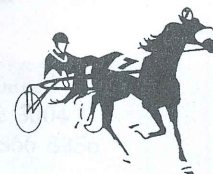

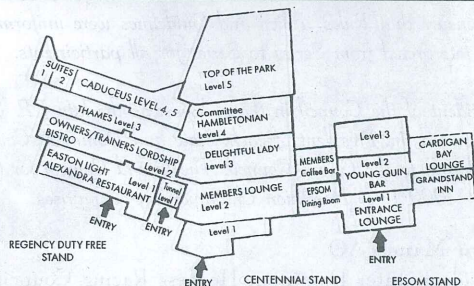

After choosing the venue where you wish to be, the type of bet you require and amount to be invested, simply advise the tote operator of this choice, along with your selection (s).

NOTE: Always check your ticket before leaving the Tote Operator.

CANCELLATION RULES

No cancellations will be allowed for bets with a value of \$200 of greater via betting terminals within 15 minutes of scheduled race start time unless it is cancelled within 2 minutes of the ticket sale. This regulation is applied to protect the integrity and ensure continuing customer confidence in the totalisator system

BETTING VOUCHERS -

Eliminate time spent in queues waiting for cash transactions. Use a betting voucher on course, it is safer than cash. Use the Betting Voucher for - All Bets, Add Dividend Payments to Add \$,s to, Withdraw Cash from at any stage during the meeting. A pin number is encouraged for additional security. Any operator can establish a betting voucher. betting Vouchers can be used at any terminal. Hand the operator your voucher prior to placing your bets or redeeming your pay tickets. The operator will automatically issue a new voucher at the completion of your transactions. The Betting Voucher is on-going and does not have to be redeemed at the end of the meeting. It can also be used at TAB offices.

INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS SYSTEM

- A. Points shall be awarded to each horse actually starting and finishing a race of Qualifying Heat on the basis that the winner of the race of a Qualifying Heat will receive 12 points the equivalent of the number of horses previously selected by the Auckland Trotting Club as the maximum number of horses to complete in each race of the Qualifying Heats. The second horse in each race of the Qualifying Heats will receive 11 points and the third horse will receive the next lower number with each horse finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding horse.
- B. The winner in each race of a Qualifying Heat will receive four (4) bonus points to be added to the points already earned for that race. The second and third horses in each race of a Qualifying Heat will receive two (2) and one (1) bonus points respectively to be added to the points already earned for that race.
- C. There are no points allocated for fastest time.
- D. A horse that is scratched from a race of the Qualifying heat or a horse that does not complete the race will not be allocated any points for the race of that Qualifying Heat.
- E. In the event of a scratching of a horse not completing the race, points will be allocated as before with the winner and other horses finishing the race entitled to receive their maximum number of points as if a full field had completed and finished in the course in that particular race.
- F. In the event of a dead heat all points for the horses dead heating shall be added together and equally divided.
- G. The judge shall place all horses in a race according to the order in which their noses reached the winning post.
- H. In each Qualifying Heat the original number of maximum points allocated for such Heat shall be allocated irrespective of the actual number of starters and irrespective of the variation of the number of Heats on each day or night of racing.

STIPENDIARY STEWARDS PRESS REPORT

AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB - TUESDAY 9TH MARCH, 1999

Weather : OVERCAST/SHOWERY - Track : FAST

1. **HEATHCOTE & HENSHAW SIGNS LTD MOBILE PACE:** BIT OF THAT was slow to gain its position during the run up. Shortly after the start **WORTHY VANCE** paced roughly and tangled briefly settling towards the rear.

2. **ALEK GORYL PANELBEATERS MOBILE PACE:** **VELORUM** was a late scratching from this event with a veterinary certificate to be provided. At the start **SHANBRY ROSE** broke losing considerable ground. With approximately 600m to travel **JIGGERY POKERY** commenced to pace roughly and in so doing lost its position, causing **SOKY'S KISS** which was following to take evasive action.

3. **ABLE TIMBER SUPPLIES LTD 4TH PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT:** Favorite **KATE'S FIRST** settled back in the field, then improved to race outside the leader without cover for the final 1600m of the event. The mare battled well for her fourth placing. Over the concluding stages **POCKET BATTLESHIP** was inclined to run inwards under pressure.

