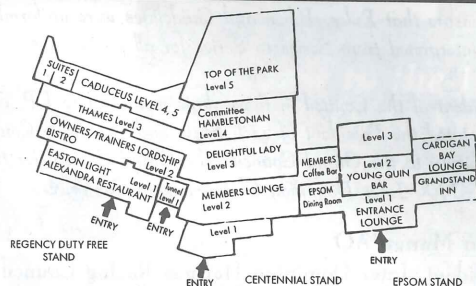

CANCELLATION RULES

No cancellations will be allowed for bets with a value of \$200 or greater via betting terminals within 15 minutes of scheduled race start time unless it is cancelled within 2 minutes of the ticket sale. This regulation is applied to protect the integrity and ensure continuing customer confidence in the totalisator system

BETTING VOUCHERS -

Eliminate time spent in queues waiting for cash transactions. Use a betting voucher on course, it is safer than cash. Use the Betting Voucher for - All Bets, Add Dividend Payments to Add \$,s to, Withdraw Cash from at any stage during the meeting. A pin number is encouraged for additional security. Any operator can establish a betting voucher. betting Vouchers can be used at any terminal. Hand the operator your voucher prior to placing your bets or redeeming your pay tickets. The operator will automatically issue a new voucher at the completion of your transactions. The Betting Voucher is on-going and does not have to be redeemed at the end of the meeting. It can also be used at TAB offices.

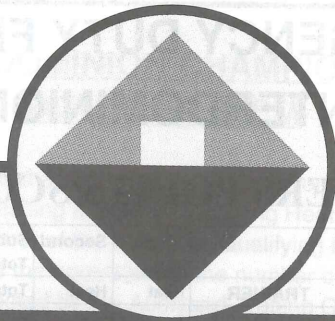
- A. Points shall be awarded to each horse actually starting and finishing a race of Qualifying Heat on the basis that the winner of the race of a Qualifying Heat will receive 12 points the equivalent of the number of horses previously selected by the Auckland Trotting Club as the maximum number of horses to complete in each race of the Qualifying Heats. The second horse in each race of the Qualifying Heats will receive 11 points and the third horse will receive the next lower number with each horse finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding horse.
- B. The winner in each race of a Qualifying Heat will receive four (4) bonus points to be added to the points already earned for that race. The second and third horses in each race of a Qualifying Heat will receive two (2) and one (1) bonus points respectively to be added to the points already earned for that race.
- C. There are no points allocated for fastest time.
- D. A horse that is scratched from a race of the Qualifying heat or a horse that does not complete the race will not be allocated any points for the race of that Qualifying Heat.
- E. In the event of a scratching of a horse not completing the race, points will be allocated as before with the winner and other horses finishing the race entitled to receive their maximum number of points as if a full field had completed and finished in the course in that particular race.
- F. In the event of a dead heat all points for the horses dead heating shall be added together and equally divided.
- G. The judge shall place all horses in a race according to the order in which their noses reached the winning post.
- H. In each Qualifying Heat the original number of maximum points allocated for such Heat shall be allocated irrespective of the actual number of starters and irrespective of the variation of the number of Heats on each day or night of racing.

ATC Stalwart

Many locals and visitors alike who attend the 1999 Regency Duty Free InterDominions will be saddened by the absence from the Alexandra Park scene of Ron Robertson.

Ron died suddenly on New Year's Day, ending a long and colourful era of devoted service to harness racing in general and the Auckland Trotting Club in particular.

He was 73.

Stepping down from the ATC executive last year after 31 years of outstanding contribution as an official, he had been fervently looking forward to enjoying the '99 InterDominions as "passenger".

Ably assisted by his wife Mary, Ron Robertson officiated in various capacities during the 1968, '75, '83 and '91 InterDominion carnivals, being President from 1979 to '84.

Widely recognised as Auckland Trotting's greatest ambassador, Ron enthusiastically participated in the sport he loved - as a breeder, owner, trainer and, even at times, as a race driver.

Ruling Credit won him a Pacers' Consolation at the 1975 InterDominions, while other well-performed horses in his interests, here and in Australia, included Spanker On, Stretto, Jacron, Scotch Trick and Regal Notice.

Through the warm hospitality Ron Robinson extended to all and sundry who succumbed to his entreaties to join him in the action at Alexandra Park, "Ronnie Rob" will be fondly remembered for many years to come.

Bob Lovett, former long-time media man and now proprietor of Remuera Fisheries, has relinquished his naming rights as a sponsor for tonight so that the race will honour the memory of Ron Robertson - a gesture admirably reflecting the measure of esteem in which Ron is held.

