PATRONS NOTE PRE-RACE WARM UPS

Patrons are advised that trainers are permitted to "warm up" their horses during the preliminary of the race immediately prior to the race in which their horse is engaged (i.e.: a runner engaged in race two may "warm up" during the preliminary for race one. Runners engaged in race one, "warm up" a half hour before the first race).

The purpose of the "warm up" is to loosen up (warm up) the horse's muscles and joints prior to the vigorous exercise of the race. The practice is similar to that adopted by human athletes prior to competition. Exponents of the pre-race warm up believe the practice activates the horse's system to an optimal level for its race.

When a horse is being "warmed up" its driver will be wearing the correct colours, however the horse will not have a saddle cloth number on but will have a head number.

There may be occasions when the horse is warmed up by a driver other than the driver engaged in the actual race. This may occur when the race driver has a driving commitment in the preceding race.

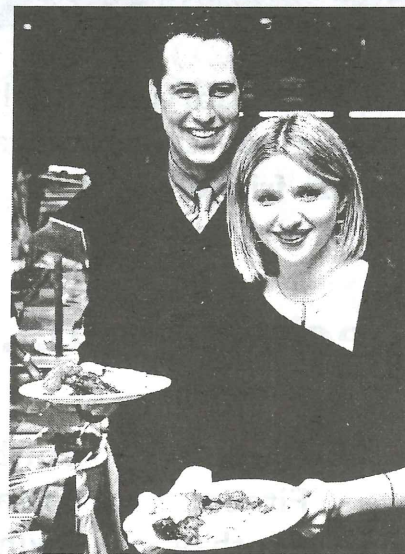

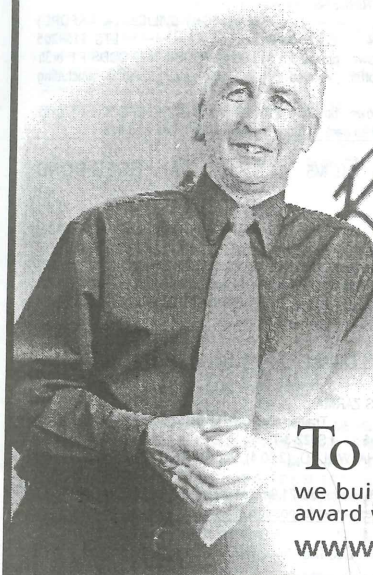

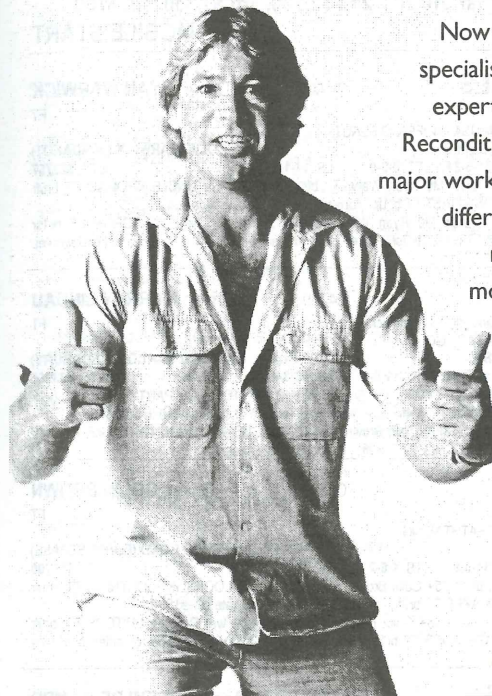

WHISTLNUKE WHITBY (John Caldwell) gave ground in the final turn. Mr. Caldwell was cautioned regarding continuing to use his whip, albeit sparingly, when the horse was not responding.

Winner - ROMBO RAMBO

RACE 3 - 2004 ROSS NORTH INTER DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP - HEAT 1 (1740 MBL)

TE KANARAMA raced ungenerously into the final turn and then broke gait free of interference. A post-race veterinary examination found no abnormalities. The gelding was barred to one satisfactory trial. Stewards ruled that it may start in the second round of heats provided it trials satisfactorily.

DOUBLE IDENTITY was hampered in the final turn when FOX OSHAUGHNESSY was moved outward for a clear run.

THE DIE IS CAST had difficulty obtaining a clear run in the run to the finish.

Sheri Sheehy (LITE RED) was cautioned for rating a 33 second quarter.

Winner - FAKING IT

RACE 4 - 2004 ROSS NORTH INTER DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP - HEAT 2 (1740 MBL)

First emergency FINAL QUEST started from barrier 6 with the scratching of TRICKY VIC.

LOMBO LA FE FE broke gait shortly after the start when being urged to try and attain the lead. The mare again broke gait in the back straight on the final occasion, and was barred to a satisfactory trial. Stewards ruled that it may start in the second round of heats provided it trials satisfactorily.

