GENERAL INFORMATION

BUGLE CALL: A bugle call will be sounded over the public address system when the field leaves the Birdcage.

LAP BELL: As a warning to drivers the lap bell will be sounded when the field has one more round of the track to go

SIREN: A siren will be sounded when the Judicial Committee conducts any hearing that may affect the result of a race. Patrons are warned against destroying totalisator tickets until at least FIVE MINUTES after the running of each race, or until payment of dividends has actually been commenced.

INDICATOR LIGHTS ON WINNING POST

ORANGE — Indicates that the starter has been notified to commence the race in 1½ minutes. RED — Indicates that the starter has permission to commence the race.

UNRULY HORSES: If the letters UR appear in place of the barrier draw it means that, that particular horse has been declared unruly by the Stipendiary Stewards and such horse shall start a second line on the extreme outside from behind and clear of the front line horses. If there are other horses on the second line the horse or horses so declared unruly shall start on the extreme outside of the second line and clear of the front and second line horses.

BREAKING HORSES: As a general principle, when a pacer or trotter breaks during a race, the driver must immediately return the horse to its correct gait and where possible take the horse clear of the field.

The Stipendiary Stewards may fine or suspend any driver who fails to take such action and disqualify any horse which in their opinion has gained an advantage by breaking.

Where the Stipendiary Stewards decide that any horse by breaking at or near the finishing line gained an advantage that enabled it to run into a place before any other horses in the race, they shall relegate the horse gaining the advantage behind such other horses.

UNDER DOLLAR DIVIDENDS: The attention of patrons is drawn to the following notice which appeared in the New Zealand Gazette on 18 December, 1980:-

"Pursuant to sections 44A and 98A of the Racing Act 1971 (as inserted by the Racing Amendment Act 1980) the Minister of Internal Affairs hereby notifies for public information that the requirement on Totalisator Clubs and the Totalisator Agency Board to pay out by way of dividend in respect of any bet on which a dividend is payable shall not apply in respect of place betting on any race when an amount equal to 60 percent or more of the gross investments in the place pool is invested on any one of the horses or greyhounds filling a dividends-earning place in the race."

Warning: Patrons are warned that as a consequence of the above notice the possibility exists that place dividends in respect of strongly-invested starters will not be made up to \$1.



GOLDEN JUBILEE LIFESPAN INTER-DOMINION POINTS SYSTEM

- 1. Points shall be awarded to each horse actually starting and finishing a race of a Qualifying Division on the basis that the winner of a race of a Qualifying Division will receive in points the equivalent of the number of horses previously selected by the Auckland Trotting Club as the maximum number of horses to compete in each race of the Qualifying Divisions. The second horse in each race of the Qualifying Divisions will receive the next lower number in points and the third horse will receive the next lower number with each horse finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding horse until the last horse finishing in a maximum field will receive one (1) point.
- The winner of each race of a Qualifying Division will receive one (1) bonus point to be added to the points already earned for that race.
- 3. There are no points allocated for fastest time.
- 4. A horse that is scratched from a race of the Qualifying Division or a horse that does not complete the race will not be allocated any points for the race of that Qualifying Division.
- 5. In the event of a scratching or a horse not completing the course, points will be allocated as before with the winner and other horses finishing the race entitled to receive their maximum number of points as if a full field had competed and finished the course in that particular race.
- In the event of a dead-heat all points of the horses dead-heating shall be added together and equally divided.
- The Judge shall place all horses in a race according to the order in which their noses reached the winning post.
- In each Qualifying Division the same number of maximum points shall be allocated irrespective of the actual number of starters and irrespective of the variation of the number of Divisions on each day or night of racing.

RACE 1 - INTERNATIONAL CLASSIC SERIES TROTTERS FINAL

Apart from Call Me Chiola the rest of the field broke at the start or during the running.

