COLLECTION OF TOTE DIVIDENDS

FAVOUT BETTING

'FAVOUT' BETTING is a mode of betting whereby punters can bet on a race which has a prohibitive odds-on favourite (1/4 or shorter) as if that horse was not in the field.

Such a horse is called a "designated horse" and bookmakers approved for FAVOUT betting shall not display odds for the "designated horse"

Approved FAVOUT bookmakers shall pay bets as if the "designated horse" was not in the field. That is, if the "designated horse" runs a placing, it is ignored completely and the fourth horse is promoted to third.

The Chairman of Stewards shall declare the FAVOUT placings prior to the "All Clear" being notified and they shall be announced over the Public Address System.

"BATTLE CRY" STAKES: "Sholty's First" (G. A. Lang) was unable toobtain a clear run over the concluding stages. The Stewards charged D. V. Dove "Personality Pete" under Rule 380 for allowing this horse to shift out near the 1000 metres when not sufficiently clear of "Alboretto" (A. D. Peace), resulting in "Alboretto" losing its position, and being forced four wide. Dove was found guilty as charged, and his licence to drive was suspended for two weeks, which will take effect from midnight on Saturday, 22nd April, to enable Doye to fulfil his engagements. The first half of the last mile was covered in 64.1 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "Salzburg" (S. D. Dove), the winner of the race

"YAMAMOTO" STAKES: "Cute Frost" (V. J. Knight), which began badly, will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw. "Plenty to Spare" (N. L. Welsh) was slow to begin. "Cute Frost" (V. J. Knight) was caught three wide in the early stages, and tired over the concluding stages of the race. The first half of the last mile was covered in 62.2 seconds. A swab sample was taken

from "Andy Bush" (B. A. Ralph), the winner of the race

"SKY CHANNEL" INTER-DOMINION TROTTERS CHAMPIONSHIP - Fourth Heat: "Game Ebony" (I. R. Lee), which broke in the score-up, and "Rival Lass" (G. W. Lee), which broke as the start was effected, will be both excluded from the mobile barrier draw. As a result of "Rival Lass" breaking, "Tango Brava" (A. S. C. Douglas) had to be checked, and broke for a few strides. Turning out of the back straight on the first occasion, "Fair Tally (Kathleen A. Ford) broke. "Fair Tally" broke over the concluding stages when under pressure, "Pitcher" (T. E. Demmler) was held up over the concluding stages when unable to obtain a clear run. The Stewards charged W. J. Bond "Kano Joe" under Rule 268(f) for permitting this horse to cover the first half of the last mile in 67.2 seconds, which is .2 of a second outside of the prescribed time. Bond was found guilty as charged, and was fined the sum of \$200. A swab sample was taken from "Kano Joe" (W. J. Bond), the winner of the race, and from "Pitcher" (T.E. Demmler), second placegetter

VICTORIA HARNESS RACING CLUB COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL: "Alba Veit" (J. O'Sullivan) was slow to begin. The Stewards questioned M. E. White "Highland Walk", R. J. Thomson "Empire Queen" and Mark Hayes "Havelock Prince " regarding an incident which Thomson "Empire Queen" and Mark Hayes "Havelock Prince " regarding an incident which occurred near the winning post on the first occasion where "Havelock Prince" was contacted and broke, resulting in "Andy Armbro" (N. F. Shinn) and "Nats Vision" (Gavin Lang) being severely checked, and "Ransom Demand" (R. A. Spencer) and "Advance On" (K. R. Linsell) also being checked. It was found to have been caused when "Empire Queen", which was being eased toobtain a trail behind "Highland Walk", shifted in abruptly, contacting "Havelock Prince", and starting off the chain of events behind this horse. The Stewards informed R. J. Thomson, trainer-driver of "Empire Queen", that this horse will be given only one more chance to improve its racing manners otherwise a bar will be imposed. The first half of the last mile was covered in 66.3 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "Carry the Flag" (M. F. Blackmore), the winner of the race.

"SKY CHANNEL" INTER-DOMINION TROTTERS CHAMPIONSHIP - Fifth Heat: "Ar Jay" (R. J. Gleeson) and "Super Bye Bye" (L. Caruana) both broke near the starting point, and will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw. "Second Bat" (A. D. Peace) was caught three wide over the final 1500 metres. "Tyron Scottie" (P. G. O'Reilly) was held up when unable to obtain a clear run over the concluding stages. The first half of the last mile was covered in 64.4 seconds. A swab sample was taken from the winner, "Yankee Loch", (J. O'Sullivan), and from

the second placegetter, "Second Bat" (A. D. Peace).