RACE 5 - 2004 ROSS NORTH INTER DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP - HEAT 3 (1740 MBL)

The start was delayed several minutes when COUNTRY WAYS required a gear adjustment. A false start was declared at the first attempt when Colin Brown (SAND PEBBLES) called to the starter that the hoppel shortening pins released prematurely. As a result the race started seven minutes late.

Chris Lewis driver of 6th placed ALL HART successfully protested against 5th placed THORPEDO (Greg Bennett) as a result of Mr. Bennett allowing THORPEDO to shift outward in the run to the finish hampering the forward momentum of ALL HART. THORPEDO was relegated to 6th position.

The winner THE FALCON STRIKE appeared "short" in its action as it crossed the finish line. Two subsequent veterinary examinations found no abnormalities. Trainer Gary Hall was instructed to inform Stewards of any developments that may affect the horses fitness. Stewards will order a veterinary examination of the horse at its stable prior to it being presented to race on Tuesday.

RACE 6 - 2004 SWAN DRAUGHT AUTUMN CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL (2140 MBL)

Stewards questioned Justin Warwick (FERNLEA) regarding his tactics in the final 400 where he restrained the horse from wider on the track and then failed to use any vigour or release the deafeners in the final turn or in the run to the finish. Mr. Warwick explained that the horse was hampered shortly after the start when crossed by BAGGY PANTS (Kim Young) and after being involved in a jostling with Colin Reeves (ROYAL WIZARD) to the bell, the horse was reluctant to race. At the 400 he felt his chances would be better served to attempt to obtain an inside run in the final turn rather than continue to race wider as the horse was not making ground in the circumstances. It won its last start at Gloucester Park with the deafeners in place, and he was confident that releasing the deafeners would make no difference to his finishing position. In the circumstances was reluctant to apply the whip to the horse. Mr. Warwick advised that the horses chances were significantly diminished after it failed to lead, and the relatively fast pace in the final 800 made its task even more difficult. A post race veterinary examination found no abnormalities. Trainer Carol Warwick advised she was satisfied with the performance in the circumstances of the race.

ROYAL WIZARD raced roughly after the start.

STANLEY MOORE raced roughly after the start and was made ODM.

STANLEY MOORE and EAGLE EYE LOMBO were checked at the 700 when ROYAL WIZARD broke gait after it became unbalanced when Mr. Reeves (STANLEY MOORE) endeavoured to hold his position to the outside of FERNLEA. An inquiry will be conducted into this incident at a later date.

RACE 7 - 2004 ROSS NORTH INTER DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP - HEAT 4 (1740 MBL)

PEGGY DALE was severely checked at the winning post on the first occasion by HOLMES D G (Scott Phelan) which hung inward approaching the turn. Mr. Phelan was unable to restrain wider to allow sufficient room for PEGGY DALE as BUCK THE ODDS (Mark Reed) was crossing. An inquiry will be conducted into this incident at a later date.

SOKYOLA which led the one wide line and was rated-up to the leader BUCK THE ODDS gave ground in the concluding stages to finish 7th. Trainer/driver Lance Justice advised he was somewhat disappointed with the performance, notwithstanding the circumstances of the race. He would advise any developments in the ensuing days. A post-race veterinary examination found no abnormalities.

RACE 8 - 2004 LAFARGE PLASTAMASTA WA SALES CLASSIC 3YO COLTS AND GELDINGS FINAL (2140 MBL)

WILLOWLEAF BOY was momentarily obliged wider at the 1000 when Fred Kersley (GLOBAL FORCE) moved three wide to trail FORTY TWO GRAND. Mr. Kersley was reprimanded [Rule 63 (1)(b)]. Mr. Kersley was also reprimanded for his whip action in the concluding stages.

PADDY HANNAN broke gait free of interference off the back straight on the first occasion. When it and MEGGIES BOY were moved to a position in the one wide line at the same time resulting in PADDY HANNAN becoming unbalanced.

GLOBAL FORCE - (Bryan Cousins)

RACE 9 - TOYOTA GENUINE PARTS/TOYOTA QUALITY SERVICE HANDICAP (2900 SS)

NEW YORK STYLE and RXPLORE began badly. NEW YORK STYLE was placed on its last chance in the draw.

HANDS OF STONE galloped briefly at the start.

GENERAL

- Pre-race Blood samples were taken from a number of runners throughout the meeting for testing and examination.
- Samples were taken from all winners for testing and examination.
- Routine gear/identification checks were conducted.
- This may not be the final report for the meeting.

NOTICE TO PATRONS

CONDITIONS OF RACING:

All races are run under the Western Australian Trotting Associations Rules of Harness Racing 1999.