STIPENDIARY STEWARDS PRESS REPORT

AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB - FRIDAY 5TH MARCH, 1999

Weather : OVERCAST/SHOWERY - Track : FIRM

1. WUNDA MEATS MOBILE PACE - Heading into the back straight on the first occasion MANDRAKE paced roughly when racing ungenerously on the inside of THE BULLDOZE CZAR.

2. GULF HARBOUR FERRIES LTD MOBILE PACE - In the home straight ON PARADE brushed the pylons when taking a narrow opening on the inside of IMPRESSIVE LADY. Shortly after the finishing line IMPRESSIVE LADY became unbalanced. In the early and middle stages ABBEYSHRILE pulled hard and race ungenerously. The connections advised that they would be taking the blinkers off the mare for his next start.

3. BAX GLOBAL (NZ) LTD PACERS 1ST QUALIFYING HEAT - The sulky wheels on both KATE'S FIRST and ADIO ROUTINE needed attention prior to the start. MASTERCLASS was unable to maintain his position on the gate and as a result was slow to begin. With approximately 900m to travel, SCREEN PLAY broke after being checked due to a general easing of the pace. I. Cowie, driver of FROSTY MOTA which was racing in the trail, was shown the tape and advised that he should have taken hold sooner than he did on this occasion. In this incident SCREEN PLAY lost a shoe. SIR VANCELOT, which raced four deep on the running line, ran on strongly when clear finishing in eighth position.

4. SKY CITY TROTTERS 1ST QUALIFYING HEAT - AVATAR broke briefly during the score up and as a result was slow to begin. Shortly after the start JK DEE broke losing several lengths. This horse then broke again with 300m to travel. AVATAR broke with approximately 1100m to run. The connections advised that SUNDON'S WAY lost both front shoes during the running. Favourite MERINAI after contesting for the lead with SPECIAL FORCE for approximately 300m, then elected to race in the trail. The mare appeared to have every chance when moving down into the passing lane through the home straight and fought on well for third placings.

5. MINOLTA NZ LTD HANDICAP PACE - ANOTHER PARTY was a late scratching as the gelding has been sold to overseas interests. M. McKendry, driver of HARRY'S BROTHER, when questioned in regard to his lack of vigour from the 600m, stated that after he had moved wide to commence a run the gelding had dropped the bit and had not stretched out in its normal manner. A subsequent veterinary examination of HARRY'S BROTHER did not reveal any abnormality.

6. NEVELE R STUD PACERS 2ND QUALIFYING HEAT - Nothing to report.

7. MAGNESS BENROW HANDICAP TROT - LAST SUNSET and MAFIOSO broke in the early stages with MAFIOSO losing considerable ground. Rounding the home turn with approximately 300m to travel, SUMMER SQUALL broke when racing in tight quarters between COOL FORCE on its outside and KNOCK KNOCK on the inner. Both these horses shifted ground at the same stage KAIMATA ECHO commenced to give ground.

8. McILROY MOTEL & COMMERCIAL BROKERS QUALIFYING HEAT - A false start was declared when MOUNTAIN GOLD which had drawn the pole, broke in the early stages of the score up interfering with LITTLE ROCK. For the restart MOUNTAIN GOLD was sent to the outside. Also during the score up NOOPY KIOSK trotted roughly. The connections of MOUNTAIN GOLD were issued with a warning to improve the gelding's mobile start manners. In the middle stages ANDREW EYRE was caught three wide without cover. McGRADY commenced to give ground after leaving the 700m. Rounding the home turn with approximately 300m to travel KNIGHT PISTOL, when making a run three wide broke free of interference losing all chance. In the home straight MEANDER IN EDEN had to switch ground outwards in order to obtain a clear run.

The connections of McGRADY made application to scratch the horse from the remainder of the series on account of the horse's performance. The Stipendiary Stewards were satisfied that this was an acceptable reason and did not impose a scratching penalty after the connections gave an assurance that the horse would be given a let up prior to resuming.

9. INTER-ISLAND HORSE TRANSPORT PACERS 3RD QUALIFYING HEAT - Shortly after the start MELTON LUCIAND which had drawn one on the second line, was checked when tightened for room by FRANCO HAT TRICK (B. Purdon) which had initially been taken in by HAPPY ASSET which had been taken in by KLIKILITE. The incident was compounded due to MELTON LUCIAND pacing roughly at this stage and being inclined to run away from the outside horses. After taking into account all the circumstances, no action was taken other than to advise B. Purdon to exercise more care. With 1400m to travel MELTON LUCIAND when hanging out away from the rein burr accidentally struck the wheel on the sulky of FRANCO HAT TRICK. In the home straight HAPPY ASSET was held up when unable to obtain a clear run.