4. **ON ROBERTSON MEMORIAL 3RD TROTTERS QUALIFYING HEAT:** Prior to the start **MEANDER IN EDEN** needed attention to its shoes. **NOOPY KIOSK** was considerably slow to begin. **AVATAR** broke at the start losing several lengths. This horse broke again during the running. The connections of the gelding were warned to improve its racing manners. With 1700 metres to travel **JK DEE** trotted roughly for a start distance. An information was lodged against **D K Gibbons (NOOPY KIOSK)** alleging that he was in breach of Rule 857 (7) (g) in that he failed to come up into position with **NOOPY KIOSK** in the run up behind the mobile gate at the start of this event. **NOOPY KIOSK** missed the start by approximately 15 lengths. The charge was upheld and he was fined the sum of \$100.

5. **STEAMLINE FREIGHT LTD HANDICAP TROT:** At the start of shortly after the following horses broke or made mistakes - **DEL GARDA**, **TUFF COOKIE**, **CABALETTA**, **CLASSICAL WHIZ** and **SHANYAND**. Round the home turn on the last occasion **TUFF COOKIE** broke again. The connections of **DEL GARDA** were advised that the mare will be required to start from the nooky position for standing starts until further notice. The connections of **SHANDYAND** were advised that the gelding is stood down for stake bearing events for a period of 14 days and then until such time as it trials to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward on one occasion.

6. **FRIDAY FLASH 5TH PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT:** At the start **FROSTY MOTA** and **BLUE RINSE** were back of the gate at dispatch. The pull up blinds on **RAPAKI LAD** malfunctioned despite the efforts of horseman **G Bennett** to activate them. An investigation established that trainer **J Green** had taken all possible measures to ensure the gear was working properly prior to the race.

7. **CARLTON PARTY HIRE AUSTRALASIAN YOUNG DRIVERS CHAMPIONSHIP:** After approximately 500m **WHITFORD ATOM** momentarily broke falling back on to **LIEBE LASS** which in turn went back on to **ADMIRAL'S FELLA** which broke as a consequence losing several lengths. In the home straight **BRUTE FORCE** was inclined to lay out under pressure.

8. **NRM PERFORMA 6TH PACERS QUALIFYING HEAT:** At the point of dispatch **IRAKLIS** and **KLIKILITE** were slightly off the gate. With 600m to travel **SAM MALONE** which had been racing in the trail gave ground quickly. Rounding the final with approximately 300m to travel **NEBULIZER** got his head around, appeared to get on a knee breaking and in so doing falling back and hampering **BRABHAM**, as a result **MELTON LUCIAND** had to be checked and **SCREEN PLAY** was hampered. In the run home **SCREEN PLAY** drifted out under pressure further forcing **MELTON LUCIAND** wider. Over the concluding stages **SILK BROCADE** appeared to falter. Veterinary examinations were ordered to be carried out on the following horses - **SAM MALONE**, **SILK BROCADE** and **NEBULIZER**. The Veterinary Surgeon reported as follows: **SAM MALONE** was inspected no significant abnormalities were found, **SILK BROCADE** was inspected and it was reported that the horse had pulled up lame in the off front foreleg. The mare will be examined prior to the third heat with view to ascertaining its soundness to race. **NEBULIZER** was inspected and no abnormalities were found.

9. **CIVIC VIDEOS MOBILE PACE:** **HIGHVIEW HOT SHOT** was a late scratching from this event after being sold to overseas interests. A late driving was authorised by the Stipendiary Stewards with **D Butcher** replacing **Tony Shaw** as the driver of **ROCKBREAKER**.

10. **CENTRA AUCKLAND HOTEL 4TH TROTTERS QUALIFYING HEAT:** **MERINAI** and **KNIGHT PISTOL** were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon prior to the race and both were found to be fit to start. **THE PATRIOT** was unable to maintain gate speed and as a result was considerably slow to begin. **KAWARAU INVASION** and **NATIONAL INTEREST** both broke free of interference at the start losing considerable ground. **KINGFISH KIVI** broke free of interference losing its chance with 350m to run.

An application was made by Mr D Gale, trainer of **BLUE RINSE**, to scratch the gelding from its heat on the third night of the qualifying round and to have the horse exempted so it could run in the InterDominion Series Consolation. D Gale stated that the horse has had a history of leg problems and was suffering from an arthritic condition. He further stated that P Ferguson, driver of the gelding in tonight's heat, had advised him that the horse had not stretched out in its normal manner in tonight's event and had suggested that the horse be rested on Friday night. D Gale and P Ferguson both stated that the horse had pulled up in its normal manner and no lameness was apparent. The Stipendiary Stewards advised Mr Gale that they considered his reasons for scratching without the accompanying Club Veterinary Surgeon's recommendations to be unacceptable and that if the horse was to be scratched for its engagements on Friday night without the associated Club Veterinary Surgeon's certificate, it would be stood down in accordance with the conditions governing the conduct of the series for the specified period of eight weeks.