SCRATCHINGS/GEAR CHANGES/DRIVING CHANGES:

All scratchings, gear changes and driving changes as at 4.00pm on meeting night are displayed on the wallcards in the Betting Ring and at each totalisator window and are announced over the public address system.

STARTERS ORDERS:

Horses are under Starters Orders when they enter onto the track for their race.

STANDING STARTS:

A start is signalled by a flashing blue light and bell. A false start is signalled by the starters whistle.

MOBILE STARTS:

A flashing amber light will signal that the Starter has called the field forward. A flashing green light will signal a start. A flashing red light will signal a false start.

NO RACE:

In the event that a No Race is declared by the Stewards during running it shall be signalled by flashing red lights and the sound of a siren.

FALLEN HORSE:

In the event of a fallen horse remaining on the track amber warning lights and a siren will warn drivers.

LODGE MENT OF PROTESTS:

- (1) A person who considers that a horse is not entitled to be placed in a race as the judge has decided, may lodge a protest with the All clear steward.
- (2) A protest can relate only to an incident which occurred during the running of a race.
- (3) A protest must state the grounds.
- (4) A protest must be made before the declaration of all clear.
- (5) For the purposes of this rule "person" means a steward, the starter of the race, a connection or driver of any horse competing in the race or an authorised agent.

BETTING TICKETS:

All betting tickets and dividend payments should be checked carefully before leaving the totalisator window or bookmakers stand. Any error must be drawn to the attention of the operator or bookmaker immediately.

LOST TICKETS:

BOOKMAKERS:

Lost Bookmaker betting tickets should be referred to the Betting Supervisor in the Betting Ring.

TOTALISATOR:

No dividend shall be recoverable or paid except on presentation of the ticket for which the dividend is claimed, or the expiration of 3 months from the date of the declaration of the dividend.

In the case of a lost winning ticket, a lost ticket claim form must be completed. Refer to tote staff for assistance.

BOOKMAKERS LIABILITY LIMITS:

PRIME MEETING:

Liability limit of \$2,000 before horses enter onto the track reducing to \$500 after horses are on the track.

COUNTRY FRONT MEETINGS:

Liability limit of \$1,000 before horses enter onto the track reducing to \$500 after horses are on the track.

INTERSTATE MEETINGS:

As per "Country Front Meetings".

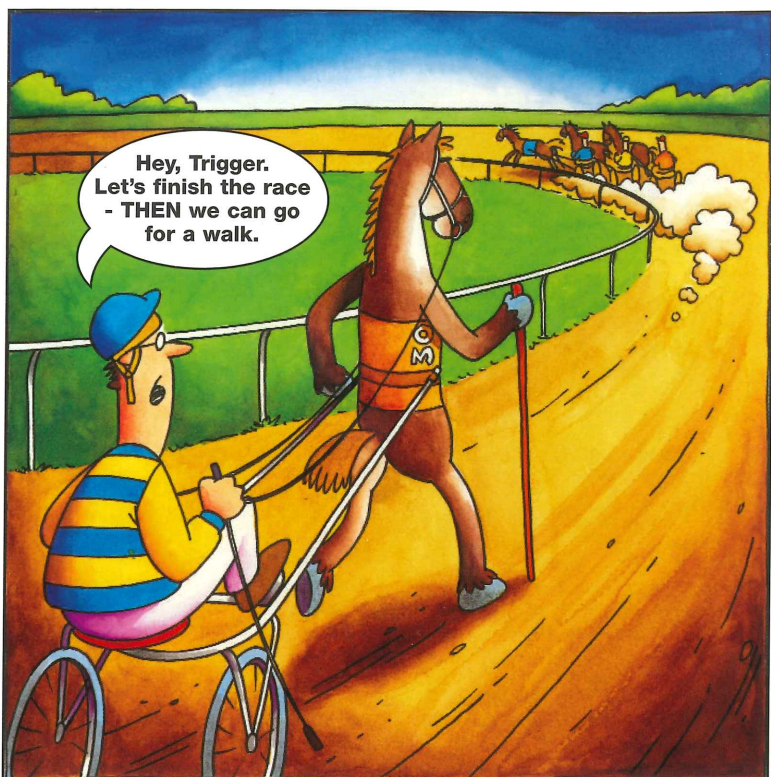
TOTE PLACE BETTING:

8 or more starters	-	place bets paid on 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd horses.
5,6 or 7 starters	-	place bets paid on 1 st and 2 nd horses.
4 or less horses	-	no place betting.

This Rule may be varied when late scratchings occur.

INTERSTATE AND COUNTRY TROTTING MEETINGS:

Totalisator betting is available throughout the course on all TAB meetings held during the time frame for the local meeting.
