

STEWARDS REPORT

26TH FEBRUARY, 1992

VALIANT PRESS STAKES (First Heat): The following horses were pre-race blood tested with a negative result in each case: "Apple Graft", "Rameka (NZ)", "Gavilson" and "Moon Dark". As a result of the totalizator breaking down, the Stewards directed that this race start at 7.10 p.m., Race 2 at 7.37 p.m. and Race 3 at 8.05 p.m. The race started one minute later than the amended starting time. "Gavilson" (P. D. Carrafa) raced roughly, and lost ground near the despatch point.G. C. Martin "Rameka (NZ)" was reprimanded regarding the manner in which he used his whip during this event. "Devil Grant" (N. J. Webberley) broke without interference near the 900 metres.A warning was issued. "Gavilson" (P. D. Carrafa) was momentarily inconvenienced near the 900 metres when "High Potential" (D. V. Dove) shifted out. D. V. Dove was advised to use more care when shifting ground infuture. The Stewards opened an inquiry into T. E. Demmler's handling of "The Main Report (NZ)" in this race, and after takingsome evidence adjourned the inquiry to a date to be fixed. The first half of the last mile was covered in 61.9 seconds. A swabsample was taken from "Imprint" (P. J. Wells), the winner of the race.

THE INTER DOMINION 1992 QUIT TROTTING CHAMPIONSHIP (Third Heat): The following horses were pre-race blood tested witha negative result in each case: Kano Joe", "Maoris Glory", "Con's Poem", "Lenin" and "Fraggle Rock (NZ)". This race started at 19:38. The Stewards severely reprimanded G. R. Conroy "Spikealite" for allowing this horse to shift in near the winning post on the first occasion, and brush "Maoris Glory" (Gavin Lang). "Dark Edge" (G. A. Lang) was caught three wide in the early stagesuntil it gained a position outside of the leader. "Con's Poem" (D. A. Semmens), which was unable to obtain a clear run, brushed the sulky of "Spikealite" (G. R. Conroy) near the 200 metres, and broke. The Stewards deemed this to be a racing incident. The timing restriction did not apply in this race. A swab sample was taken from "Maoris Glory" (Gavin Lang), the winner of the race, and from "Game Paul (NZ)" (P. G. O'Reilly), second placegetter in the race.

CARBINE CHEMICALS HANDICAP: The following horses were pre-race blood tested with a negative result in each case: "CityFinal", "Pappy McCoy", "Cols Flyer", "Lord Greystoke" and "Halyer". This race started at the amended time of 20:05. "Stylish Adios" (J. D. Justice), which galloped as the start was effected and lost considerable ground, will continue to be

Webberley) hung that, and as a result "Cols Flyer" (R. Serhan) lost a position in the one wide line, and raced three wide for the remainder of the event. A warning was issued regarding the racing behaviour of "Halyer". Near the 400 metres, "Cols Flyer" (R. Serhan) began to tire and hung in, tightening the ground of "Holy Smoke" (R. J. Thomson), which had to be checked. The first half of the last mile was covered in 60.4 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "Halyer" (N. J. Webberley), the winner of the race.

THE INTER DOMINION 1992 QUIT PACING CHAMPIONSHIP (Fourth Heat): The following horses were pre-race blood tested with a negative result in each case: Master Musician (NZ)", "Zulu Lou", "Level Advice", "Thomas Magnum" and "Impressionist (NZ)". This race started at 20:32. "Thomas Magnum" (N. J. Webberley) was slow to begin, and will continue to be excluded from the mobile barrier draw.The Stewards reprimanded N. J. Webberley "Thomas Magnum" for allowing this horse to shift in soon after the start, causing "Impressionist (NZ)" (T. E. Demmler) to lose its position in the one wide line for a short distance.V. Frost "Westburn Grant" was reprimanded for allowing this horse to shift out near the 900 metres, and as a result of this "Impressionist (NZ)" (T. E. Demmler) was again inconvenienced for ashort distance.In the back straight on the final occasion, "Impressionist (NZ)" (T. E. Demmler) had to be eased and lost ground when "Thorate" (B. P. Hancock) shifted out. The Stewards reprimanded B. P. Hancock, and told him that in future he must exercise more care when shifting ground.The first half of the last mile was covered in 62 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "Level Advice" (A. D. Peace), the winner of the race, and from "MasterMusician (NZ)" (R. J. Dunn), second placegetter in the race.

