he New South Wales Trotting Club purchased the Glebe circuit in 1911 from the Metropolitan Rugby Union for £10,400.

The track was known as Epping until 21st March 1929, when due to confusion of the name with that of a well-known Sydney suburb, it was renamed Harold Park, after Childe Harold (Imp), one of the great progenitors of the stock of the early night trotting days.

Childe Harold was bred in Kentucky and was imported from Glasgow, Scotland, by Mr Andrew Town of Richmond, New South Wales.

The progress since then has reached heights undreamt of by those who attended Harold Park's inaugural meeting in 1902, and from its early obscurity Harold Park has become known world-wide as the venue of one of Australia's most spectacular night entertainments.



MOBILE STARTING PROCEDURES

Effective from 1st October 1986

The Procedures are:

- 1. The run-up behind the gate will be 300 metres.
- 2. During the first 100 metres the gate will accelerate to approximately 20km. per hour, and for the next 100 metres will accelerate to approximately 30km per hour, before accelerating for the final 100 metres to the release point. When a particular speed has been reached in a score-up there shall be no decrease except in the case of a false start.

"In the event of a track being rain effected, the mobile barrier starter may on approval from the Chief Steward reduce the score-up speeds".

- Where a horse offends in the first score-up causing a false start it will remain in its alloted position.
- Where the same horse offends on the second score-up causing a false start it will be "Scratched".
- In the event of a false start drivers must return to the starting point as quickly as possible (at a pace or trot). Any driver dismounting from his sulky without the starter's permission will be deemed to be wasting time and be duly dealt
- In the event of a horse not taking up its place at the start the stewards may apply Rule 591 of the Rules of Harness Racing
- Scratchings In the event of a scratching or scratchings, no gaps will be left in either line and no horse will move from the back line to the front line unless there are fewer horses on the front line than on the back line.

The only exception to this regulation is when reserves are drawn in a race and on these occasions barrier positions shall be determined at 9.30 am race day for T.A.B. meetings. Also, when fewer horses remain on the front line as against the back line, the front line shall be filled.

FALSE STARTS

- (i) A false start will only be declared if:-
 - (a) A horse causes interference to another runner.
 - (b) A horse falls prior to the starting point.
 - (c) A horse breaks gear prior to the starting point.
 - (d) A horse scores-up in front of the gate.
- * PLEASE NOTE: A horse which has galloped away and does not cause a false start will be considered to be a starter and the field will be despatched without that horse.

PENALTIES

FIRST OFFENDERS

- (a) A horse which causes a false start or which fails to take up its allotted position will automatically be stood down until it requalifies from behind the Mobile, and is also made an ODM horse.
- (b) If this is the horse's first offence, it will remain out of the draw for its next two starts and then may re-enter the draw provided it performs satisfactorily.
- (c) A horse which causes 2 false starts in an event and is consequently withdrawn will be stood down 3 Mobile Trials, two of which must be Re-Qualifying trials and is re-classified as an ODM horse.

PREVIOUS OFFENDERS (ODM Horse)

- (a) A horse which has previously caused a false start but then scored-up satisfactorily on the second occasion, and has again behaved in a similar manner at another meeting within a period of two months will be automatically stood down 4 Mobile Trials, two to be Re-Qualifying trials and is re-classified as an RODM horse.
- (b) A horse which has previously behaved intractably behind the mobile and was subsequently withdrawn and on returning to licensed

meetings causes a further false start will be automatically stood down 6 Mobile Trials, two to be Re-Qualifying trials, and is re-classified as an RODM horse. When the trials are completed, the horse is required to perform satisfactorily at 2 non-TAB meetings before being allowed to accept for TAB meetings.

REQUALIFYING

Previous offenders from the mobile attempting to re-qualify MUST do so from the front row of the mobile barrier and must be drawn with a horse on either side

RE-INCLUSION OF HORSES INTO THE DRAW

- (a) **ODM Horses** (with the exception of first offenders): Application will only be considered after 3 satisfactory performances at licensed meetings.
- (b) RODM Horses: Consideration of a re-classification to ODM will only be considered after 5 satisfactory performances at licensed meétinas.

