AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB - FRIDAY 12TH MARCH, 1999 Weather: FINE - Track: FAST

1. TV GUIDE HANDICAP PACE: As D. Butcher had not arrived at the course on time due to a traffic accident on the motorway permission was granted for M. McKendry to be substituted as the driver of RITCHIE'S DREAM, C De Fillipi driver of SHARDON'S STAR when questioned, as to the reason for him improving four wide at the 1400m, stated that he had committed the horse forward prior to YULESTAR shifting outwards and therefore did not consider that he had been forced wider at this stage. Rounding the home turn the final time ROBINSON CRUSOE broke, ran inwards making contact with the sulky on SHARDON'S STAR continuing on inwards and interfering with RICHIE'S DREAM. The connections of ROBINSON CRUSOE were issued with a warning in regard to this horse's

2. DIRECT FORMS 7TH PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT: In the home straight BROTHER TIM was unable to obtain a clear run. HAPPY ASSET was caught three wide for the final 1000m, and in the home straight battled on for 4th. 3. PASCOES THE JEWELLERS 5TH TROTTERS QUALIFYING HEAT: NATIONAL INTEREST broke free of interference with 175m left to run losing all chance. MISS WHIPLASH finished an unlucky 4th after getting clear late in the run home. THE PATRIOT was caught three wide in the early stages

4. COCA COLA AMATIL AUSTRALASIAN YOUNG DRIVERS CHAMPIONSPID !! SAT. THE COURTIER was slow to begin when unable to maintain its position on the gate. The win favourite TOC MUCH settled towards the back of the field, commenced to make ground from the 1200m and raced three wide from that stage to the finish, battling on well for 5th place.

5. DAEWOO AUTOMOTIVE NZ 6TH TROTTERS QUALIFYING HEAT: GLOBE TROTTER broke at the start losing several lengths. AVATAR was caught three wide in the middle stages.

The connections of NOOPY KIOSK made application to have the horse removed from the unruly. The Stipendiary Stewards after giving this matter due consideration declined the application after taking into account this horse's performance during the series.

6. INDEPENDENT TELECOM LTD 8TH PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT: Racing into the first turn POCKET BATTLESHIP which was contesting for the lead broke, ran inwards checking BRABHAM which in turn checked ROYMARK back onto KATE'S FIRST. A protest was lodged against POCKET BATTLESHIP being declared 6th on the grounds of interfering indirectly with ROYMARK which finished 7th. The Judicial Committee, after hearing the relative evidence, upheld the protest relegating POCKET BATTLESHIP to 7th. An associated charge was laid against horseman R. Byrnes under Rule 869 (4) for the manner in which he drove POCKET BATTLESHIP into the first turn. After hearing the evidence the JCA gave R. Byrnes the benefit of the doubt and the charge was dismissed. The favourite BRABHAM after receiving the early check raced one out and one back and improved outwards at the top of the home straight finishing on well for second placing. M. Purdon when questioned as to the reason for him not improving outwards near the 600m when MASTERCLASS improved three wide, stated that at that stage BRABHAM was not traveling well enough and he was only able to come half way out prior to being put back. POCKET BATTLESHIP hung in throughout the event striking several pylons when rounding the home turn.

7. PCL INDUSTRIES LIMITED 7TH TROTTERS QUALIFYING HEAT: An information was lodged against driver J. Smith under Rule 857 (7) (g) in that he failed to come up into position with MOUNTAIN GOLD in the score up behind the mobile gate, prior to the start. The Judicial Committee after hearing the relative evidence found the charge proven and fined J. Smith the sum of \$175,00. Shortly after the start KINGFISH KIWI broke losing considerable ground and may chance in the event. After traveling approximately 400m MOUNTAIN GOLD commenced to trot roughly, broke and lost considerable ground and any chance in the event. Rounding the home turn J K DEE broke momentarily. In the home straight KAWARAU INVASION broke under pressure. The favourite CEDAR FELLA which raced three wide in the early stages appeared to trot roughly on the turns, however, this horse finished on well in the home straight for 4th placing.

8. WOODLANDS STUD 9TH PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT: B. Hancock horseman of SIR VANCELOT was warned in regard to striking the pylons inside the last 400m, it was also observed that the horse had a tendency to lay in at this stage. The favourite SIR VANCELOT raced three back or, the running line then in the home straight was held up when unable to obtain a clear run.

9. CHEVALIER EQUESTRIAN LTD INTER-DOMINION DRIVERS CHALLENGE: In the home straight the hood worn by PAY GOLD failed to release and the driver J. Langdon dropped his whip with approximately 150m to run after it became entangled in the hood cord.

10. BAX GLOBAL (NZ) LTD 10TH PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT: A charge was laid against B. Hancock the driver of QUANTUM LOBELL under Rule 868 (3) in that he failed to drive 4th placed QUANTUM LOBELL out to the end of the race when he had a reasonable chance of running third. After hearing the relative evidence from the parties concerned and viewing the videos the J.C.A Committee dismissed the Information.

QUANTUM LOBELL the favourite raced outside the leader without cover throughout the race, battling on well for 4th placing.