THE INTER DOMINION 1992 QUIT TROTTING CHAMPIONSHIP (Fourth Heat): The following horses were pre-race blood tested with a negative result in each case: "Lyn's Choice (NZ)", "Dashing Chief", "Gee Du Jour (NZ)" and "Idle Scott (NZ)". This race started at 20:57. "French Wine (NZ)" (F. Thacker), which broke in the score-up will continue to be excluded from the mobile barrier draw. "Glenfield Girl" (I.R. Lee), which broke near despatch point, will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw. "French Wine (NZ)" (F. Thacker) broke for a short distance near the 900 metres. Near the 600 metres, "Guardian Angel (NZ)" (J. O'Sullivan) broke. After questioning J. O'Sullivan "Guardian Angel (NZ)" and J. W. Langdon "William Dee (NZ)", and viewing the official video, the Stewards gave Langdon the benefit of a doubt as to whether his shifting out had caused thetrouble to "Guardian Angel (NZ)", or whether "Guardian Angel (NZ)", as stated by J. O'Sullivan, was inclined to race roughlyof its own accord, but informed Langdon that they would expect him to use more care under similar circumstances. Near the 400metres, "French Wine (NZ)" was tightened for room and broke when racing between "Lyn's Choice (NZ)" (N. L. Cavallaro), which had shifted out fractionally, and "Idle Scott (NZ)" (D. K. Gibbons), which had shifted in.D. K. Gibbons "Idle Scott (NZ)" was also reprimanded for the manner in which he used his whip at this stage. The timing restriction did not apply in this race. A swab sample was taken from "Lyn's Choice (NZ)" (N. L. Cavallaro), the winner of the race, and from "Gee DuJour (NZ)" (A. G. Herilhy), the second placegetter in the race,

THE INTER DOMINION 1992 QUIT PACING CHAMPIONSHIP (Fifth Heat): The following horses were pre-race blood tested with anegative result in each case: Lord Muckalee', "Christopher Vance (NZ)", "Tip Top Prince', "Defoe (NZ)" and "Imprimartar". This race started at 21:25. "Almeta Boy" (B. R. Gath), which was unable to obtain a clear run, bumped the sulky of "Zakara" (G. E. Hall) near the 180 metres, and raced roughly. The Stewards charged D. W. Wilson "Meadow Mirage" under Rule 380 for allowing this horse to shift out near the 800 metres when not sufficiently clear of "Smooth Genghis (USA)" (B. Purdon), resulting in "Smooth Genghis (USA)" (Boing its position in the three wide line and having to travel wider on the track. Wilson was found guilty as charged, and after considering a submission on penalty he was fined the sum of \$400.The Stewards questioned A. G. Herlihy, driver of "Christopher Vance (NZ)", and trainer B. Purdon, regarding the improvement in this horse's performance tonight as compared with its run on Saturday last. Herlihy explained that he horse had to work hard to obtain the lead on Saturday night, and had failed to run on over the concluding stages, and he had decided tonight not to usethe horse as much in the early stages of the race. Purdon explained that, although "Christoper Vance (NZ)" was forced to work hard in the early stages on Saturday night, he had been disappointed that the horse had tired to the extent that it did. Purdon added that on Monday he had a veterinary surgeon

examine "Christoper Vance (NZ)". This examination revealed that the horse may have been slightly jadedafter its flight from New Zealand, and this may have contributed to "Christopher Vance (NZ)" failing to run the race out on Saturday night. "Zakara" (G. E. Hall) shifted out when under pressure over theconcluding stages. The first half of the last mile was covered in 59.9 seconds.A swab sample was taken from "Christopher Vance (NZ)" (A. G. Herlihy), the winner of the race, and from "Lord Muckalee" (G. J. Morgan), the second placegetter in the race.

SOUTHERN CROSS THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLIES CLASSIC: The following horses were pre-race blood tested with a negative result in each case: "Sarina Alto", "Scottish Del (NZ)", "Misty Maiden", "Veronica Vance (NZ)", "Roses Heart" and "Whitby Tolez". This race started at 21:53. "Sarina Alto" (R. R. Benger) broke for a few strides in the score-up, but had regained its position prior to the start being effected. "Banjo Miss" (P. G. Manning) was slow to begin, which inconvenienced "Roses Heart" (N. J. Webberley). "Scottish Del (NZ)" (M. D. Webster), which failed to complete the course, was examined by the Board's Veterinary Surgeon, who reported that this filly was lame in the near fore leg. The Stewards informed J. Carbone, trainer of "Scottish Del (NZ)", that this filly will be barred from racing for 28 days, and that a veterinary certificate of soundness must be lodged with the Harness Racing Board before "Scottish Del (NZ)" will be permitted to race again. A swab sample was taken from "Scottish Del (NZ)". Near the 1100 metres, "Scottish Del (NZ)" (M. D. Webster), which was tiring, hung in and bumped "Sarina Alto" (R. R. Benger), causing this filly to race roughly for a few strides. "Sarina Alto" (R. B. Benger), causing this filly to race roughly for a few strides. "Sarina Alto" (R. B. Benger), causing this filly to race.