10. CAPITAL PRESS LTD MOBILE PACE - SMOOTH ROYAL was removed from the unruly. An investigation was held into a possible breach of the Push Out Rule with 1300m to travel when it appeared that HO WONG (M. McKendry) had improved three wide momentarily forcing THE SNIPER wider on the track. After establishing that THE SNIPER had contributed to the incident due to its tendency to hang out, and that this horse had regained the three wide position shortly thereafter, no further action was taken other than advising M. McKendry in regard to his obligations under the Push Out Rule. During this incident HO WONG had struck the sulky wheel of JUST SMOOTH resulting in this horse carrying a flat tyre from this stage to the finish.

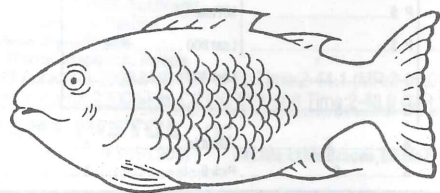

The Prize

The winner of this promotion will receive either a free service of an approved mare to the stallion IN THE POCKET or alternatively at the option of the winner) the market value in cash of the service fee for the 1999 season. the runner-up in this promotion will receive either a free service of an approved mare to the stallion TROUBLEMAKER or alternatively (at the option of the winner) the market value in cash of the service fee for the 1999 season.

Promotion

The promotion comprises two stages. the first stage involves the drawing of one ticket at each of the twenty-one eligible races.

The second stage held after race nine (9) on Grand Final Night involves the drawing of one of those twenty-one tickets as the winning ticket. A second draw shall be held amongst the remaining twenty tickets to determine the winner of the runner-up's prize.

Conditions of Entry

1. The entry form is a betting ticket issued by the Auckland Trotting Club or the NZ Totalisator Agency Board to a person who is over the age of eighteen years. Such entry form may be issued to a person over the age of eighteen years who is appointed to act as a representative on behalf of a person or persons of or over the age of eighteen years not able to get to the course or the NZTAB and to make such investments in this promotion as authorised by such absentee person(s).

2. The entry ticket to be eligible must be a totalisator ticket that complies with the following conditions:

- (i) Have a minimum single investment value of \$10.00
- (ii) Be a ticket that has a single investment value of \$10.00 on any heat, consolation of Grand Final of the InterDominion Championship events.

(iii) Forms part of the totalisator pool from which dividends are declared.

(iv) Have the entrant's name, address and telephone number clearly written or printed on the back of the ticket.

3. A totalisator ticket that has been cancelled prior to the running of a race of which is subject to a refund because of a late scratching is not eligible for entry.

4. The eligible betting ticket can either be a winning or losing ticket.

Patrons can obtain a winning ticket back from the totalisator staff after having such winnings paid out by requesting the return of the ticket from such staff member after it has been processed through the totalisator.

5. There will be a draw in the first stage of the promotion on the night of 9th March to determine the names of the five (5) winning ticket holders with eligible investments on the InterDominion heats on the 5th March to go forward to the final draw. A further draw will be held on the 12th March to determine the names of the five(5) winning ticket holders with eligible investments on the InterDominion heats on the 9th March to go forward to the final draw. A final draw shall be made on the 19th March after Race Nine (9) to determine the names of the seven (7) winning ticket holders with eligible investments on the InterDominion heats of the 12th March and of the names of the four (4) winning ticket holders with eligible investments on the InterDominion Consolations and Grand Finals of the 19th March. Each entry shall be eligible for one draw only. The entry ticket must be lodged in the specially marked receptacles situated around the racecourse or at the NZTABs after any of the eligible races. An eligible ticket may be deposited in such receptacles at any time prior to the final draw following Race Nine(9) on the 19th March. Eligible tickets will only be accepted by the NZTABs for the first three (3) nights of the Carnival ie March 5th, 9th and 12th.

6. The receptacles on each of the first three nights of the Carnival will be emptied on course thirty (30) minutes after the last heat each night and by the NZTABs at their designated closing time for that night. The NZTABs, in an arrangement with the Club shall forward all entries received next day to the Club by Courier Post. Each draw will be conducted under the supervision of the Chief Racecourse Inspector from Harness Racing New Zealand whose decision as to the eligibility of the tickets is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

7. The name of the entrant drawn to go into the final draw will after each night that a draw takes place, be broadcast on the course and over Trackside and on Radio Pacific. Drawers of winning tickets for the first two nights will also be notified by the Club.

8. After the last of the eligible races has been run and the last draw made, The twenty-one (21) successful tickets will go forward to the second stage draw by lot which shall take place in the Victory Circle after Race Nine on the programme. The entrant with the first ticket drawn at the second stage will receive the IN THE POCKET prize and the second ticket drawn will win the TROUBLEMAKER prize.

9. By entering a ticket in a draw the owner of that ticket authorises its destruction at any time after completion of the draw in which it was entered.