- 6. The receptacles on each of the first three nights of the Carnival will be emptied on course thirty (30) minutes after the last heat each night and by the NZTABs at their designated closing time for that night. The NZTABs , in an arrangement with the Club shall forward all entries received nest day to the Club by Courier Post. Each draw will be conducted under the supervision of the Chief Racecourse Inspector from Harness Racing New Zealand whose decision as to the eligibility of the tickets is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 7. The name of the entrant drawn to go into the final draw will after each night tha a draw takes place, be broadcast on the course and over Trackside and on Radio Pacific. Drawers of winning tickets for the first two nights will also be notified by the Club.
- 8. After the last of the eligible races has been run and the last draw made, The twenty-one (21) successful tickets will go forward to the second stage draw by lot which shall take place in the Victory Circle after Race Nine on the programme. The entrant with the first ticket drawn at the second stage will receive the IN THE POCKET prize and the second ticket drawn will win the TROUBLEMAKER prize.
- By entering a ticket in a draw the owner of that ticket authorises its destruction at any time after completion of the draw in which it was entered.

- 12. A contact confirming the nomination for the IN THE POCKET and TROUBLEMAKER service will then be issued by Woodlands Stud and Karamea Farm to the winners.
- 13. If the winner elects to accept the service nomination, the service nomination will be on a guaranteed 42-day positive pregnancy test. If the mare does not succeed in getting a 42-day positive pregnancy test in the 1999 breeding season, then a payment in cash of the market value of the service fee will be paid to the winner on presentation of a veterinary certificate to this effect.
- 14. It will be the responsibility of the winner to insure the foetus. There will be no free return service in IN THE POCKET or TROUBLEMAKER and there will be no live foal guarantee.
- 15. If a 42-day positive pregnancy test is issued then the foetus will be at the sole risk of the winner from that date and there will be no further obligation or any party after that date.
- The prize is not transferable and connot be sold.
- Any entrant may be required to produce identification and / or proof of age.
- 18. Directors, Committee, Stewards, Employees, Staff and their families of the Auckland Trotting Club, Woodlands Stud and Karamea Farm, the Auckland Totalisator Consortium, TAB and raceday officials are not eligible to enter this promotion.
- 19. The winner agrees to cooperate fully with the Auckland Trotting Club and Woodlands Stud in respect of his or her success in the competition, including photographs and publication of the winner's name. "Family relates to "blood family" (or by adoption) and specifically; Father, Mother, Brother, Sister, Son, Daughter, Husband, Wife and De Facto are to be excluded. #### AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB (INC.) HARNESS RACING NEW ZEALAND

In pursuance and exercise of the power contained in section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, Harness Racing New Zealand resolves to, and does hereby make the following Rules controlling the admission of persons to all race courses used by racing clubs which are now, or may at any time hereafter be registered with the said Harness Racing New Zealand.

#### RULES (Under the Racing Act 1971)

- These rules shall come into force on the day after the day on which they are published in the "New Zealand Gazette."
- 2. In these rules the words "racecourse", "racing club", and "race meeting" shall have meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by Section 2 of the Racing Act 1971, and the word "bookmaker" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto by the Gaming Act 1908, or any subsequent Act consolidation or in substitution of such Act.
- 3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from all racecourses used by racing clubs which are or may at any time hereafter be registered with the Harness Racing New Zealand while such racecourses, or any thereof, are being used by any club for a race meeting, namely:
  - (a) All persons under disqualification imposed under New Zealand Rules of Racing or the New Zealand Rules of Trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside of New Zealand which have reciprocal agreement in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or Harness Racing New Zealand;
  - (b) Bookmakers;
  - (c) Persons convicted of theft, burglary, receiving stolen goods, robbery, unlawful taking or conversion of a motor car or other vehicles, false pretences, forgery, uttering, possession of counterfeit coin, or assault;
  - (d) Persons convicted of any offence under the Gaming Act 1908, or of any of the following offences under the Crimes Act 1961; murder, attempted murder, manslaughter (not based on negligence), sections 188-204 (which relate to assaults and injuries to the person), sections 294-297 (which relate to arson or attempt threat), crimes involving dishonesty or conspiracy to commit a crime, indecent acts, sexual offences, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
  - (e) Persons convicted of an offence against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Narcotics Act 1965, or against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
  - (f) Persons convicted in countries outside New Zealand of offences corresponding to those mentioned in paragraph (d) or paragraph (e); Provided always that a committee established by the New Zealand Racing Conference and Harness Racing New Zealand upon being satisfied as to the character and otherwise that any person whom, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of these rules should have relief from the effect thereof may grant an exemption to any such person.
- 4. The rules previously made by the Harness Racing New Zealand under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the "New Zealand Gazette", of 22 November 1973, on P.2438, and which were deemed to have been revoked at midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976, have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time before midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976. In every other respect such revoked rules thereafter have no effect. The rules previously made by the Harness Racing New Zealand under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the "New Zealand Gazette", shall thereafter have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time between midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976 and midnight on the day on which these rules are published in the said Gazette. In every other respect such revoked rules shall hereafter have no effect.