RACE ACCIDENTS

The Stipendiary Stewards are concerned that further injury may occur to drivers and horses involved in accidents if patrons move on to the racetrack.

The Stewards are aware that members of the public have the best of intentions, but point out that there are laid down procedures in the event of accidents.

These procedures involve officials and horsemen experienced in these emergencies as well as medical and ambulance officers who are on standby.

This request is a direction from the Chairman of Stipendiary Stewards and patrons are respectfully urged to co-operate.

NEW SOUTH WALES HARNESS RACING CLUB LTD. **ABANDONED MEETINGS**

Should the Board of Directors be compelled by circumstances beyond its control, to order a meeting to be abandoned after the public has been admitted, the following procedure will apply:-

- (1) If less than four races have been conducted at the time of abandonment, each patron will receive at the exits from the Course, a ticket carrying the privilege of free admission to the next Friday/Tuesday meeting, or -
- (2) If four or more races on the programme have been run, no issue of tickets will be By order of the Board of Directors.

SIGNALS PROTESTS

will be announced immediately after the finish of a race, and also displayed by a red light on the semaphore, and the sounding of a beepbeep warning sound on the public address system.

ALL-CLEAR AND PAY SIGNALS

will be the showing of a green light on the semaphore and the sounding of a siren. **EMERGENCY (CLUB'S) COLOURS**

FIRST SET - RED and GREEN HALVES, GREEN CAP

SECOND SET - WHITE, GREEN STAR, WHITE CAP

These Colours will be worn by Drivers in all races where a change of colour is necessary.

STEWARDS REPORTS

Harold Park, Friday, 26th February, 1988

STEWARDS: Mr. R. Nebauer (Chairman of Stewards), Mr. P. Archer (Deputy Chairman of Stewards), Mr. R. Bottle, Mr. B. Lowe (Starter-Steward), Mr. D. Moylan (Bookmakers Steward), Mr. G. Allen (Trainee).

SCRATCHINGS: The following horses were withdrawn after final acceptance time for veterinary reasons and were stood down from competing at licensed meetings under Rule 238(d) for the periods as stated: 28 days — GILDA, BAHADUR. 7 days — HAPPY SUNRISE (withdrawn at 6.42 p.m.), BLUE GRASS SPECIAL (at 2.18 p.m.).

GEAR CHANGES: KARAMEA CHRISTMAS to race in slightly longer hopples. CHEROKEE CHIEF and FARM COVE to race in a tongue tie. PARDON ME BOYS to race in removeable earplugs.

RACE 1 T.L.E. PACE (1,609 METRES) — RATTLETRACK (D. Wilson), which had drawn the rails on the second line, galloped early in the score-up, resulting in the horse being well out of position when a start was effected, taking no competitive part in the event, and finishing distanced. When questioned, trainer-driver D. Wilson explained that RATTLETRACK had been in a piggish mood during the afternoon, had travelled badly to the course, and that just prior to galloping he had struck if with the whip. He attributed the horse's behaviour to resentment of the whip. After considering the matter, and as the horse had a previous history of tractability in this regard, only a warning was issued, but in future mobile events RATTLETRACK will be included in the outside barrier draw. Upon being informed of the penalty, D. Wilson persisted in remonstrating with the parrier draw. Opto deing informed of the penalty, D. wilson persisted in refinerizating with the stewards and left the stewards room only when formally directed to do so. Despite the vigorous efforts of its driver MISTER LANGUS (R. White), which was drawn on the outside of the frontline, was slightly out of position when the start was effected. A warning was issued. On the first turn when contesting for a one-wide position TASMAN ROVER (R. Brady) and UNEXTENDED (D. Binskin) momentarily contacted, resulting in TASMAN ROVER becoming unsettled in its gear, galloping, and dropping back into the field, severely checking BLAKHA MATI (T. Tumbull). In view of the circumstances, the stewards decided to place only a warning on TASMAN ROVER his unsatisfactory race behaviour. D. A. Royle (RICH TRICK) was fined \$100 under Rule 224(c) for setting what in the opinion of the stewards was an excessively slow pace for the second quarter of the event, which was run in 35 seconds, which was 2 seconds outside the allowable maximum time for quarters for races over this distance. When explaining his tactics D. A. Royle stated that he was of the opinion that sectional times at Harold Park were for the halves and not for quarters of the last of the opinion that sectional unless at hardout aris were for the traiters and intribut quarters of the last mile at Harold Park. In view of the slackening of the pace commencing the second quarter resulting from leader RICH TRICK (D. Royle) being restrained, BIG BOSS (J. J. Smith), which was racing at the rear of the field, although under restraint from its driver, contacted the offside sulky wheel of MISTER LANGUS (R. White), resulting in BIG BOSS momentarily galloping. Commencing the run down the back straight in the final lap BLAKHA MATI (T. Turnbull), which was racing wide on the track, shifted in slightly and brushed the offside sulky wheel of MISTER was facing wide on the tracks, sintent in signly and broased the official states along wheel of which talk and the LakKHA MATT galloping for a short distance. A warning was issued against BLAKHA MATT'S unsatisfactory race behaviour. On the final turn, when being moved wider on the track to obtain a clear run, TASMAN ROVER (R. Brady) paced roughly for a short distance, resulting in BIG BOSS (J. J. Smith) being inconvenienced. A warning was issued against TASMAN ROVER'S unsatisfactory race behaviour, and R. Brady was severely reprimanded under Rule 265 for failing to allow sufficient clearance to BIG BOSS at this stage of

