice of the bookmakers supervisor. He may be contacted through the Secretary's office. The following details will be required:—

- (a) Name of Bookmaker
- (b) Name of horse
- (c) Amount of wager
- (d) Odds of horse on offer at time of placing your bet
- (e) Ticket number, if possible
- (f) Any other information that may be helpful in support of your claim e.g. bet placed before yours.

**Interstate Betting** Bookmakers betting on interstate races are required to bet for a win and place provided that there are eight or more horses in the race and the odds on offer are not less than even money.

**Complaints** There is a bookmakers supervisor on course to provide assistance in the settlement of disputes. He may be contacted through the Secretary's office.

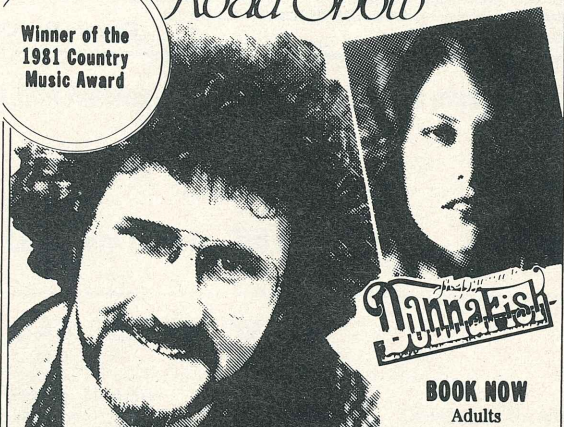

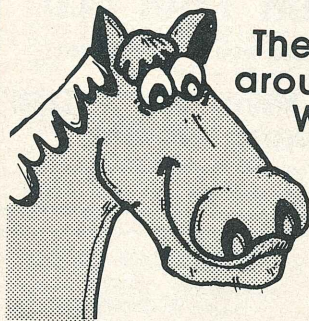
