# MOBILE START PROCEDURE

In most cases a false start in a mobile barrier event will only be declared in accordance with Rule 216.

#### **RULE 326**

The Starter may defer the start if at the designated starting point:-

- a horse has fallen:
- the chances of any runner have been or are being materially affected by interference;
- a horse has broken equipment;
- any horse is not fully behind the arms of the barrier or if a horse scores ahead of the barrier;
- any horse is likely to gain an unfair advantage; or
- any horse has by reason of its position at the start been denied a winning opportunity, provided that a start will not be deferred merely by reason of the fact that a horse is in a break or because a horse is back from its barrier position at the time of starting.

Provided that the Starter will always have the power to abort a start as outlined in Rule 317, should something untoward occur.

#### **RULE 317**

The Starter shall endeavour to get all horses away in position and in gait and may abort a start should he for any reason not be satisfied with the score up.

#### EXTRACT FROM REGULATIONS UNDER THE RACING AND GAMING ACT, 1952. Regulation 157

- Subject to subregulation 92), if (a) a bookmaker carries on the business of bookmaking on a racecourse in this State; and
  - (b) the bookmaker offers odds against a horse or dog; and (c) a bettor tenders a bet on that horse or dog -
- the bookmaker is to lay those odds to a sum not exceeding \$100 if demanded by the bettor, but so that the bookmaker is not obliged to lose more than \$700 in respect of that bet.
- Subject to subregulation (2), if -
  - (a) a bookmaker carries on the business of bookmaking on a racecourse in this State; and
  - (b) the bookmaker decides to accept each way bets on a particular race; and (c) the bookmaker offers odds against a horse or dog; and

  - (d) a bettor tenders an each way bet on that horse or dog in that race -
- the bookmaker is to lay those odds to a sum not exceeding \$100 each way if demanded by the bettor, but so that the bookmaker is not obliged to lose more than \$875 in respect of that bet.
- (a) a bookmaker carries on the business of bookmaking on the racecourse at King Island; and (b) the bookmaker offers odds against a horse; and
- (c) a bettor tenders a bet on that horse -
- the bookmaker is to lay those odds to a sum not exceeding \$20 if demanded by the bettor, but so that the bookmaker is not obliged to lose more than \$200 in respect of that bet.

#### Regulation 161

#### Concession Betting

- 161a A concession bet is subject to the following conditions:-
  - (a) that if a bettor selects the winner, the bookmaker is to pay the bettor the face value of the betting ticket;
  - (b) that if the bettor selects the second-placegetter, the bookmaker is to return the stake to the bettor;
- (c) that if there is a dead-heat for first place and a bettor selects one of the dead-heaters, the bookmaker is to return the stake plus one half of the amount that the bettor would have won had the competitor the bettor selected
- (d) that if there is a triple dead-heat for the first place and a bettor selects one of the dead-heaters, the bookmaker is to return two thirds of the stake plus one third of the amount that the bettor would have won had the competitor the bettor selected been the only winner;
- (e) that if there is a dead-heat for second place and a bettor selects one of the dead-heaters the bookmaker is to return the stake divided by the number of dead-heaters;
  - (f) that the bet is void if the race becomes a walk-over.

#### Odds and Evens Betting

- 161b An odds and evens bet is subject to the following conditions;(a) that the number of a competitor in a race is the number of the competitor set out for that race in the programme produced by the body conductiong the race;
- (b) that the bookmaker is to pay the bettor the face value of the ticket if a bettor correctly selects odd numbers or even numbers as the group of numbers to which the number of the winner of a race belongs;
- (c) that the bet is void if a race results in a dead-heat between an even numbered competitor and an odd numbered competitor.



RACE 1: Jay Miles (Sam Rawnsley) broke in the score up and has been placed out of the draw. Rodney Ashwood (Harmonia) was reprimanded for throwing his head back contacting Jay Miles (Sam Rawnsley). Harmonia which led hung in and tired noticeably. Won Way Ticket (Robert Walters) pulled hard and tired. Future Road (Christian Salter) performed poorly. Ted Demler (Paksa Punch) was reprimanded for being late on the track.