RACE 2 YARALLA SEA SCOUTS PACE (1,960 METRES) — PRESTONIAN (G. W. Innes), which started from the outside of the front line, galloped after the start, losing considerable ground, resulting in the gelding taking no competitive part in the event and finishing distanced. When questioned, the driver explained that the gelding had hung in slightly shortly after the start, and when checked out had become unsettled in its gear and galloped. The stewards barred PRESTONIAN from competing at licensed meetings, under Rule 325(a), being a last-start winner, until it can trial satisfactority on three occasions. D. Aliken (GAY ADAM) was fined \$200 under Rule 224(c) for setting what in the opinion of the stewards was an excessively slow pace for the second quarter of the last mile, was run in 3.2. seconds, which was 2/10 second outside the allowable maximum sectional time for quarters in races over this distance. When imposing the penalty, the stewards were mindfull that this was the second occasion on which D. Aliken had been before the stewards for such an offence in recent times. Commencing the run home LORA LIGHT (V. C. Bourke, which was searching for a run contacted and punctured the nearside sulky wheel of SAVE THE RAKAIA (J. Beeby), V. C. Bourke was severely reprimanded under Rule 265 for failing to exercise sufficient control over his mare at this stage of the event.

RACE 1ST HEAT NSW PACERS DERBY (2,350 METRES) — Prior to the event P. D. Johnson, the trainer-driver of SPEED KING, reported that he does not use the whip on the colt as it does not respond to that type of driving. PARDON ME BOYS (A. C. Lewis), which was drawn on the second line, galloped as the score-up commenced, losing considerable ground and when under pressure from its driver to endeavour to pick up the field again galloped, resulting in PARDON ME BOYS being well out of position when the start was effected. When questioned, the driver claimed that he was not ready for the score-up to commence and that when he switched around ROCKET JASON his horse had become unbalanced and galloped. After perusing the official video, and taking into consideration PARDON ME BOYS previous record of tractability in this regard, the stewards issued a warning only, but in future mobile events PARDON ME BOYS will be included in the outside barrier draw. Throughout the event, particularly on the turns, SPEED KING (P. D. Johnson) hung in, placing its driver at a disadvantage. A warning was issued. The stewards noted the intentions of the connections to race SPEED KING in a rein burr in future. BAY SPIRIT (G. Williams) raced three wide for the major portion of the event.