A. A. LANCASTER CUP: "Sir Reilly" (S. D. Dove), which plunged asthe score-up was commenced and became unbalanced asa result, was back from its position near despatch point. "Batik Print" (C. A. Alford) raced roughly as the start was effected. Turning into the straight on the first occasion, "Rufus Young Blood" (I. R. Lee) and "Empire Fella" (P. L. Ward) locked wheels momentarily when "Rufus Young Blood" hung out. "Empire Fella" (P. L. Ward) raced roughly turning out of the straight near the 1700 metres. "Great Rival" (Leonie Collins) was held up and carried back through the field when "Batik Print" (C. A. Alford) tirred between the 600 and the 400 metres. "Preux Amara" (V. J. Knight) hung in when under pressure near the straight entrance, tightening the ground on "Kentucky George" (B. R. Gath). The first half of the last mile was covered in 62.2 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "Rufus Young Blood" (I. R. Lee), the winner of the race.

"SKY CHANNEL" INTER-DOMINIOM TROTTERS CHAMPIONSHIP - Sixth Heat: "Shack Mobile" (H. Young), which broke as the start was effected, will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw. "Suave Guy" (N. J. Clarke), which had difficulty maintaining itsbarrier position, will continue to be excluded from the mobile barrier draw. "Hot and Dry" (R. B. Conroy) broke under pressure near the finish. For people who used the FAVOUT method of betting, which was operated on "True Roman", the all-clear was given on "Its Troppo", "John Gilbert" and "Suave Guy". The first half of the last mile was covered in 64.9 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "True Roman" (Gavin Lang), the winner of the race, and from "Its Troppo", second

"CASTELTONS PRIDE" THREE-YEARS-OLD STAKES: The Stewards reprimanded T. B. Warwick "Mazzini Magic" for allowing thishorse to shift in and tighten the ground of "Cabriolet" (A. D. Peace) turning out of the straight on the first occasion. Turning out of the back straight on the final occasion, "Spring Wiper" (M. N. Wishart) broke without interference for a few strides. "Clever Prince" was a late withdrawal on veterinary advice at 9.57 a.m. The first half of the last mile was covered in 64.1 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "Tac Wind" (V. J. Knight), the winner of the race.

To improve betting value for patrons and further enhance the exciting spectacle of harness racing at Moonee Valley, the Harness Racing Board have increased the field size and accordingly adjusted the number of horses to start from the front row in mobile barrier races.


The following changes apply to tonight's racing:

TWO ROWS

Generally, a maximum of 11 horses will contest mobile start races with 8 on the front row and 3 trailing.


OUT OF DRAW

Horses declared "Out of the barrier Draw in Mobile start races" (ODM), usually for unruly behaviour, will be placed in the outermost barrier positions on the front row.



SCRATCHINGS

In the event a horse is scratched at any time after the declaration of fields, the remaining horses on that row only shall move toward the rails to occupy the scratched horse's vacant position. Horses from the second row will not move on to the front row.



EXCEPTIONS

- 1. For the present, 2YO races will continue to be restricted to 9 horses all starting in one row from behind the mobile barrier.
- 2. The Final and the Consolation of the 'Sky Channel' InterDominion Trotters Championship (Races 6 & 8) will be run under the same starting conditions as the first round heats on Saturday, April 8, that is a maximum of 9 starters and all in one row.

TOTALISATOR BETTING

WIN: Selected runner must win.

PLACE: Selected runner must run 1st, 2nd or 3rd.
WIN & PLACE: Combined win bet and place bet on same horse. QUINELLA: Selected horses must run 1st and 2nd in any order. TRIFECTA: Selected horses must run 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the correct

RUNNING DOUBLE: Select the winners of two consecutive races. DAILY DOUBLE: Select the winners of two nominated races. EXTRA DOUBLE: Select the winners of two nominated races. QUADRELLA: Select the winners of four nominated races.

TRIFECTA BETTING

ALL DIVIDENDS DISPLAYED TO \$1

(Minimum bet is 50¢)

SINGLE TRIFECTA Select the first three runners past the post in the correct order. e.g. 2 for win, 4 for 2nd, 7 for 3rd.

NOTICE TO DRIVERS

SECTIONAL TIMES

The Sectional Time Requirements for Moonee Valley are as follows:

(a) Drivers are required to complete the first half of the mile in 65 seconds for Metropolitan Penalty Bearing (MPB) races and 67 seconds for other events excluding 2YO and 3YO trotters races and races over a distance longer than 2380 metres.

(b) A concession of 1 second in the Sectional Time Requirement for will apply for MPB races conducted over 2380 metres when the first portion of the race to the mile point is completed in 59 seconds or less.

(c) Stewards have been directed to take into consideration factors that may have led to an infringement of the Sectional Time Regulations when determining whether an offence has been committed and before imposing penalties.

SECTIONAL TIME LIGHTS

To assist Drivers to assess 'race speed' a light has been installed at the 1206 metre point. This light will be activated 32.5 seconds after the leading horse passes the 1609 metre mark.

This light will allow Drivers to determine whether the pace of the race has to be quickened to complete the section (the first half of the last mile) in the required 65 seconds or less.

No other lights will be activated around the track during the course of each race.