THE INTER DOMINION 1992 QUIT PACING CHAMPIONSHIP (Sixth Heat): The following horses were pre-race blood tested with anegativeresult in each case: Starship (NZ)", "Sogo (NZ)", "On Parade", "Franco Tiger" and "Generator". This race started at 22:21. The Stewards questioned B. R. Gath "Franco Tiger" and T. E. Demmler "Bowmal Boy (NZ)" regarding an incident which occurred soon after the start where "Bowral Boy (NZ)" shifted in and raced roughly. As a result, "On Parade" (S. Ford) and "Aapennon Lad" (A. A. Cachia) were checked, and both horses broke. After taking evidence from the drivers and viewing the official video, it was found that "Bowral Boy (NZ)" had shifted in of its own accord soon after the start, and tightened the ground of "Sogo (NZ)" (B. Purdon). Soon after "Bowral Boy (NZ)" was inconvenienced slightly when "Franco Tiger shifted in. "Bowral Boy (NZ)" will be expected to improve its racing behaviour, and B. R. Gath "Franco Tiger" was informed will be must give horses racing on his inside more room under similar circumtances. Near the 500 metres, "Starship (NZ)" (P. G. O'Reilly) cast itsnear fore shoe. The first half of the last mile was covered in 60.6 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "Blossom Lady (NZ)" (A. M. Butt), the winner of the race, and from "Franco Tiger" (B. R. Gath), the second placegetter in the race.

VALIANT PRESS STAKES (Second Heat): The following horses were pre-race blood tested with a negative result in each case: "Dial a Buck (NZ)", "The Cruise Control", "Meadowlands Mick" and "Abbeville". This race started at 22:49. "Moon Fella (NZ)" (J. Tortona), which broke in the score-up, will be excluded from the mobile barrier draw. "Moon Fella (NZ)" (J. Tortona) brokea centre hopple carrying strap, and was retired from the race in the middle stages. "Hazel Daphne" (J. L. McGuinness), which broke near the 800 metres, checking "Dominion Red" (G. A. Lang) and "Meadowlands Mick (P. G. Gath), will be barred from racing for 28 days for what the Stewards considered to be an unsatisfactory performance. The Stewards questioned B. R. Gath "The Cruise Control" and G. Peace Coneden" regarding an incident which occurred near the 200 metres where "Coneden" was endeavouringto obtain a run inside of "The Cruise Control". After taking evidence from the drivers concerned, and viewing the official video, the Stewards reprimanded Peace for attempting to obtain a run where there was insufficient room, and informed Gath that he must drive with his body inside the confines of his sulky at all times. "Coneden" (G. Peace) was unable to obtain a clear run. "Meadowlands Mick" (P. G. Gath) was unable to obtain a clear run until near the 80 metres. The Stewards will question P. G.Gath "Meadlowlands Mick" at their earliest convenience regarding this horse losing ground prior to the start being effected. The first half of the last mile was covered in 63.6 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "Fawlty" (D. A. Murphy), the winner of the race. All horses which were swabbed were inspected. Their hopples were measured, and those measurements recorded.

NOTICE TO DRIVERS SECTIONAL TIMES

The Sectional Time Requirements for Moonee Valley are as

(a) Drivers are required to complete the first half of the mile in 65 seconds for Metropolitan Penalty Bearing (MPB) races and 67 seconds for other events excluding 2YO and 3YO trotters races and races over a distance longer than 2380 metres.

(b) A concession of 1 second in the Sectional Time Requirement will apply for MPB races conducted over 2380 metres when the first portion of the race to the mile point is completed in 59

seconds or less.

(c) Stewards have been directed to take into consideration factors that may have led to an infringement of the Sectional Time Regulations when determining whether an offence has been committed and before imposing penalties.

SECTIONAL TIME LIGHTS

To assist Drivers to assess 'race speed' a light has been installed at the 1206 metre point. This light will be activated 32.5 seconds after the leading horse passes the 1609 metre mark.

This light will allow Drivers to determine whether the pace of the race has to be quickened to complete the section (the first half of the last mile) in the required 65 seconds or less.

No other lights will be activated around the track during the course of each race.

FIELD SIZES & MOBILE STARTS

TWO ROWS

Generally, a maximum of 11 horses will contest mobile start races with 8 on the front row and 3 trailing.

Horses declared "Out of the barrier Draw in Mobile start races" (ODM), usually for unruly behaviour, will be placed in the outermost barrier positions on the front row.

In the event a horse is scratched at any time after the declaration of fields, the remaining horses on that row only shall move toward the rails to occupy the scratched horse's vacant position. Horses from the second row will not move on to the front row.

NOTICE TO PATRONS RULES OF BETTING — BETTING LIMITS

A bookmaker betting on the Rails or in the Market Place at Moonee Valley who is offering odds against a horse shall not refuse to lay such odds to any sum demanded provided that the bookmaker shall not be compelled to risk more than \$1,000 on any wager. Furthermore, a bookmaker betting off the rails at Moonee Valley or outside the metropolitan area shall not be compelled to risk more than \$600 on any wager.

All Moonee Valley patrons are advised that Concession and Place Bookmakers can use a "Win Only This Horse" sign when the favourite opens at odds on. It should be noted this sign will be displayed against the one horse for the duration of betting.


