GENERAL INFORMATION

BUGLE CALL: A bugle call will be sounded over the public address system when the field leaves the Birdcage.

LAP BELL: As a warning to drivers the lap bell will be sounded when the field has one more round of the track to go.

SIREN: A siren will be sounded when the Judicial Committee conducts any hearing that may affect the result of a race. Patrons are warned against destroying totalisator tickets until at least FIVE MINUTES after the running of each race, or until payment of dividends has actually been commenced.

INDICATOR LIGHTS ON WINNING POST

ORANGE — Indicates that the starter has been notified to commence the race in 1½ minutes.

RED — Indicates that the starter has permission to commence the race.

UNRULY HORSES: If the letters UR appear in place of the barrier draw it means that, that particular horse has been declared unruly by the Stipendiary Stewards and such horse shall start a second line on the extreme outside from behind and clear of the front line horses. If there are other horses on the second line the horse or horses so declared unruly shall start on the extreme outside of the second line and clear of the front and second line horses.

BREAKING HORSES: As a general principle, when a pacer or trotter breaks during a race, the driver must immediately return the horse to its correct gait and where possible take the horse clear of the field.

The Stipendiary Stewards may fine or suspend any driver who fails to take such action and disqualify any horse which in their opinion has gained an advantage by breaking.

Where the Stipendiary Stewards decide that any horse by breaking at or near the finishing line gained an advantage that enabled it to run into a place before any other horses in the race, they shall relegate the horse gaining the advantage behind such other horses.

UNDER DOLLAR DIVIDENDS: The attention of patrons is drawn to the following notice which appeared in the New Zealand Gazette on 18 December, 1980:-

"Pursuant to sections 44A and 98A of the Racing Act 1971 (as inserted by the Racing Amendment Act 1980) the Minister of Internal Affairs hereby notifies for public information that the requirement on Totalisator Clubs and the Totalisator Agency Board to pay out by way of dividend in respect of any bet on which a dividend is payable shall not apply in respect of place betting on any race when an amount equal to 60 percent or more of the gross investments in the place pool is invested on any one of the horses or greyhounds filling a dividends-earning place in the race."

Warning: Patrons are warned that as a consequence of the above notice the possibility exists that place dividends in respect of strongly-invested starters will not be made up to \$1.

The duties of the Council are to supervise all matters pertaining to the Series and to finalise the Grand Final field.

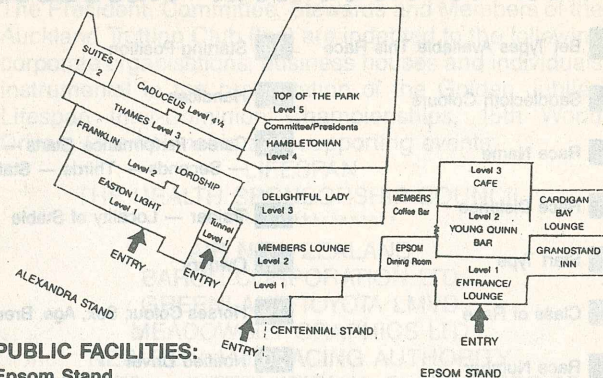

GOLDEN JUBILEE LIFESPAN INTER-DOMINION POINTS SYSTEM

- Points shall be awarded to each horse actually starting and finishing a race of a Qualifying Division on the basis that the winner of a race of a Qualifying Division will receive in points the equivalent of the number of horses previously selected by the Auckland Trotting Club as the maximum number of horses to compete in each race of the Qualifying Divisions. The second horse in each race of the Qualifying Divisions will receive the next lower number in points and the third horse will receive the next lower number with each horse finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding horse until the last horse finishing in a maximum field will receive one (1) point.
- The winner of each race of a Qualifying Division will receive one (1) bonus point to be added to the points already earned for that race.
- There are no points allocated for fastest time.
- A horse that is scratched from a race of the Qualifying Division or a horse that does not complete the race will not be allocated any points for the race of that Qualifying Division.
- In the event of a scratching or a horse not completing the course, points will be allocated as before with the winner and other horses finishing the race entitled to receive their maximum number of points as if a full field had competed and finished the course in that particular race.
- In the event of a dead-heat all points of the horses dead-heating shall be added together and equally divided.
- The Judge shall place all horses in a race according to the order in which their noses reached the winning post.
- In each Qualifying Division the same number of maximum points shall be allocated irrespective of the actual number of starters and irrespective of the variation of the number of Divisions on each day or night of racing.

STIPENDIARY STEWARDS PRESS REPORT

RACE 1 — INTERNATIONAL CLASSIC NORTHERN HEMISPHERE OPEN

Whiteleigh's Way put in a few rough strides after 200m but soon settled while Mark Butler was inclined to pace erratically in the first 400m before settling and Jolly Joseph broke with approximately 150m to run for a few strides. Trainer R. W. Nation was fined \$50 for being late into the birdcage.