10. The winners must elect in writing by 31st March 1999 as to whether they will send a mare to IN THE POCKET or TROUBLEMAKER or take the market value cash amount for the 1999 season. Woodlands Stud would pay the winner by 20th March 2000 after selling and collecting the service fee on behalf of the winner.

11. If the winners elect to send a mare to either IN THE POCKET or TROUBLEMAKER, the mare must be approved by Woodlands Stud of Ross Simpson and must satisfy the terms and conditions set in place for the service of these specific stallions as specified by the respective studs. If the mare is not acceptable, the studs will pay out the market value of the service fee.

12. A contact confirming the nomination for the IN THE POCKET and TROUBLEMAKER service will then be issued by Woodlands Stud and Karamea Farm to the winners.

13. If the winner elects to accept the service nomination, the service nomination will be on a guaranteed 42-day positive pregnancy test. If the mare does not succeed in getting a 42-day positive pregnancy test in the 1999 breeding season, then a payment in cash of the market value of the service fee will be paid to the winner on presentation of a veterinary certificate to this effect.

14. It will be the responsibility of the winner to insure the foetus. There will be no free return service in IN THE POCKET or TROUBLEMAKER and there will be no live foal guarantee.

15. If a 42-day positive pregnancy test is issued then the foetus will be at the sole risk of the winner from that date and there will be no further obligation or any party after that date.

16. The prize is not transferable and cannot be sold.

17. Any entrant may be required to produce identification and / or proof of age.

18. Directors, Committee, Stewards, Employees, Staff and their families of the Auckland Trotting Club, Woodlands Stud and Karamea Farm, the Auckland Totalisator Consortium, TAB and raceday officials are not eligible to enter this promotion.

19. The winner agrees to cooperate fully with the Auckland Trotting Club and Woodlands Stud in respect of his or her success in the competition, including photographs and publication of the winner's name. *Family relates to "blood family" (or by adoption) and specifically; Father, Mother, Brother, Sister, Son, Daughter, Husband, Wife and De Facto are to be excluded. This would therefore allow a Son-in-Law or Daughter-in-Law to be eligible.

AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB (INC.) HARNESS RACING NEW ZEALAND

In pursuance and exercise of the power contained in section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, Harness Racing New Zealand resolves to, and does hereby make the following Rules controlling the admission of persons to all race courses used by racing clubs which are now, or may at any time hereafter be registered with the said Harness Racing New Zealand.

RULES (Under the Racing Act 1971)

1. These rules shall come into force on the day after the day on which they are published in the "New Zealand Gazette."
2. In these rules the words "racecourse", "racing club", and "race meeting" shall have meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by Section 2 of the Racing Act 1971, and the word "bookmaker" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto by the Gaming Act 1908, or any subsequent Act consolidation or in substitution of such Act.
3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from all racecourses used by racing clubs which are or may at any time hereafter be registered with the Harness Racing New Zealand while such racecourses, or any thereof, are being used by any club for a race meeting, namely:
 - (a) All persons under disqualification imposed under New Zealand Rules of Racing or the New Zealand Rules of Trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside of New Zealand which have reciprocal agreement in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or Harness Racing New Zealand;
 - (b) Bookmakers;
 - (c) Persons convicted of theft, burglary, receiving stolen goods, robbery, unlawful taking or conversion of a motor car or other vehicles, false pretences, forgery, uttering, possession of counterfeit coin, or assault;
 - (d) Persons convicted of any offence under the Gaming Act 1908, or of any of the following offences under the Crimes Act 1961; murder, attempted murder, manslaughter (not based on negligence), sections 188-204 (which relate to assaults and injuries to the person), sections 294-297 (which relate to arson or attempt threat), crimes involving dishonesty or conspiracy to commit a crime, indecent acts, sexual offences, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
 - (e) Persons convicted of an offence against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Narcotics Act 1965, or against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
 - (f) Persons convicted in countries outside New Zealand of offences corresponding to those mentioned in paragraph (d) or paragraph (e);
Provided always that a committee established by the New Zealand Racing Conference and Harness Racing New Zealand upon being satisfied as to the character and otherwise that any person whom, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of these rules should have relief from the effect thereof may grant an exemption to any such person.
4. The rules previously made by the Harness Racing New Zealand under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the "New Zealand Gazette", of 22 November 1973, on P.2438, and which were deemed to have been revoked at midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976, have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time before midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976. In every other respect such revoked rules thereafter have no effect. The rules previously made by the Harness Racing New Zealand under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the "New Zealand Gazette", shall thereafter have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time between midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976 and midnight on the day on which these rules are published in the said Gazette. In every other respect such revoked rules shall hereafter have no effect.
