GENERAL INFORMATION

BUGLE CALL: A bugle call will be sounded over the public address system when the field leaves the Birdcage.

LAP BELL: As a warning to drivers the lap bell will be sounded when the field has one more round of the track to go.

SIREN: A siren will be sounded when the Judicial Committee conducts any hearing that may affect the result of a race. Patrons are warned against destroying totalisator tickets until at least FIVE MINUTES after the running of each race, or until payment of dividends has actually been commenced.

INDICATOR LIGHTS ON WINNING POST

ORANGE — Indicates that the starter has been notified to commence the race in 1½ minutes. RED — Indicates that the starter has permission to commence the race.

UNRULY HORSES: If the letters UR appear in place of the barrier draw it means that, that particular horse has been declared unruly by the Stipendiary Stewards and such horse shall start a second line on the extreme outside from behind and clear of the front line horses. If there are other horses on the second line the horse or horses so declared unruly shall start on the extreme outside of the second line and clear of the front and second line horses.

BREAKING HORSES: As a general principle, when a pacer or trotter breaks during a race, the driver must immediately return the horse to its correct gait and where possible take the horse clear of the field.

The Stipendiary Stewards may fine or suspend any driver who fails to take such action and disqualify any horse which in their opinion has gained an advantage by breaking.

Where the Stipendiary Stewards decide that any horse by breaking at or near the finishing line gained an advantage that enabled it to run into a place before any other horses in the race, they shall relegate the horse gaining the advantage behind such other horses.

UNDER DOLLAR DIVIDENDS: The attention of patrons is drawn to the following notice which appeared in the New Zealand Gazette on 18 December, 1980:-

"Pursuant to sections 44A and 98A of the Racing Act 1971 (as inserted by the Racing Amendment Act 1980) the Minister of Internal Affairs hereby notifies for public information that the requirement on Totalisator Clubs and the Totalisator Agency Board to pay out by way of dividend in respect of any bet on which a dividend is payable shall not apply in respect of place betting on any race when an amount equal to 60 percent or more of the gross investments in the place pool is invested on any one of the horses or greyhounds filling a dividends-earning place in the race."

Warning: Patrons are warned that as a consequence of the above notice the possibility exists that place dividends in respect of strongly-invested starters will not be made up to \$1.



HOW WE SEE THE FIELD

An even mix of trial and race form makes this a tough betting challenge and the rail draw could well help EASY GOER to perform with credit. 

Family Pride was a late scratching from this event on veterinary advice. The Club's veterinary surgeon reported that the horse was lame in the near front leg. Favourite David Moss trotted roughly after the barrier pulled away losing several lengths before settling towards the rear. Lyn's Choice broke after approximately 200m settling quickly.

RACE 7 - NEW ZEALAND RACING AUTHORITY EIGHTH PACERS

QUALIFYING HEAT

Bold Sharvid was a late scratching by the Stipendiary Stewards due to the horse having an unacceptable level of bicarbonate. Blossom Lady paced roughly with approximately 300m to run eventually breaking in the run home. Following the event trainer D.G. Jones was fined \$100.00 as the connecting strap on the near side had broken.

RACE 9 — MANUKAU TROTTING CLUB INTER-DOMINION TROTTERS CHAMP CONSOLATION

Piece De Resistance which drew three on the front line broke during the run up, this resulted in White Horse Pride, which had drawn the second row behind this horse, to be checked. In the re-run Piece De Resistance was sent to the outside of the front line by the starter. Following the running of this event a complaint was lodged against I.R. Lee (Glenfield Girl) on the grounds of careless driving causing interference to Game Nian and Midlands Del, both these horses breaking after approx. 400m. I.R. Lee pleaded guilty and his horseman's licence was suspended up to and including the 16th March 1991. He was also fined the sum of \$250.00.

RACE 10 — BARON DEVELOPMENTS HANDICAP PACE

Fella's Ego (Mrs S.H. Branch) broke, ran in squeezing Caledonian Count (M.J. Stormont) down on to the hub rail, which resulted in this horse breaking and losing whatever change he may have had in the race. Following the event trainer Mrs S.H. Branch was warned that a repetition of her driving tactics would see her dealt with and further the horse was issued with a warning regarding its racing manners. The bandage on Bobby Dazzler (E.B. Billett) on the off fore came undone in the run home and trainer E.B. Billett was subsequently fined the sun of \$100.00 for faulty gear.

AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB (INC.)

Extract from N.Z. Gazette, 8th June, 1978, No.50. Page 1613 New Zealand Trotting Conference

In pursuance and exercise of the power contained in section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, the New Zealand Trotting Conference resolves to, and does hereby make the following rules controlling the admission of persons to all racecourses used by racing clubs which are now, or may at any time hereafter be registered with the said New Zealand Trotting Conference.

RULES Under the Racing Act 1971

1 These rules shall come into force on the day after the day on which they are published in the New Zealand Gazette.

2. In these rules the words "racecourse", "racing club", and "race meeting" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by Section 2 of the Racing Act 1971, and the word "bookmaker" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto by the Gaming Act 1908, or any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution of such Act.

The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from all racecourses used by racing clubs which are or may at any time hereafter be registered with the New Zealand Trotting Conference while such racecourses, or any thereof, are being used by any Club for a race

meeting, namely:

(a) All persons under disqualification imposed under New Zealand Rules of Racing or the New Zealand Rules of Trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside New Zealand which have reciprocal agreement in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or the New Zealand Trotting Conference;

Persons convicted of theft, burglary, receiving stolen goods, robbery, unlawful taking or conversion of a motor car or other vehicle, false pretences, forgery, uttering,

possession of counterfeit coin, or assault;

Persons convicted of any offences under the Gaming Act 1908, or of any of the following offences under the Crimes Act 1961; murder, attempted murder, manslaughter (not based on negligence), sections 188-204 (which relate to assaults and injuries to the person), sections 294-297 (which relate to arson or attempt there at), crimes involving dishonesty or conspiracy to commit a crime, indecent acts, sexual offences, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution therefor;

Persons convicted of an offence against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Narcotics Act 1965, or against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution

thereof:

Persons convicted in countries outside New Zealand of offences corresponding to those


mentioned in paragraph (d) or paragraph (e).

Provided always that a committee established by the New Zealand Racing and Trotting Conferences upon being satisfied as to character and otherwise that any person who, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of these rules should have relief from the effect thereof may grant exemption to any such person.

4. The rules previously made by the New Zealand Trotting Conference under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the New Zealand Gazette, of 22 November 1973, on P.2438, and which were deemed to have been revoked at midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976, have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time before midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976. In every other respect such revoked rules thereafter have no effect. The rules previously made by the New Zealand Trotting Conference under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the New Zealand Gazette, and shall thereafter have the effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time between midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976 and midnight on the day on which these rules are published in the said Gazette. In every other respect such revoked rules shall hereafter have no effect.