RACE 2 — NEW ZEALAND RACING AUTHORITY FOURTH PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT

Following the running of this race an objection was lodged against the eighth placing being awarded to Its Motor Power on the grounds of careless driving causing interference to Night Colt, with a resultant check to Chuin, after approximately 200m. After hearing from the Stipendiary Stewards, J. O'Sullivan (Its Motor Power), R. Pierce (Night Colt) and viewing the videos, it was found that Its Motor Power had moved in sharply causing Night Colt to break. It was therefore decided to relegate Its Motor Power from its eighth placing to last behind Night Colt and Chuin. It was also decided to suspend J. O'Sullivan's horseman's licence up to and including 9 March 1991 and a fine of \$250 was imposed. Honkin Vision was a late scratching on veterinary advice. This horse has been withdrawn from the series and will require to trial on two occasions plus produce a veterinary certificate before racing again.

RACE 3 — SMOKEFREE THIRD TROTTERS QUALIFYING HEAT

Le Duc, The Expatriate and Hickory Stick broke during the running.

RACE 4 — INTERNATIONAL CLASSIC OPEN

B. V. Saunders was fined \$50 for late notification of a seven day rule. Super Fuel broke shortly after the barrier was released losing several lengths but caught the field after 600m. Butler's Chore paced roughly round the top bend with approximately 400m to run.

RACE 5 — GREENLANE TOYOTA FIFTH PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT

Almeta Boy tangled for a few strides shortly after the barrier was released but soon settled. However, Letterkenny Lad was required to go through on the inside of this horse and Gasthof, which went round the outside of this horse, tangled shortly afterwards losing several lengths.

RACE 6 — THAMES HARNESS RACING CLUB FOURTH TROTTERS QUALIFYING HEAT

Following this race an objection was lodged to the fourth placing being awarded to Gee Du Jour on the grounds of careless driving causing interference to Tobago after 250m. After hearing from the Stipendiary Stewards, C. De Filippi (Gee Du Jour), A. M. Butt (White Horse Pride), H Skinner (Tobago) and viewing the videos, it was found that Gee Du Jour had moved in sharply pushing White Horse Pride onto Tobago which broke. It was therefore decided to relegate Gee Du Jour from its fourth placing to behind Tobago. It was also decided to suspend C. De Filippi's horseman's licence for 9 March 1991 and a fine of \$250 was imposed. Game Paul, Midlands Del, Piece De Resistance and Glenfield Girl all made mistakes either at the start or during the running of this event. Following the event R. J. Brosnan, the trainer of Game Paul, was given permission to start this horse from the unruly mark for mobile starts.

RACE 7 HAYMAN PASLEY MOBILE PACE

Evado broke at the start and Fresh Fields broke with 300m to run.

RACE 8 — NEW ZEALAND RACING AUTHORITY SIXTH PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT

The delay to the start of this race was caused when a shoe had to be renailed on the horse Dare You To. Following the event an objection was lodged to the seventh placing being awarded to Two Under (S. Dove) on the grounds of causing interference to Surmo Way (P. C. Ferguson) after the field had travelled approximately 50m. After hearing from the Stipendiary Stewards, the respective drivers and viewing the videos it was found that Two Under, which drew number one at the barrier, run out badly despite driver S. Dove's efforts to keep it straight, and as a result Mark Hanover was pushed out onto Surmo Way which had been following Gale Fella through. Surmo Way at the time had Franco Ice on its outside and therefore no room in which to pace, broke and lost any chance. It was therefore decided to relegate Two Under from seventh to twelfth and promote Surmo Way to eleventh. The associated complaint against S. Dove was dismissed as it was considered he had done his best to control the horse in the circumstances. However, Two Under was subsequently declared unruly.

RACE 9 — HOUSE OF PAGANI MOBILE PACE

The official programme was delayed ten minutes from this race onwards. Jumping Jack Flash broke in the run home as did Bourbon Chief and Astral Bay.

RACE 10 — INTERNATIONAL CLASSIC OPEN — CONSOLATION

Grandmaster paced roughly as the barrier pulled away. Judicial broke after 200 m.

All competitors in Races 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10 were tested together with the balance of the inter-dominion heat runners.

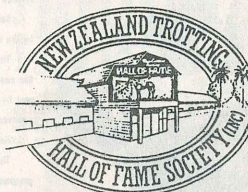

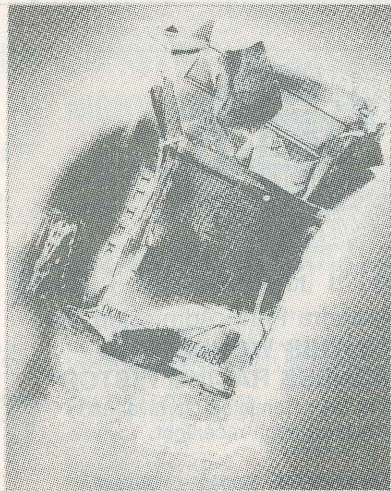

Where tobacco concerns are investing in sponsorship, the price is often paid by young New Zealanders.