An application was made by trainer M Purdon to scratch **MERINAI** from the remainder of the series for the reason that the mare was not responding to treatment in regard to its muscular problem which in his opinion had resulted in the mares below par performance. The Stipendiary Stewards advised that veterinary certificate would be required for the horse to be exempted from the eight weeks stand down period.

The Prize

The winner of this promotion will receive either a free service of an approved mare to the stallion **IN THE POCKET** or alternatively (at the option of the winner) the market value in cash of the service fee for the 1999 season. The runner-up in this promotion will receive either a free service of an approved mare to the stallion **TROUBLEMAKER** or alternatively (at the option of the winner) the market value in cash of the service fee for the 1999 season.

Promotion

The promotion comprises two stages. The first stage involves the drawing of one ticket after each of the twenty-one eligible races.

The second stage held after race nine (9) on Grand Final Night involves the drawing of one of those twenty-one tickets as the winning ticket. A second draw shall be held amongst the remaining twenty tickets to determine the winner of the runner-up's prize.

Conditions of Entry

1. The entry form is a betting ticket issued by the Auckland Trotting Club or the NZ Totalisator Agency Board to a person who is over the age of eighteen years. Such entry form may be issued to a person over the age of eighteen years who is appointed to act as a representative on behalf of a person or persons of or over the age of eighteen years not able to get to the course or the NZTAB and to make such investments in this promotion as authorised by such absentee person(s).

2. The entry ticket to be eligible must be a totalisator ticket that complies with the following conditions:

- (i) Have a minimum single investment value of \$10.00
 - (ii) Be a ticket that has a single investment value of \$10.00 on any heat, consolation of Grand Final of the InterDominion Championship events.
 - (iii) Forms part of the totalisator pool from which dividends are declared.
 - (iv) Have the entrant's name, address and telephone number clearly written or printed on the back of the ticket.
3. A totalisator ticket that has been cancelled prior to the running of a race of which is subject to a refund because of a late scratching is not eligible for entry.
4. The eligible betting ticket can either be a winning or losing ticket.

Patrons can obtain a winning ticket back from the totalisator staff after having such winnings paid out by requesting the return of the ticket from such staff member after it has been processed through the totalisator.

5. There will be a draw in the first stage of the promotion on the night of 9th March to determine the names of the five (5) winning ticket holders with eligible investments on the InterDominion heats on the 5th March to go forward to the final draw. A further draw will be held on the 12th March to determine the names of the five(5) winning ticket holders with eligible investments on the InterDominion heats on the 9th March to go forward to the final draw. A final draw shall be made on the 19th March after Race Nine (9) to determine the names of the seven (7) winning ticket holders with eligible investments on the InterDominion heats of the 12th March and of the names of the four (4) winning ticket holders with eligible investments on the InterDominion Consolations and Grand Finals of the 19th March. Each entry shall be eligible for one draw only. The entry ticket must be lodged in the specially marked receptacles situated around the racecourse or at the NZTABs after any of the eligible races. An eligible ticket may be deposited in such receptacles at any time prior to the final draw following Race Nine(9) on the 19th March. Eligible tickets will only be accepted by the NZTABs for the first three (3) nights of the Carnival ie March 5th, 9th and 12th.

6. The receptacles on each of the first three nights of the Carnival will be emptied on course thirty (30) minutes after the last heat each night and by the NZTABs at their designated closing time for that night. The NZTABs, in an arrangement with the Club shall forward all entries received next day to the Club by Courier Post. Each draw will be conducted under the supervision of the Chief Racecourse Inspector from Harness Racing New Zealand whose decision as to the eligibility of the tickets is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

7. The name of the entrant drawn to go into the final draw will after each night that a draw takes place, be broadcast on the course and over Trackside and on Radio Pacific. Drawers of winning tickets for the first two nights will also be notified by the Club.

8. After the last of the eligible races has been run and the last draw made, The twenty-one (21) successful tickets will go forward to the second stage draw by lot which shall take place in the Victory Circle after Race Nine on the programme. The entrant with the first ticket drawn at the second stage will receive the IN THE POCKET prize and the second ticket drawn will win the TROUBLEMAKER prize.

9. By entering a ticket in a draw the owner of that ticket authorises its destruction at any time after completion of the draw in which it was entered.