RACE 2 - INTERNATIONAL CLASSIC SERIES FILLIE FINAL

There was a slight delay to the start of this event when the starter had to restart one of the arms on the mobile gate. Chatem Up broke shortly after the start causing a check to Atomic Lace. Evamay broke after 300m causing a slight check to Went Overboard. Atomic Lace tangled again with 900m to run. With 350m to run Precious Gift broke. Following the race a complaint was lodged against M. Purdon (Precious Gift) on the grounds of careless driving causing his own horse to break. After hearing from the Stipendiary Stewards, M. Purdon and viewing the video, it was the unanimous decision of the Committee that M. Purdon was guilty and he was fined \$300.00.

RACE 3 - INTERNATIONAL CLASSIC SERIES FILLIES CONSOLATION

Motoring Miss broke shortly after the start and after 250m Tricky Singer broke and ran in causing a check to Donna's Maid. After 500m Breakthrough broke.

RACE 4 - BARON SECURITIES MOBILE PACE

After the field had travelled approximately 500m, Soky's Belle, which was racing one out without cover, paced roughly, broke and ran in causing a check to Mac Express, which fell. Soky's Belle then ran out severely disrupting the rest of the runners in the race. Following the event the connections of Soky's Belle were informed that the horse had been declared ineligible for all totalisator and stake races until such time as it has trialed to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward on four occasions. Favourite Alberton Fair was examined by the Club's Veterinarian following this race as the horse had a swollen knee and the Veterinarian was of the opinion this was caused by a broken blood vessel during the race.

SMOKEFREE FIRST PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT

Following the running of this event R.T. May was questioned regarding the racing of Field Commander just after the barrier was released which caused his horse to lose several lengths before settling. He advised and it was confirmed that Motor Power and Thorate had moved in at the same time as Starship was running out and as a result Field Commander had to be taken hold of. An objection was lodged against the first placing being awarded to Two Under on the grounds of interference to Starship with approximately 400m to run. After hearing the evidence from the Stipendiary Stewards, V.J. Knight, R.J. Brosnan and viewing the videos, it was found that Two Under, which had been in the lead, ran out approximately two sulky widths from the fence down the back straight for the last time and this allowed R.J. Brosnan to drive Starship through on the inside. However, as they came to the bend Two Under came back down and as a result Starship was severely checked breaking and losing several lengths and Thorate, which was in behind, was also broken up. It was therefore decided to relegate Two Under from first to last behind Thorate. It was also decided to suspend V.J. Knight's horsemans licence up to and including 9th March, 1991.

RACE 6 - FRANKLIN TROTTING CLUB (INC) FIRST TROTTERS QUALIFYING HEAT.

Evander Rose, Midlands Del, Game Paul and White Horse Pride broke shortly after the mobile was released while Hickory Stick broke on two occasions round the top bend.

RACE 7 AIR NEW ZEALAND SECOND PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT

K.J. Harrison, the trainer of Dare You To, was questioned regarding the instructions he had given to R.T. May for the horses barrier position. He advised that he considred that Mr May may have misunderstood him as he was completely confident that his horse would race in any barrier position allotted to him. The only thing he advised the Committee was that his horse had never been trained to parade prior to a start and therefore considered it would be impossible for him to adopt the methods used in New Zealand. With approximately 400m to run Lookahead began to stop quickly and as a result B. Mangos attempted to move off this horse back but hooked wheels with Biossom Lady which had Surmo's Dream on the outside. As a result Gale Fella also received a slight check.

RACE 8 - GREENLANE TOYOTA THIRD PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT

Following this event R.T. May was fined \$100 for hitting a wheel causing his horse to break when attempting to come off the back of Franco Ice. H.W. Skinner was questioned regarding the racing manners of Honkin Vision. He advised that the horse had begun to hang with approximately 900m to run. He then pulled the ear plugs and the horse straightened up down the back, but again began to hang badly round the top bend with 400m to run, but when lnky Lord broke in front of him, he had to take hold of his horse and as a result, almost went over the hub rail. As he advised the Committee he considered the horse was not showing any ill effects from its previous quarter-crack injury, but would still have it examined by the Club's Verterinary Surgeon, he was informed that an official vet's certificate would be required prior to it racing on Wednesday night. An application was made by V.J. Knight to remove Almeta Boy from the unruly list and this was granted.