The Health Sponsorship Council's Lifespan programme has been set up to end that contradiction.

And to assist tobacco sponsored organisations as they move into a healthier future.

Over the next few years, Lifespan proposes to phase out tobacco sponsorships and, wherever necessary, replace them with its own support.

It's a small price to pay for a healthy New Zealand.

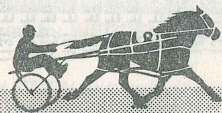

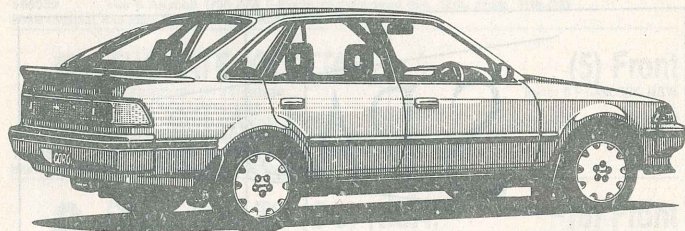

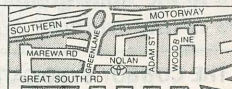

New Zealand Trotting Conference

In pursuance and exercise of the power contained in section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, the New Zealand Trotting Conference resolves to, and does hereby make the following rules controlling the admission of persons to all racecourses used by racing clubs which are now, or may at any time hereafter be registered with the said New Zealand Trotting Conference.

RULES Under the Racing Act 1971

1. These rules shall come into force on the day after the day on which they are published in the New Zealand Gazette.
 2. In these rules the words "racecourse", "racing club", and "race meeting" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by Section 2 of the Racing Act 1971, and the word "bookmaker" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto by the Gaming Act 1908, or any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution of such Act.
 3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from all racecourses used by racing clubs which are or may at any time hereafter be registered with the New Zealand Trotting Conference while such racecourses, or any thereof, are being used by any Club for a race meeting, namely:
 - (a) All persons under disqualification imposed under New Zealand Rules of Racing or the New Zealand Rules of Trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside New Zealand which have reciprocal agreement in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or the New Zealand Trotting Conference;
 - (b) Bookmakers;
 - (c) Persons convicted of theft, burglary, receiving stolen goods, robbery, unlawful taking or conversion of a motor car or other vehicle, false pretences, forgery, uttering, possession of counterfeit coin, or assault;
 - (d) Persons convicted of any offences under the Gaming Act 1908, or of any of the following offences under the Crimes Act 1961; murder, attempted murder, manslaughter (not based on negligence), sections 188-204 (which relate to assaults and injuries to the person), sections 294-297 (which relate to arson or attempt there at), crimes involving dishonesty or conspiracy to commit a crime, indecent acts, sexual offences, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
 - (e) Persons convicted of an offence against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Narcotics Act 1965, or against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
 - (f) Persons convicted in countries outside New Zealand of offences corresponding to those mentioned in paragraph (d) or paragraph (e).
- Provided always that a committee established by the New Zealand Racing and Trotting Conferences upon being satisfied as to character and otherwise that any person who, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of these rules should have relief from the effect thereof may grant exemption to any such person.

4. The rules previously made by the New Zealand Trotting Conference under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the New Zealand Gazette, of 22 November 1973, on P.2438, and which were deemed to have been revoked at midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976, have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time before midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976. In every other respect such revoked rules thereafter have no effect. The rules previously made by the New Zealand Trotting Conference under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the New Zealand Gazette, and shall thereafter have the effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time between midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976 and midnight on the day on which these rules are published in the said Gazette. In every other respect such revoked rules shall hereafter have no effect.

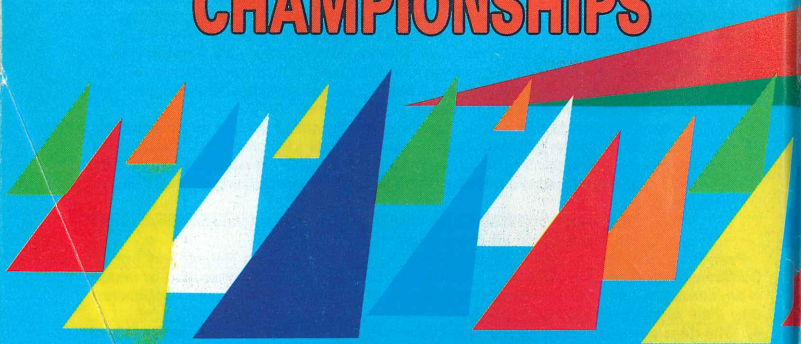