RACE 4 2ND HEAT NSW PACERS DERBY (2,350 METRES) — V. J. Knight (ANOTHER BART) was fined \$100 under Rule 224(c) for setting what in the opinion of the stewards was an excessively slow pace for the first quarter of the last mile, which was run in 34.4 seconds, which was 9/10

second outside the allowable maximum times for quarters of the last mile in races run over this distance. When racing behind the leader on the turn lowards the home straight before the beli, LEF OF GUNYAH (C. Gleeson) galloped, losing considerable ground and checking HOLY SMOKE (R. J. Thomson), ELEGANT RUN (D. Wilson) and CARLTON RAINBOW (C. Lobb). When questioned C. Gleeson explained that JEF OF GUNYAH's nearside hopple shortener pin had failed to release and that at the time the colt was racing fiercely, placing him at a disadvantage, resulting in JEF OF GUNYAH shifting away from the rails and contact occurring between the off hind leg of the horse and the nearside sulky wheel of KOTARE SYMBOL (D. Binskin), causing JEF OF GUNYAH to gallop. C. Gleeson's evidence was confirmed by the steward's observations, and therefore no action was taken other than to direct C. Gleeson to make the necessary alteration of the horse's gear to ensure against repitition. ANOTHER BART (V. J. Knight) failed to obtain a clear run until the concluding stages of the event.

RACE 5 MARRICKVILLE TENNIS CLUB PACE (1,960 METRES) — BULLY TARPORT (R. E. Roots), which was drawn on the second line, galloped without interference, losing considerable ground. When questioned, the driver could offer no satisfactory explanation for the gelding's wayward mobile barrier behaviour. In view of BULLY TARPORT'S recent history of tractability in this regard, only a warming was issued, but in future mobile events the gelding will be included in the outside barrier draw. WINDSOR FLIGHT (D. Wilson), which was drawn in barrier one, galloped, lost valuable ground, and as a result was out of position when the start was effected. When questioned the driver had no excuse for the coll's unsatisfactory mobile barrier behaviour. In view of WINDSOR LIGHT'S previous history of tractability in this regard, only a warming was issued, but in future mobile events tellow that the coll will included in the outside barrier draw.

RACE 6 DISTRICT 31 ASSOCIATION PACE (2,350 METRES) — In the run home when under pressure from its driver, ROBBER JOHN (V. Frost) veered out, allowing ample room for SPEED PARTNER (M. Frost) to secure an insider run. A warning was issued against the gelding's unsatisfactory race behaviour, and V. Frost was severely reprimanded under Rule 269 for failing to make sufficient effort to correct ROBBER JOHN. V. Frost was further informed that if the gelding offends in a similar manner in future, his driving would be held responsible.

RACE 7 ORIENTAL ASSOCIATION PACE (1,960 METRES) — KARAMEA CHRISTMAS (R. Chisholm) was obliged to race three wide for a considerable portion of the event, resulting in the mare compounding in the latter stages of the race.

RACE 8 PATRICIAN BROS. GRANVILLE PACE (1,960 METRES) — F. J. Willis (JACKALOU) was fined \$200 under Rule 224(c) for setting and excessively slow pace whilst leading in that the second quarter of the last mile was run in 34.1 seconds, which is 1.1 seconds outside the allowable maximum time for quarters of the last mile for races over this distance. When imposing the penalty, the stewards where mindfull that this was the second occasion F. J. Willis had offended in this regard in recent times. Approaching the first turn, when racing on the raits and to the inside of BEARASON BEAU (D. Hancock) and JACKALOU (F. Willis), SIR OCLIN (B. Hancock) became unsettled in its gear, galloped and lost considerable ground, severely checking LADY OF HANEMA (N. Barker). SIR COLIN was immediately retired from the event with a broken nearside front hopple loop. After questioning the drivers, and viewing the incident on the official video, it was clearly established that SIR COLIN had sufficient racing room at this stage of the event and that the hopple loop had snapped before SIR COLIN galloped. In view of these circumstances, no action was taken.

RACE 9 KOALA KING PACE (2,350 METRES) — WOLGARU'S NIGHT (C. Gleeson), which was drawn in barrier one, was out of position throughout the score-up despite the vigorous efforts of its driver, resulting in HUCKSTER HANOVER (J. Beeby) being inconvenienced. A final warning was issued regarding WOLGARU'S NIGHT'S unsatisfactory mobile barrier behaviour.