RACE 9 - KUMEU DISTRICT TROTTING CLUB (INC) SECOND TROTTERS QUALIFYING HEAT

Following this event a complaint was lodged against C.J. Butler (Rebecca Bret) on the grounds of inteference to Yankee Loch (J.F. Curtin) which broke with approxiantlely 250m to run. After hearing the relative evidence, it was found that Guardian Angel which Rebecca Bret was following, trotted roughly round the top bend the last time and almost broke and C.J. Butler changed direction with his horse in an attempt to avoid Guardian Angel and as a result Yankee Loch was squeezed up. It was therefore decided to dismiss the complaint. Gee Du Jour broke shortly after the start while Le Duc broke during the running.

RACE 10 - WISES DIRECTORIES MOBILE PACE

Go For Broke tangled badly in the run up, losing approximately 20 lengths but caught the field after 1000m. The connections were subsequently warned to improve this horses racing manners. P.T. Blanchard and P.E. Simpson, the trainers of Resolute Poplar, were fined \$100 for faulty gear when this horse dropped a front hopple and as a result broke checking King Strike with approximately 150m to run.

SCRATCHINGS FROM INTER-DOMINIONS

Franco Gold, Hayden Bromac, Franco Glide, Amendment, Carden Court were all declared ineligible to race for a period of 8 weeks from today as per Regulation 27(b) of the Inter-Dominion Championships.





AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB (INC.)

Extract from N.Z. Gazette, 8th June, 1978, No.50, Page 1613 New Zealand Trotting Conference

In pursuance and exercise of the power contained in section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, the New Zealand Trotting Conference resolves to, and does hereby make the following rules controlling the admission of persons to all racecourses used by racing clubs which are now, or may at any time hereafter be registered with the said New Zealand Trotting Conference.

RULES Under the Racing Act 1971

- These rules shall come into force on the day after the day on which they are published in the New Zealand Gazette.
- In these rules the words "racecourse", "racing club", and "race meeting" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by Section 2 of the Racing Act 1971, and the word "bookmaker" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto by the Gaming Act 1908, or any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution of such Act.
- 3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from all racecourses used by racing clubs which are or may at any time hereafter be registered with the New Zealand Trotting Conference while such racecourses, or any thereof, are being used by any Club for a race meeting, namely:
 - (a) All persons under disqualification imposed under New Zealand Rules of Racing or the New Zealand Rules of Trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside New Zealand which have reciprocal agreement in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or the New Zealand Trotting Conference;
 - (b) Bookmakers;
 - (c) Persons convicted of theft, burglary, receiving stolen goods, robbery, unlawful taking or conversion of a motor car or other vehicle, false pretences, forgery, uttering, possession of counterfeit coin, or assault;
 - (d) Persons convicted of any offences under the Gaming Act 1908, or of any of the following offences under the Crimes Act 1961; murder, attempted murder, manslaughter (not based on negligence), sections 188-204 (which relate to assaults and injuries to the person), sections 294-297 (which relate to arson or attempt there at), crimes involving dishonesty or conspiracy to commit a crime, indecent acts, sexual offences, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution therefor;
 - (e) Persons convicted of an offence against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Narcotics Act 1965, or against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
 - Persons convicted in countries outside New Zealand of offences corresponding to those mentioned in paragraph (d) or paragraph (e).

Provided always that a committee established by the New Zealand Racing and Trotting Conferences upon being satisfied as to character and otherwise that any person who, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of these rules should have relief from the effect thereof may grant exemption to any such person.

4. The rules previously made by the New Zealand Trotting Conference under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the New Zealand Gazette, of 22 November 1973, on P.2438, and which were deemed to have been revoked at midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976, have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time before midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976. In every other respect such revoked rules thereafter have no effect. The rules previously made by the New Zealand Trotting Conference under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the New Zealand Gazette, and shall thereafter have the effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time between midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976 and midnight on the day on which these rules are published in the said Gazette. In every other respect such revoked rules shall hereafter have no effect.