RACE 2: Bouncing Back (Brian Hancock) broke in the score up and will be out of the draw. Security Risk (Don Peck) broke after the start and has been placed out of the draw. Pedestal Boy was back from its position at the start. Driver Gavin Lang was reprimanded for not making sufficient effort to take up his allotted position. Ted Demmler (Cango) was reprimanded for contacting the pylons. Indy Aaron was examined by the Veterinary Surgeon after the event and found to be sore and will be stood down until a Veterinary Certificate of soundness is received.

RACE 3: Strezlecki Lady (Don Peck) was back at the start. Dennis Wilson (Late Bid NZ) was reprimanded for inconveniencing Jack Boyer (Barrie Rattray). Stewards spoke to Ken Barron driver of Bradshaw NZ as to the reason he handed the lead to Our Sir Vancelot without any challenge racing to receive the bell. Barron said Bradshaw raced its best with a sit and although there was only 750 metres to go, he felt that to keep Our Sir Vancelot out he would have to use a lot of energy but to get a sit behind that horse he believed his chances would be enhanced. Stewards noted his explanations but told him they would expect to see a consistency in his driving tactics.

RACE 4: Our Andi (Anthony Waddington) galloped away and has been placed out of the draw. Our Rocky Knight (Don Peck) broke. Ice Hawk (Tony Herlihy) galloped away. Rodney Ashwood (Bey Contender) was found guilty of careless driving in that he abruptly shifted away from the rails checking Run Jerry (Bill Dornauf). His driving licence was suspended for three race dates.

RACE 5: Hoppys Jet NZ (Graham Lang) broke and checked Shiver Me Timbers (Ricky Duggan).

RACE 6: The Parisian (Michael Castles) was out of position at the start.

RACE 7: Tony Herlihy was reprimanded on Try A Fluke in that he allowed it to shift wide in the home straight into the back straight on the final occasion Sam Malone (Jim O'Sullivan) carried Skipper Trust wider. David Murphy (Skipper Trust) attempted to hold his position tight on Sam Malone and broke. Northern Brewer (Mark Stanley) was checked. Stewards did not believe that Jim O'Sullivan was entirely responsible and told Murphy under similar circumstances he would be expected to concede he had lost the position.

RACE 8: Jagged Ruler (Gavin Lang) hung in against the efforts of the driver forcing Saint Peters Pass (Scott Ford) inside the pylons and eventually that pacer broke. The offside hopple connecting strap of Saint Peters Pass broke. Rug Rat Donny (Ken Austin) was unable to obtain a clear run.

## **FALSE STARTS**

The THRB has adopted the following policy in respect of false starts in mobile races, to commence from 8/4/94.

Firstly, if a horse misbehaves and causes a false start, it will score up from its allocated barrier position for the second attempt. (In extreme cases, Stewards may still scratch a horse or send it to the outside after the first offence),

Secondly, if it again causes a false start it will be sent to the outside.

The starter will still call false starts only if a horse is interfered with or denied a fair chance to start. No false start will be called simply if a horse misbehaves without interfering with other runners.

Tasmania was the only State which sent an offending horse to the outside after it caused a first false start.

The procedure outlined above is in line with the system currently operating in Victoria.

## Dear Participant,

The Club is concerned as we are sure you are, with the possibility of a child being injured in the area of the race day stalls and seeks your help in minimising the potential risks.

It would be appreciated if at any time that you have children in your care, they are maintained under your control and not exposed to unnecessary dangerous situations during a race or trial meeting.

Whilst it is recognized that in lots of cases the children are totally at ease around horses, unfortunately accidents do happen and none of us wants any person injured particularly not children.

We hope that you will understand the Club's concern and help us make the environment a little safer.

During the period of the Cadbury Inter Dominion, only people with appropriate passes will be permitted in the restricted stable area. This policy has been arrived at by the Club in consultation with and at the request of Harness Racing Tasmania's Stewards.

The passes will be issued to participating trainers, drivers, nominated strappers and owners of participating horses. Consequently, unless a child is old enough to be acting as a strapper for a specific horse and is issued with the suitable pass, (in which case no other person will be accredited as a strapper for that horse), children will not be admitted to the stabling area.

(3) Where authorized people entering the stables have children in arms the child will be admitted.

PRAMS AND STROLLERS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED TO STABLING AREA.

Whilst these provisions have been introduced prior to the Inter Dominion, they are safety issues that will impact on the industry. The conditions will be retained in some form after the Inter. Your understanding and co-operation with these three matters is appreciated.