10. The winners must elect in writing by 31st March 1999 as to whether they will send a mare to IN THE POCKET or TROUBLEMAKER or take the market value cash amount for the 1999 season. Woodlands Stud would pay the winner by 20th March 2000 after selling and collecting the service fee on behalf of the winner.

11. If the winners elect to send a mare to either IN THE POCKET or TROUBLEMAKER, the mare must be approved by Woodlands Stud of Ross Simpson and must satisfy the terms and conditions set in place for the service of these specific stallions as specified by the respective studs. If the mare is not acceptable, the studs will pay out the market value of the service fee.

12. A contact confirming the nomination for the IN THE POCKET and TROUBLEMAKER service will then be issued by Woodlands Stud and Karamea Farm to the winners.

13. If the winner elects to accept the service nomination, the service nomination will be on a guaranteed 42-day positive pregnancy test. If the mare does not succeed in getting a 42-day positive pregnancy test in the 1999 breeding season, then a payment in cash of the market value of the service fee will be paid to the winner on presentation of a veterinary certificate to this effect.

14. It will be the responsibility of the winner to insure the foetus. There will be no free return service in IN THE POCKET or TROUBLEMAKER and there will be no live foal guarantee.

15. If a 42-day positive pregnancy test is issued then the foetus will be at the sole risk of the winner from that date and there will be no further obligation or any party after that date.

16. The prize is not transferable and cannot be sold.

17. Any entrant may be required to produce identification and / or proof of age.

18. Directors, Committee, Stewards, Employees, Staff and their families of the Auckland Trotting Club, Woodlands Stud and Karamea Farm, the Auckland Totalisator Consortium, TAB and raceday officials are not eligible to enter this promotion.

19. The winner agrees to cooperate fully with the Auckland Trotting Club and Woodlands Stud in respect of his or her success in the competition, including photographs and publication of the winner's name. "Family relates to "blood family" (or by adoption) and specifically; Father, Mother, Brother, Sister, Son, Daughter, Husband, Wife and De Facto are to be excluded. This would therefore allow a Son-In-Law or Daughter-In-Law to be eligible.

AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB (INC.) HARNESS RACING NEW ZEALAND

In pursuance and exercise of the power contained in section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, Harness Racing New Zealand resolves to, and does hereby make the following Rules controlling the admission of persons to all race courses used by racing clubs which are now, or may at any time hereafter be registered with the said Harness Racing New Zealand.

RULES (Under the Racing Act 1971)

1. These rules shall come into force on the day after the day on which they are published in the "New Zealand Gazette."
2. In these rules the words "racecourse", "racing club", and "race meeting" shall have meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by Section 2 of the Racing Act 1971, and the word "bookmaker" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto by the Gaming Act 1908, or any subsequent Act consolidation or in substitution of such Act.
3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from all racecourses used by racing clubs which are or may at any time hereafter be registered with the Harness Racing New Zealand while such racecourses, or any thereof, are being used by any club for a race meeting, namely:
 - (a) All persons under disqualification imposed under New Zealand Rules of Racing or the New Zealand Rules of Trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside of New Zealand which have reciprocal agreement in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or Harness Racing New Zealand;
 - (b) Bookmakers;
 - (c) Persons convicted of theft, burglary, receiving stolen goods, robbery, unlawful taking or conversion of a motor car or other vehicles, false pretences, forgery, uttering, possession of counterfeit coin, or assault;
 - (d) Persons convicted of any offence under the Gaming Act 1908, or of any of the following offences under the Crimes Act 1961; murder, attempted murder, manslaughter (not based on negligence), sections 188-204 (which relate to assaults and injuries to the person), sections 294-297 (which relate to arson or attempt threat), crimes involving dishonesty or conspiracy to commit a crime, indecent acts, sexual offences, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
 - (e) Persons convicted of an offence against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Narcotics Act 1965, or against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 6 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
 - (f) Persons convicted in countries outside New Zealand of offences corresponding to those mentioned in paragraph (d) or paragraph (e); Provided always that a committee established by the New Zealand Racing Conference and Harness Racing New Zealand upon being satisfied as to the character and otherwise that any person whom, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of these rules should have relief from the effect thereof may grant an exemption to any such person.
4. The rules previously made by the Harness Racing New Zealand under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the "New Zealand Gazette", of 22 November 1973, on P.2438, and which were deemed to have been revoked at midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976, have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time before midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976. In every other respect such revoked rules thereafter have no effect. The rules previously made by the Harness Racing New Zealand under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the "New Zealand Gazette", shall thereafter have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time between midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976 and midnight on the day on which these rules are published in the said Gazette. In every other respect such revoked rules shall hereafter have no effect.
